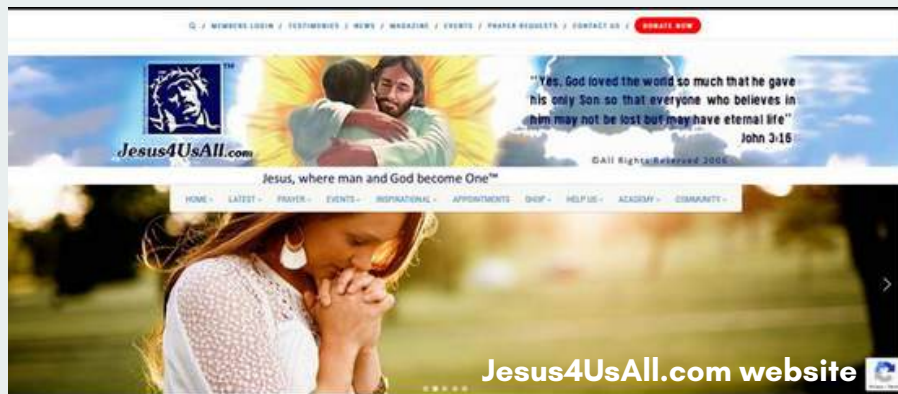

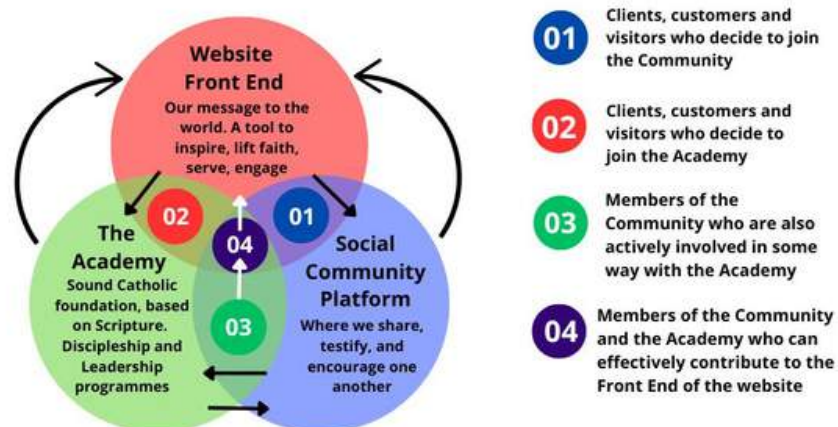

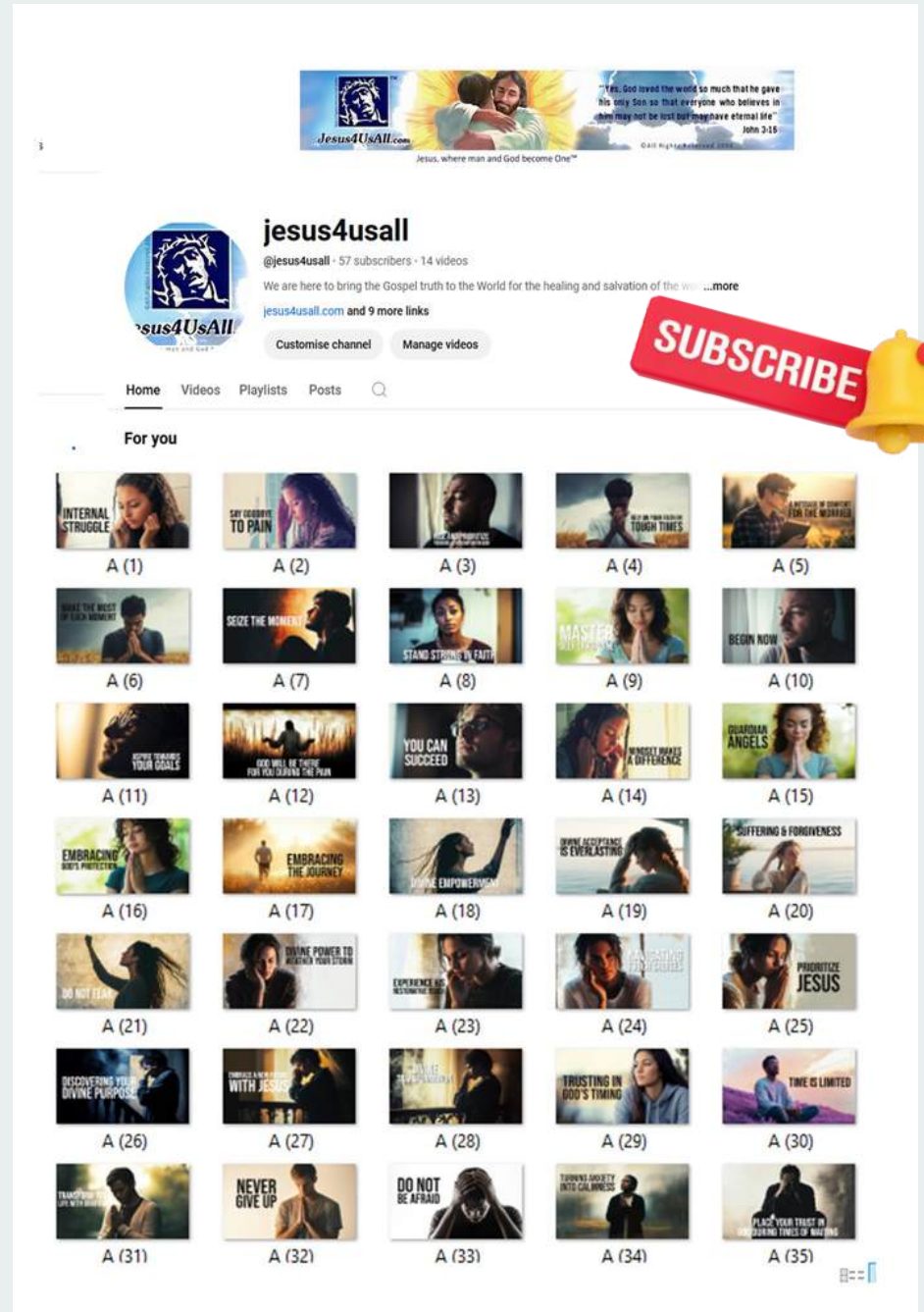
The Foundations of Catholic Faith

MARCH - MONTH OF ST JOSEPH
FEAST DAYS: 19TH MARCH & 1ST MAY



O St Joseph, whose protection is so great, so strong, so prompt before the throne of God, I place in you all my interests and desires. O St Joseph, do assist me by your powerful intercession, and obtain for me from your divine Son all spiritual blessings, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. So that, having engaged here below your heavenly power, I may offer my thanksgiving and homage to the most Loving of Fathers. O St Joseph, I never weary of contemplating you, and Jesus asleep in your arms; I dare not approach while He reposes near your heart. Press Him in my name and kiss His fine head for me and ask Him to return the kiss when I draw my dying breath. St Joseph, Patron of departed souls, pray for me. Amen.



St David's Day - 1st March

St David, *Dewi Sant*, was a leading figure and monk in the early Welsh Church who lived in Pembrokeshire in the sixth century. He founded a monastic community, living a simple, austere life in the Celtic monastic tradition which connected the people of Wales with Ireland, Cornwall, France and the Scottish Isles. He drew followers from all over Wales and he travelled a great deal to preach. One of the most famous stories about David's preaching is that when speaking at the *Synod of Brefi* (now Llanddewi Brefi in Ceredigion), the earth beneath his feet rose up to create a hill so his words could be heard, and he could be seen. His last words to his followers, still repeated to this day, were: **"Be joyful, keep the faith, do the little things you have seen me do"**. The earliest known 'life' of St David was written by a monk called Rhygyfarch around 1080, 500 years after David died. It was based on the oral traditions and memories of his sayings and the stories passed down. Later versions added more detail from other sources. According to these, his father was a prince of Ceredigion and his mother was St Non, the daughter of a chieftain and a nun. Saints' lives were not written then as biography but to build the reputation of the saint by drawing on parallels with other saints and with the life of Jesus himself. This was to inspire people to lead a life of holiness and faith. In the case of Rhygyfarch there was the added purpose of boosting the claims of the Celtic and Welsh Church and the role of St David's **diocese** as an archbishopric. Trying to untangle facts from fable would have been both impossible and missing the point: legends and additions were proof of the power and importance of the saint in people's lives.

HOLY WEEK: A NEW AND PROFOUND PERSPECTIVE

In order to understand Holy Week (1 April-20 April 2025) in the context of its original purpose, we have to see it from the perspective of the **Galilean Wedding**.



The Galilean Wedding was distinct and different from the way weddings happened around the Middle East at the time of Jesus. In fact, I would go on to say that the tradition of the Galilean Wedding has somewhat maintained its tradition even to these modern times. In order to understand what Jesus was doing at the Last Supper, we have to first look at the tradition, the language, the rituals, and the process of the Galilean Wedding. Here we will give a very brief outline, but it will be far from simple; it will carry with it a profound image with it that brings a new dimension, not only to the Eucharist, but to Christ's ambition in getting betrothed according to His Father's Will.

In the Galilean tradition, it is the father who is in charge, and it is his duty to be on the lookout for a suitable bride for His son. A bride that looks healthy and strong; a bride who has a sound character and nature. When the father finds someone suitable, and it could be someone from a very young age, he will seek to make her his son's betrothed. She will be reserved for him, through the betrothal ritual and ceremony. The first thing that would happen would be that the father, having made the announcement to his family, would call for a messenger or spokesperson – a herald, if you like – who would be appointed to go to the prospective betrothed's family home, bringing them the announcement of this proposal. When the messenger would arrive at the girl or young woman's house, they would bang on the door loudly, and shout at the top of their voice: **'I have Good News to share with this house!'** Note the words used in the Galilean Betrothal Tradition are the same words we use for the Gospel – the proclamation of the Good News – and it has the same context. When the father of the young woman invites the messenger in, the messenger would give an invitation to come to the house of the father of the groom. The messenger would then lead the prospective bride's family to the groom's father's house. The fathers would then arrange two scribes to produce the duplicate copies of the covenant that would be made between them – at this stage, it would be the two fathers who would negotiate all the terms, expectations and any dowry or insurance. Once the two fathers agree and sign the covenant, everyone would get up and make their way to the gate of the city, crying out loudly, **"Betrothal! Betrothal!"** And seeing them walk, the people of the city would follow them in procession – this was the tradition in order for the betrothal to be made public. On reaching the city gate, each family facing each other, the father of the groom would proclaim the clauses of the agreement within the covenant for all to hear, and the father of the young woman would proclaim his agreement. There would be an exchange of money from the father of the groom to the bride as security, should anything happen to the groom before the wedding. After the two fathers finish announcing the covenant of their agreement, the focus would then be on the Betrothed. Now the 'couple' would have to decide if this is something they want for themselves. A ceremonial cup and pitcher of wine would be handed to the groom; he would then pour some wine into the cup, and looking into the eyes of the young lady opposite him, would extend his hand with a cup of wine to see if she would mutually reach out her hand to take the cup from him. She really has the power to stop the whole ceremony at this point; everyone would be in suspense at this moment to see how she would respond. For our purposes here, let's see her responding positively, reaching out and looking towards his face, she would take the cup from his hand, and then holding it in both hands, she would bring it close to her face. And then there would be a pause at this moment, as she contemplated her next action. Let's say, she takes a sip of wine from this ceremonial cup, to everyone's relief and joy, and, after that

she would hand back her cup to her betrothed. Everyone would hear him say: **“From this moment forward, you are consecrated to me”**, and then he would take a sip from the same cup, sealing their future together, as betrothed; which, in the Galilean tradition, is as good as getting married, but not living together yet. Then everyone would hear the groom say, **“I will not drink from this cup with you again until I drink it with you in my father’s house,”** and with that, he would add, **“I go to prepare a place for you, and when I am ready, I will come and take you there.”** The two families would then go their separate ways, each tasked with the necessary preparations for the wedding feast; and only person who would know the timing of the wedding is the father of the groom, because only the father would have the authority to let the son know when his house is ready for the bride. This house would be joined to the father’s house.



From then on, the son would be eager to prepare the house so that he can go and get his betrothed. While the young lady would be tasked to gather 10 bridesmaids to help her prepare her dowry, bridal gown, and the bridesmaids’ dresses for the wedding feast. It’s worth pointing out that the highest priority would be on the wedding gown and bridesmaids’ dresses. Once procured, they would not be put away in some nice, fancy wardrobe; they would literally be worn day and night by the bride and her bridesmaids in readiness; as is tradition, in readiness for the return of the groom to collect his betrothed for the wedding feast at his father’s house on the appointed day.

We can imagine that the groom would come to his father from time to time asking him if the house is ready to his satisfaction. **What is amazing is that on the day that the father is satisfied that the house and banquet are ready, then he himself will give the announcement to his son; and what’s even more amazing is that he must do so in the middle of night, whilst his son is sleeping.** This is the tradition, and so when the son is woken up by the father with those wonderful words, **“Son, get up. It’s time! Go and get your betrothed.”** You can just imagine how the son would leap out of bed in excitement and rush to gather his groomsmen together with their oil lamps to wander through the dark streets to bring his betrothed home. As they go, they would blow their shofars (ram’s horns used as trumpets), crying out, **“The groom is coming!”** in the dead of night. You can imagine the homes they would pass; those neighbours who were in a deep sleep would not even notice this event; and those who were light sleepers would hear the commotion, and it would be tradition for them to get dressed and follow the procession.

From the bride’s point of view – amongst her bridesmaids, there would be watchers, watching and listening for the moment they hear the trumpet sounds and the groom coming; they would quickly trim their lamps and make their way to the dark streets to meet up with the groom and his men. The groom’s men would also be carrying a sedan chair (a ceremonial chair with ‘carrier’ poles either side). When the two parties would come face to face, the young woman would be asked to sit in the chair, and from that moment on, she wouldn’t need to walk, she would be carried by the groom’s men in honour, with her bridesmaids following behind. They would all now be rushing in the dark of night to the father’s house where the banquet would be ready for the wedding ceremony, shofars blasting, the men crying out, **“The wedding feast has come!”** And people would be following them to participate in the wedding feast celebration. The doors to the father’s house would be wide open, and the bride and the groom would take their place; and then the people would gather to sit down at the table for the guests; and once the place was full, the doors would close, and not open again for anyone, no matter who they are. The Galilean wedding feast lasts for seven days.

Knowing this, we cannot deny that a lot of what Jesus said and did had to do with his wedding, with his marriage to his bride, which is the church, which is you and me. In one sense, we are the bride; in another sense, we are the bridesmaids. In either case, we should be fully clothed and ready for the wedding ceremony of the Lamb. We are also the guests – **so we are the bride, the bridesmaid and the guest; we should be waiting and watching, and awake, ready for His return. Let us not be sleeping when that happens! And let us make sure we have enough oil in our lamps to help us get through the night to find him.**

HOLY WEEK: WEDDING SCRIPTURE TO PONDER

But while they were on their way to buy the oil, the groom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast; and the door was shut. Yet later, the other virgins also came, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open up for us.' But he answered, 'Truly I say to you, I do not know you.' Be on the alert then, because you do not know the day nor the hour."

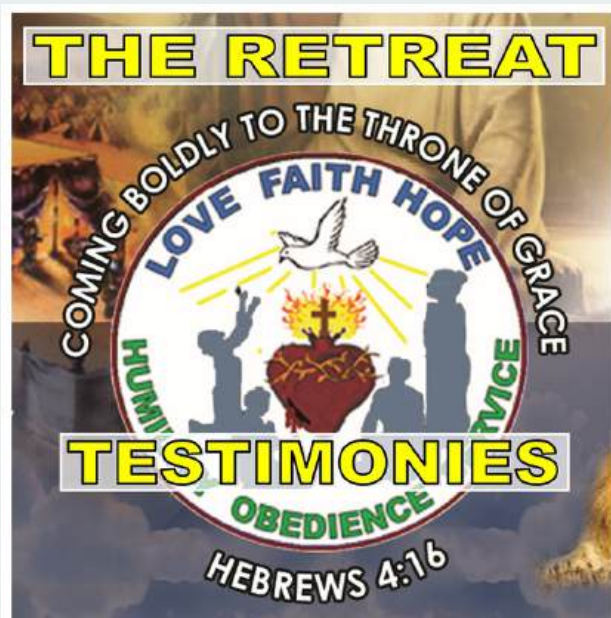

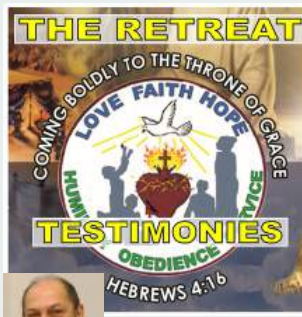
As told by Lory in Lebanon

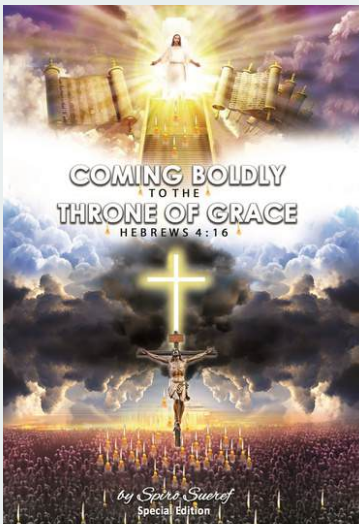

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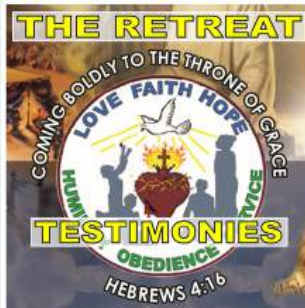
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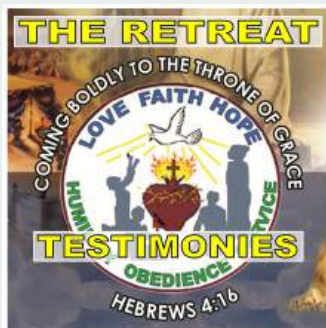


'Hi. I'm Gill from Warrington - here is my testimony. Mine was a purely spiritual problem. Four and a half years ago, I was lying in my room one night, and next to me stood a demon in human form. Six months later, it started physically attacking me - and I've had this for four years. **I've had numerous exorcisms prayed, well over a hundred; so many, I wouldn't even be able to count!** I have battled this on my own, and with others. My family wanted to section me, because when you say you are hearing and seeing things [they can't see], they think you're mentally ill. I came to this Retreat because of Sheila [of the Music Ministry] - thank you! I had no idea why I was coming here and what I was going to do, but during the prayers today... in fact, it wasn't even a planned prayer... Well, this evil thing can raise my blood pressure up to dangerous levels and give me a really bad headache. I've been hospitalised with it in the past, and the only thing that works [to stop it] is prayers. **None of the hospital's medications work**, and, anyway, it happened again here. **My blood pressure was so high, I thought I was going to pass out, and Nicholas and Father Peter prayed for me, and this thing was choking me. I couldn't speak.** It has done that to me many, many times before. And I can't declare, I can't renounce, I can't rebuke it, because **it literally has its hands around my throat. But, thanks be to God, it stopped; it just suddenly stopped.** No dramatics;

it just stopped. Praise God! Now I will just go back a bit, because this is very important to my testimony - [before coming to the Retreat] every time I would go to Mass or into a church, I would get severe pain at the side of my face, and I know it's the demon - it's trying to stop me; it causes me so much pain, and I always sit in the front [of the church] because it's nearest to the altar; and because it tries to make me leave, and I never ever have. **I can't describe the pain; it makes my eyes water, it chokes me, but the second I receive the Holy Eucharist, it stops - every single time! It's a miracle.** Every time! And I've had countless of them. **Please believe in the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, because it's real, it really is.** Before coming here I couldn't celebrate Mass without being in pain; and I couldn't pray the rosary either because the thing would choke me again. I had to pray one decade at a time. **But, yesterday, I was able to celebrate Mass with no pain for the first time ever!** Yes, I've only been a Catholic for three and a half years; **and I was also able to pray the [whole] rosary as well. Thank you Jesus, thank God.** I am so much happier; I feel as though a weight has been lifted, and I got to be able to feel joy again. Thank you Lord!

MARIA FROM BRISTOL SHARES HER TESTIMONY OF HEALING

‘My name is Maria and I come from Bristol. I had many problems after the death of my husband. We both had COVID; I survived, but my husband died.

But the way I came to this Retreat was amazing. I was preparing to go to Medjugorje on Monday, and last Sunday I went to Mass at a time and a church I don’t usually go to. But I went, it was 5 o’clock in the afternoon, because that day, they called me in the morning, saying that the choir is not going to do the training so therefore we are not going to do today; I said, “Oh, I missed Mass in the morning, so what am I going to do now?” I decided to go to this [particular] church. I went, received my communion, came back to sit down and, suddenly, after I did my prayers, I looked up, and a friend of mine who is here [at the Retreat], looked at me and waved. She came and sat down next to me, and said, “I need to talk to you.” After the Mass, she said: “There is a conference, you must come!” I asked, “When?” “Oh, this week!” said my friend. And I said, “I can’t! I will be leaving for Medjugorje on Monday.” She said, “It finishes on Sunday!” And this was last Sunday night! I asked, “Who is it?” “It’s Spiro,” she said. I said, “I have never heard of him!” Sorry. It was amazing the way it came across and I said: “I’ll go! No problem!” So I packed two bags;

fortunately, one bag was practically ready, so I packed another and came. And tomorrow I am going to leave here [the Retreat], go to church to say goodbye to a priest, go home, sleep, and then off I go, to take the plane from Manchester the following day... So my friend said she would send me all the details; on Sunday at 9pm, I called Spiro and talked to him. He said, “Unfortunately I only have one room left and it is for someone disabled.” I laughed: “No problem, because **I am disabled!**” **I have a wheelchair at home which I use regularly if I need to, when I have a pain. I have a walker, too,** but I came without the walker this time. When I came forward, some of you saw me, **I had severe arthritis, I could not kneel and had to receive communion standing up,** which was breaking my heart because I like to come to the Lord kneeling in His honour. **I could not run; no way; I couldn’t even sit, it was difficult.** I had several X-rays, I was waiting to have an operation, but because I’m only 70, they said, “You are too young.” [Laughs] Praise the Lord I didn’t, and that **I don’t need an operation now! As I can move, I can dance! I can kneel, I can skip; I received the Lord kneeling today!** It was a little sensitive, but I knelt down. **Praise the Lord!**

MARIA ADDED:

‘You know I mentioned that I lost my husband to COVID... Well, since then, I lost all my friends; not one of them left, and I don’t have a relative in England. I don’t have anyone even abroad, cause I’m from Brazil. The thing is, **as a disabled person living by myself, I have no one to take care of me, so my healing is not only physical, it’s also mental.** I was in terrible depression, but my spirit is so alive I always smile, even when things are hard, but **I was feeling heavy and I am not any more!** I have no one, no children from my marriage. My mum and dad are dead; my adoptive parents are dead, my sister is dead, everybody is dead. I have only cousins that I only met recently... In 20 years I’ve met them twice. I didn’t grow up with them ‘cause I was adopted, so there’s not really a close relationship. The only one I have is Jesus. But now I have a brother in Spiro and friends here, too.’



THE NEXT DAY

‘Spiro, I’m on a bus to Manchester now. I wanted to tell you that **yesterday and this morning I went upstairs in my house without using my chair lift!** My right knee is still good, and I can kneel down to receive my communion, but it’s not completely cured. However, [compared with] the way I was before, it is wonderful. Thank you for helping Jesus. God bless. Thanks again to your obedience to God and ministry. Now I need to find out what my ministry is, God’s desire for me.’

'Hi. My name is Alexandria. I'm from Bristol. I have been poorly these past couple of days; I'm still not 100 per cent, as you can probably hear, but **even today I have recovered massively; and very quickly!** My cold started the day I arrived at the Retreat - only a couple of days ago. For my cold to be pretty much gone already - I'd say by tomorrow morning it will be *completely* gone, maybe even tonight - is a testimony. 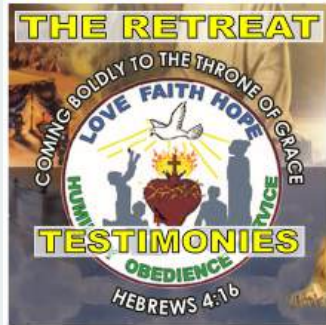
I am not feeling 100 per cent yet, but I can tell that I'll definitely recover very soon! **By tomorrow morning, praise God, I should be fully recovered!**

'I FELT IMMENSE PEACE IN MY HEART'

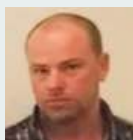

When I came to this year's Retreat, **a thought came to my mind, if I could join the Music Ministry team....** I spoke to this lovely man, here [nodding to] Adrian, and I don't know, I just felt I had to ask. I thought the answer would be 'No', but **I had this strong desire to ask, so I did.** Adrian was so encouraging – I didn't expect it; I just thought he would say 'No'. But he didn't. **Adrian encouraged me to sing, and I love singing. I loved every minute of it!** It distracted me from all the negative thinking about the past, and I realised that God is always focused and in the present. **I just thank God because I've been praising Him, literally all weekend!** [right, The Retreat's Music Ministry: Madeleine, Adrian and Shelia]



The other thing, just briefly, that happened was: I spoke to the cook here at Hebron Hall; I said to him, "You know, you seem to be very close to the Lord, how do you do it?" 'Cause I always want to transform and change, and he said, "Why don't you speak to my wife? She was the one that led me to Christ." They aren't Catholics, they are Protestants, but I thought that I'd have a chat with her anyway. She invited me to pray with her tonight. I didn't know what to do. I struggle to trust God actually and I thought, "What do I do, shall I go there? Shall I stay here?" I prayed about it, and asked: "Lord, what shall I do?" Then I spoke to Sheila, and she said, "Just stay in the meeting tonight; stay for the Mass. And **during the Healing Mass, I felt this peace in my heart, just an immense peace. All thanks and praise be to God. May this year be a year of praise. And next year I hope for a new testimony.** Thank you very much.'

CRAIG'S TESTIMONY AND THE ORIGINS OF THE 'COMING BOLDLY TO THE THRONE OF GRACE' RETREAT

I was living in Abergele [near Rhyl, Wales] when I heard about Spiro and Nick's prayer meeting in Cardiff. I went down one Christmas, and I stopped and took a little tour down to Walter's place, just off the M50, by Ledbury. It was very bitter-cold weather, very bad ice; and the night I was supposed to go down there, it was very, very bad. The motorway was all frozen over. It wasn't a night fit for man, nor beast. I didn't have any SatNav or anything. I had the name of the church, and I knew my way into Cardiff, of course, it is a big old town. It was treacherous; treacherous, bad conditions, and everybody who said they were going with me, they all kicked [changed their minds]; and I was faced with a choice. The common sense choice was, 'You know something? This ain't worth it! I'll be back down in the summer or something for a week or two, and I'll go down then.' But, no, I was convicted and driven that I had to go. So, I'd made my mind up that no matter what, I was going to go to this meeting. I had asked a few other friend Furys whilst I was down there – if they would go. I told them I didn't know the way, but they wouldn't go. Just as I was about to get into the motor, to get ready to go, Brian Fury shouted across, "I'll take you Craig."

So, the man, fair play, had never been before, and I hadn't. So, me, him and the two wives went down to Cardiff. Thank God, by the grace of God, we got there just about! It was a very dangerous road trip that night, to tell you the truth. When we got there, it wasn't a big, massive meeting; there wasn't any brilliant music ministry, but what was there, was equally **the greatest experience of the Holy Spirit I have ever had in my life. Amazing!** When I went to Miles Dempsey's that night for the first time, I was prayed over, and I sparked out, and I was on a high for two-and-a-half days. Well, that was it. That was equal to it. What I received that night at that meeting was equal to it. And, believe me, money couldn't buy it, you couldn't even imagine it. Only people who have experienced it know. Anyway, I came back and had a few more days and come back up. I went up to Pantasaph to Father Keith and Father Louis; I filled them in. I reported back the experience, and all the story of getting there. Father Keith, I think he could see that I'd had an experience; I wasn't just excited over a good old night out on the town, sort of thing. He could see.

I put the Father and Spiro and Nick in contact with each other, and from that time on, Spiro and Nicholas, for many years, had retreats at Pantasaph, for 3–4 days a piece; **hundreds and hundreds of people over the years were helped; and maybe thousands indirectly, I don't know. But many, many Masses for healing, lots of preaching, lots of teaching, miraculous healings. I used to stand and watch. Very, very powerful healings, amazing healings.**

The point is, if I hadn't made the effort, God gave me the grace – of course, He did – and God protected me. And at the last minute He sent someone to guide me – though, I would have gone alone if necessary. That night, no matter what, unless I'd been shot dead, I was going to that meeting. **But from following through a conviction** – the fruit of which was definitely seen to be from God: **I made one trip; from one trip I had one conversation; in which I gave one phone number to a Catholic priest – from those three little actions there – hundreds and hundreds of people have been helped [at The Retreats]. Craig Fury didn't help them, but because I was willing and went with it, God was able to use even the likes of me,** and for many years there have been lots of retreats until Pantasaph closed. They are still having retreats there now and days of prayer. If it wasn't, Nick and Spiro would. And there's all the knock-on things as well. **And this is just a little instance of what God can do, if we step out in faith.** We might not think it's anything, it might not be much to us, as we think, but God can multiply it and God can make it grow very, very fruitful... so step out in faith!

Fr Peter McLaren's Homily on LOVE

Fr Peter's homily, including his own artwork, right, on Friday, 4 October at the Retreat (Feast of St Francis of Assisi), was so moving, we decided to share it here.

It's the Sacred Heart. I drew it. I wake up every morning to the picture of the Sacred Heart. In 1976, when I was received into the church, the first present I had was from Sister Margaret-Mary of the Sisters of Mary; it was a picture of the Sacred Heart. I created a two-dimensional drawing of it and I think it's wonderful.

Our Father, our Creator, threw the stars into Heaven; he created the whole universe. And when He loved His Son, he loved Him with the same immensity as he did his creation. You are a human being, you can't imagine that love. That love is the Holy Spirit.

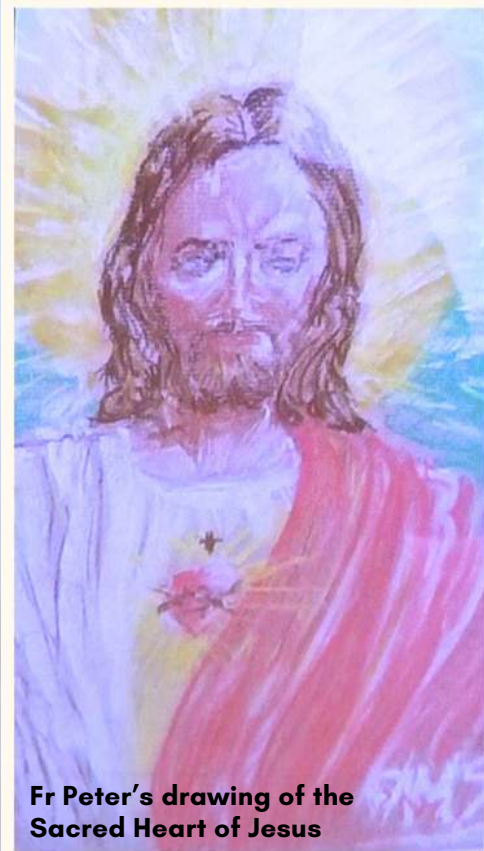
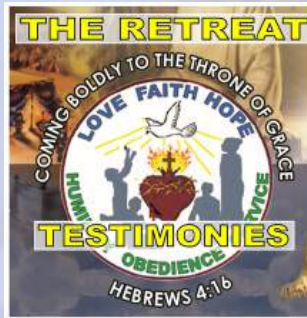
I want to tell you a bit about love; these pictures that are up here. They are some of my "handiwork". This one [bottom right corner], is my favourite. You can't see it, but there's a crack down the middle of it. It is Marie and I. [Fr Peter's beloved wife Marie died, and after a period of discernment, he became a priest] One night we had a row. And there was no frame on the picture yet. Marie grabbed hold of it in her temper and she bent it in half. "OH!" And then she started crying, and we made up, and it was beautiful. The making-up is wonderful. And she said: "I love that picture; that's my favourite picture." Because in that picture, it's Marie and I walking in our favourite place. That's me with my black mohair jumper which I love, and Marie in my favourite dress that she wore. Her pink dress. It represents my expression and her expression of love, and it's beautiful in my opinion.

But compared with God... Who created you and loved you into being, whoever you came to be in your mother's womb, He knew you. He loves you. This is what it's all about. Thank God He created you. He knew the Fall. He used to walk in "the cool of the evening" with his children. He saw how lonely the man was; he gave him a companion. Marriage, sex, sin - that hadn't been thought of yet. He just used to come into the garden in the cool of the evening and walk with his children. Then, one night, he came in, and they were hiding.

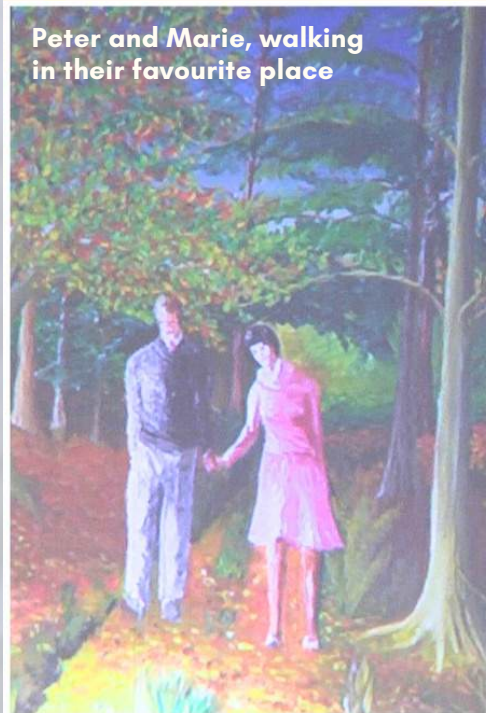
How many of you are hiding? How many of you are hiding from the Lord?

How many of you are afraid that he might find you because you are naked? Not without clothes, but naked, because you don't love yourself. You are naked because you don't see yourself as God has created you. And He loves you. He wants to grab you in his arms and say - "I love you with all my heart, with all my soul, with all my being." He is love.

When Moses found him in the Eternal Flame in the Burning Bush, He said: "I AM". He exists. You live and move, and have your existence in His being. And you will live forever. The garden of Eden will be remade; it will be renewed. And at the funeral, we heard my two favourite readings; [one] that we are already "the children of God, and what we are to be in the future isn't yet

known, but when we see God, we shall be like Him [1 John 3:2].” And [two] the Gospel, from the same John: “I have gone to prepare you a place in my mansions, and I shall return to take you with me, so that where I am, you will be also. [John 14:2]”

My dad's funeral up in Scotland... I heard my dad's voice and he cried out: “Oh, it's Mamo!” I truly believe it's my grandmother with Jesus Christ, and all his loved ones, coming to greet him, to take him home. If only we had the ears to hear and the eyes to see. At the consecration tonight, will you see all the angels and saints with Christ at the consecration? For they are here, we can tell it in the atmosphere that they are.

There are two young men, who have given up everything. I remember Spiro and Nick, and their mother, when you had a cafe by the library. We all used to gather there, and you used to spoil us and treat us, and your mum was always brilliant to us. They risked everything to come to you to teach you how to love; how to experience Christ's presence in your life – to teach you how to love and to let yourself be loved. St Francis did the same thing; it cost him dearly, and he loved dearly, and he suffered dearly, with a stigmata, because he loved. If you love with all your heart, with all your soul and all your being, you, too, will suffer. It's true; it's how suffering for the redemption of this world come about [it's because of the love/suffering of Christ that we are redeemed]. It's the cross. Did you hang on the cross and say, “Father, I forgive them; they do not know what they are doing”? It's the cross. He did that for you! How do you value yourself now? What price do you put on your head? What value do you give yourself? You are his treasures; you are his pearls beyond compare.

I often see the Catholics and I tell them jokes, and I see them smiling and I love it. Because if we can't smile, who can? We are the children of God! The descendants of the Holy Ones of Israel. The adopted brothers of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

I thought I was clever... I could do a bit of a painting. Marie could sit and talk to me, she could watch *Coronation Street*, sew; she could watch whatever you call it, with all the stripping of bodies apart... even when I came home for tea, and I'd say, “Oh God, turn that off!” And she could hold a *conversation*! I could tell you a thousand stories about the love she led me into. And I truly believe that she is in Heaven now, praying for me and my family, in the face of Our Lord Jesus Christ, radiant in the presence of Christ. Imagine the beauty of those prayers. I know she says other ones, too, because when I come in from the garden with my shoes all muddy, she says: “Get them mucky shoes off!”

Yes, smile, your future is assured. There is nothing, **nothing**, that can separate you – each and every one of you – from the love of Christ. Amen

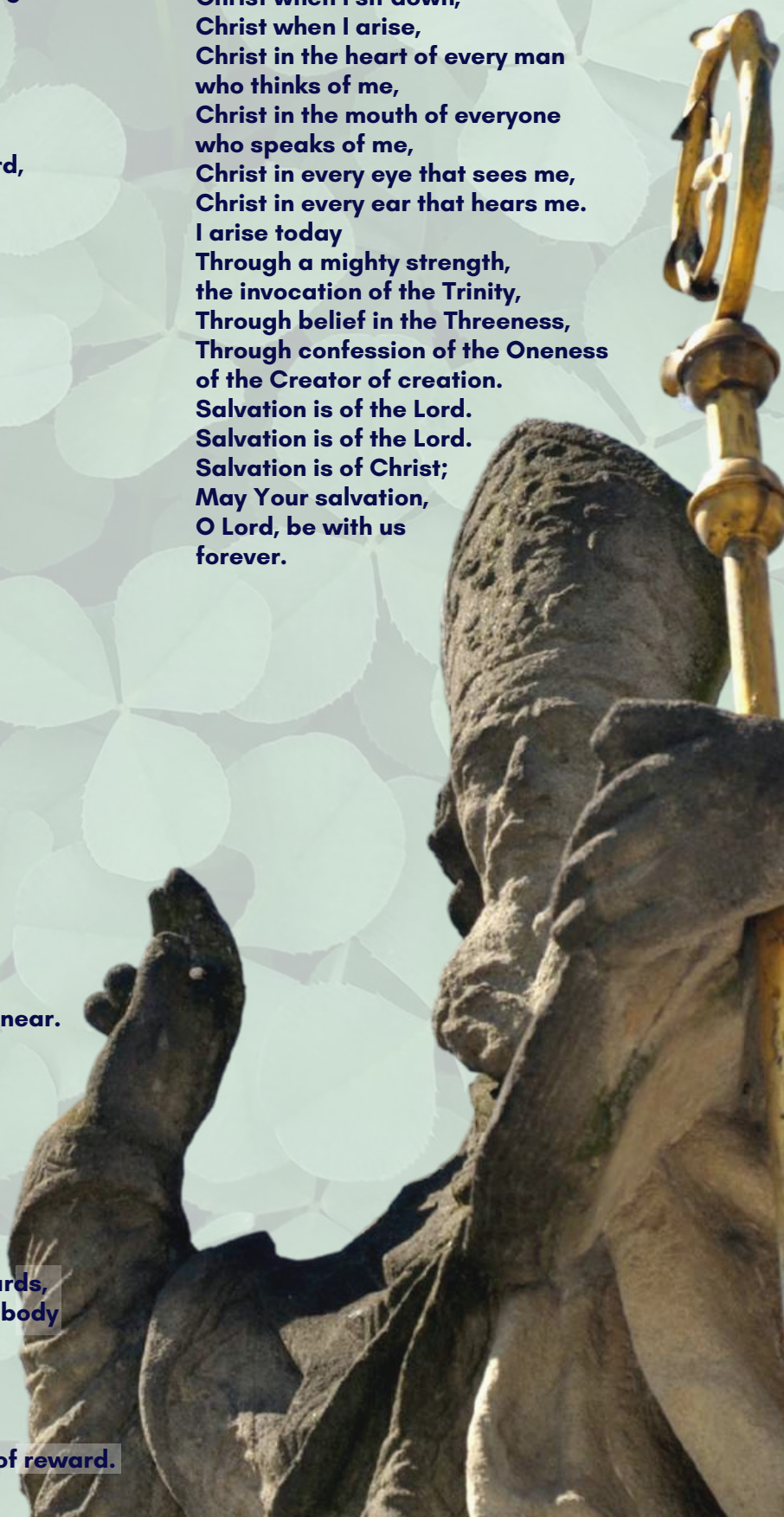

We are embarking on a 90-day journey, where for just around **3 minutes every day** we will come together to touch base with God in our daily lives.

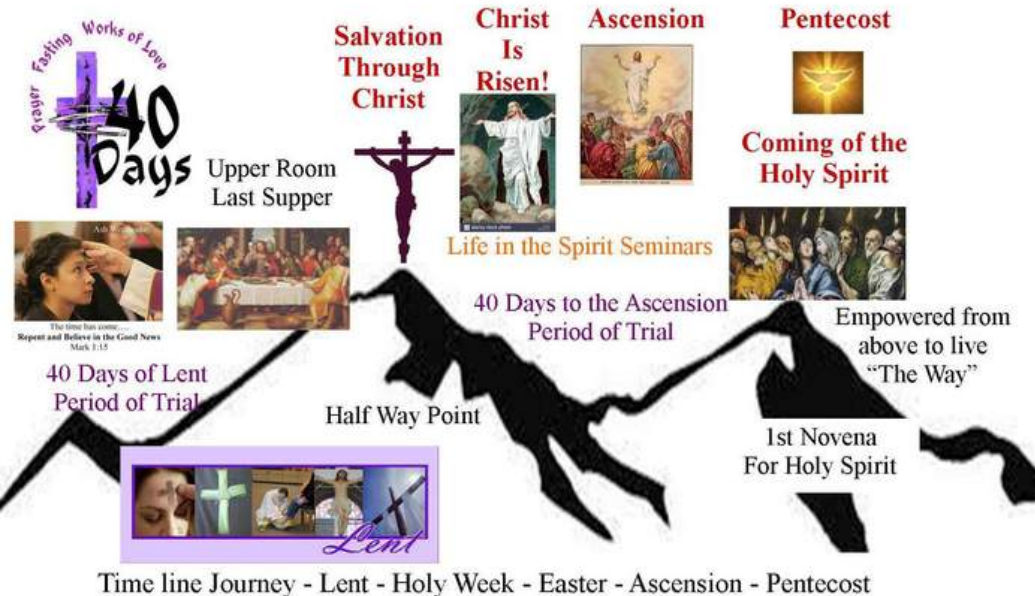

SPIRO'S LENTEN AND 'WALKING WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT' TALKS

We are all familiar with those wonderful Lenten meditation booklets called *Walk with Me: A Journey of Prayer for Lent*, and for those of you of my age, you'll have had the privilege of reading them many times! I remember this one particular year, around 2004, I did a Lenten series called 'Healing through the Penitential Path', and a woman with stage 4 cancer who had been given only four months to live, was miraculously healed by Jesus, for the glory of God, simply by attending these talks. It is amazing how God can break through into our normal everyday to bring us healing. During that Lent I kept getting the message '**Walk the Walk with Me**'; I was doing the Lenten meditations daily from the 'Walk with Me' booklet, but it seemed that it wasn't enough for Jesus for me to just walk with him, He wanted me to 'walk the walk' with him, and I had to discover what this meant. When we decide to walk with Jesus as a disciple learning from Him; if we walk with Him long enough and we are eager to imitate Him, something truly wonderful starts to happen. We become more and more like Him. This is what the Apostles refer to when they invited the Church to imitate them, just as they imitated Christ. And this is one of the purposes of the Church in its five-fold Ministry, as explained in Ephesians 4, which describes the unity of the spirit and the Christian's walk to become more and more like Christ. **Lent is about walking with Christ, but Eastertide is about learning how to walk in the fellowship of the Holy Spirit. That's what these 13 weeks of talks is about.** See the flyers below.

James 4:4 says, *"You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore, whoever wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God."* Many saints have lost their lives because of this; because they refused to worship an idol and refused to renounce Jesus as their Lord and God. One notable case is that of St Polycarp, who was an apostle of John the Apostle. He was a Greek bishop of the Catholic Church in Smyrna in the second century. St Polycarp was martyred because he refused to renounce his Christian faith and swear allegiance to the Roman emperor as a god. Despite being offered the chance to save his life by making a public sacrifice to the emperor, he remained steadfast in his belief in Christ. His refusal led to his arrest and eventual execution by burning at the stake around 155 AD. During Marcus Aurelius's rule, local and regional authorities sometimes enacted decrees requiring citizens to participate in rituals to honour the emperor and appease the gods for the well-being of the state. In cities such as Smyrna (now Izmir, Turkey, where Polycarp was bishop), such decrees would demand citizens to burn incense and make offerings to the emperor as a sign of submission to Roman authority. This practice was meant to foster unity and maintain peace in the city, as it was believed

that pleasing the gods would bring favourable conditions, such as peace and prosperity. Polycarp, however, refused to take part in this emperor worship, as it was in direct conflict with his Christian faith. Christians, unlike the pagans around them, believed in the one true God and could not honour the emperor as a deity. This refusal was seen as a threat to the Roman state's authority, and as a result, Polycarp was arrested, tried and, ultimately, martyred. His steadfastness in the face of pressure to conform to Roman religious practices is one of the key aspects of his story. One can just imagine his friends and close contacts telling him not to be stubborn and that he should give in so that he can save his life. Even these days we could imagine people advising someone in Polycarp's position that it would be okay to save your life and that God would understand and so salvation would not be lost. But this would be to deceive oneself. St Polycarp became a martyr of the church because he stood firm even in the face of death, and held on to his loyalty to God and to Jesus. This is a recurring message in the Gospels and indeed in Christianity throughout the ages. Here are just a few scriptures that point to this very important fact that if we deny Jesus, He will deny us, If we reject God He will reject us. This is a

profoundly serious thing with consequences into eternity for each one of us. See here the stand and position of the Bible, the Church and God. In **Matthew 16:25**, it says; *"For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it."* And in **Mark 8:35**, it says: *"For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and for the Gospel will save it."* And finally, in **Luke 9:24**, it says: *"For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will save it."*

In the Old Testament there is a very harsh and sad story of what can happen if we continue to disobey God. Rejecting God can bring very harsh consequences, and, in addition, the prophet Samuel reveals that obedience to God is better than any sacrifice. In **1 Samuel 15:22-26** (NASB) we read: *"Samuel said: Does the Lord have as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of the Lord? **Behold, to obey is better than a sacrifice, and to pay attention is better than the fat of rams.** For rebellion is as reprehensible as the sin of divination, and insubordination is as reprehensible as false religion and idolatry. Since you have rejected the word of the Lord, He has also rejected you from being king."* Then Saul said to Samuel, *"I have sinned, for I have violated the command of the Lord and your words, because I feared the people and listened to their voice. Now then, please pardon my sin and return with me, so that I may worship the Lord."* But Samuel said to Saul, *"I will not return with you; for you have rejected the word of the Lord, and the Lord has rejected you from being king over Israel."*

This, being a time of Lent, is a message for us. The priority for each one of us must be to obey God, in bringing about, *"Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven..."* These

scriptures and the teaching around them emphasise self-sacrifice and prioritising devotion to Jesus over earthly pursuits, while indicating that those who are willing to give up their own desires, even their lives, for His sake, will ultimately find true life.

So, this is how it will be with the Antichrist. He will, at some point, want to be worshipped. He will always edify himself in his heart and believe that there is no one like him (Rev 13:4).

This theme is more prominent at this time of Lent, when we follow Jesus to His death on the Cross; a Holy sacrifice for us and for our salvation, and the remission of our sins, and to reconcile us to our heavenly Father.

In the Jewish tradition it was a red heifer that was sacrificed so that the ashes could be used to purify the temple and tools and equipment of the temple. The Torah explains the heifer must: be without any blemishes; not have been yoked for labour: and have a completely red coat. Whilst not written down, the oral Jewish tradition says the red heifer should be at least three years old.



The red heifer, or *parah adumah*, is a rare and significant animal in Jewish tradition, mentioned in the Book of Numbers (19:3). Its ashes were historically used in purification rituals, especially for those who had come into contact with the dead. In recent years, there have been notable developments regarding red heifers in both Israel and the United States.

Red Heifers from Texas to Israel

In 2022, the Temple Institute in Israel received a red heifer from Texas. This

heifer was part of efforts to breed animals suitable for ritual purification, aiming to fulfil ancient requirements for the Third Temple. The arrival of this heifer was widely reported, including by *The Jerusalem Post*.

Israeli Efforts to Breed Red Heifers

The Temple Institute has been actively involved in breeding efforts within Israel. In 2015, they imported frozen embryos from Red Angus cattle in the US to create a herd of kosher red heifers. This initiative aimed to meet the stringent criteria outlined in the Torah for a red heifer, as mentioned earlier. The *Times of Israel* detailed these efforts, emphasising their significance for future purification rituals. These developments have been a focal point of interest within the Jewish community, reflecting a deep-seated yearning for ritual purity and the rebuilding of the Temple. For more in-depth information, the articles from *The Jerusalem Post* and *The Times of Israel* provide comprehensive coverage of these events.

Why is this important you may ask?

Well, it is because these animals were usually sacrificed between three and four years of age. If they are already three now, then they must be sacrificed within the next 12 months to follow tradition. There are reports that these red heifers would be used to purify the tools and equipment to build the third Temple in Jerusalem. If they were to be sacrificed, then it's only natural to look towards the Jewish **Passover (2025/2026/2027?)** for that to happen; a time coinciding with our own Holy Week and Good Friday. We know from descriptions of the day Jesus died on the Cross that there was some kind of eclipse covering the land. Are there any eclipses coming up which affects Jerusalem?

Passover in Israel 2025

Passover in Israel is one of the busiest times of the year. This major event in the Jewish tradition is celebrated

across the country. The first and last days of Passover are public holidays, and the days in-between are popular times for families to take vacations and day trips. As a result, several festivities take place across the land throughout that week. There are now in fact countless incredible things to do in Israel for Passover, tailored to travellers of all interests and from all backgrounds.



Passover is the festival that commemorates the story of the Exodus, in which the ancient Israelites were freed from slavery in Egypt. Ultimately, God helped the ancient Israelites escape by inflicting 10 plagues upon the Egyptians, forcing Pharaoh to release the Israelite slaves. When Pharaoh freed the Jews, they left in such a hurry that they could not wait for their bread dough to rise (leaven). Therefore, for the duration of Passover, only unleavened bread is eaten, and Matzo (a flat unleavened bread) is a prominent symbol of the holiday.

The question arises that with so many conflicts regarding Israel, Jerusalem and the Temple Mount, how can the building of the Third Temple happen without a major conflict in the region? It must come at a point when there is peace in the region at least for a while as the building starts.

Since 2015 there have been rehearsals and practices, even to train up a new generation of Levitical priests and so forth, to be able to restart the rituals after around 2000 years of having had them stopped in the temple of Jerusalem.

For almost a decade, the Temple Institute and other organisations have continued to petition the police, or directly to the Supreme Court, to conduct a Passover sacrifice on the Temple Mount because it has been, and continues to be, rejected; and so this will require a supernatural shift of some kind to allow this to happen again.

In 2020, we were all amazed at how the whole world moved into lockstep when the COVID-19 pandemic struck the world. There can only be a supernatural power that causes such a move of unity around the world. It would take something like this to get Israel and America to get the consent to begin the rebuilding of the Third Temple, although some countries will remain opposed against it and hence the Ezekiel war.

The rebuilding of the Third Jerusalem Temple, and the restarting of the Levitical priesthood sacrifices in the Temple, will trigger off a series of cascading events that will quickly move the world into The Great Tribulation, or what is known as 'Jacob's Trouble' (Jeremiah 30:7) since the Ezekiel 38/39 war of God and Magog will be part of the world's response to Israel's efforts to prepare for what they believe to be their *Mashiach* (or Messiah).

We, as Christians, believe, however, that this will be the Antichrist; who will sign a seven-year peace deal with Israel, but halfway-through declare himself to be god and demand that he be worshipped.

This coming war, triggered by the rebuilding of the Third Temple, is believed to involve Russia, Turkey, Iran, Sudan and Ethiopia, and even some countries in Europe, such as France and Germany. **And this war, in turn, will trigger the start of the seven-year "Tribulation"; the latter half of which (three and a half years), is known as "The Great Tribulation".**

Whilst many may say that it's unlikely to happen this Passover, and that the rebuilding of the Third Temple is still not on the horizon – how many could have predicted what happened in 2020 with the COVID-19 pandemic and its global action to lockdown?

It will come like this. Suddenly, unfolding events will reveal a Seven-Year Peace Treaty, and then the movement of armies against Israel.

We also need to consider that this may also trigger a global jihad which will be targeted specifically against Christians, since the Zionists believe that they have two predominant Biblical enemies: the first is Ishmael, the first son of Abraham, and secondly, Amalek, the grandson of Esau, the twin brother of Jacob who became Israel.

There are some reports that say that Ishmael are the modern-day Muslims, and that the modern-day Amalek is Europe and the west. The Zionists will produce a clever plot to cause the Muslims to start a global jihad, whereby they will start their holy war against Christians.

This is what many believe is what is happening in the West, with the large influxes of refugees, especially of those who are single, male, and of military age, being positioned for when the next pandemic will start for the lockdowns and martial law to take effect as nations bow down their sovereignty to global governance.

Whatever the case, we can look towards positioning ourselves, as far as is possible, and allowing for God's grace and protection wherever we are, so that we can have a good chance of escaping what must come – namely, the sword, war, famine, pestilence, food shortages and continued increase to food, energy, and general living costs, etc...

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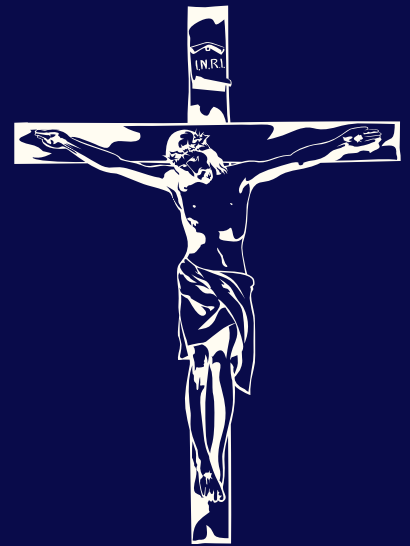

HOLY WEEK SUNDAY 13-20 APRIL 2025

Holy Week is the most sacred week in the Catholic liturgical calendar, commemorating the final days of Jesus Christ's life, his suffering, death, and Resurrection. It begins on **Palm Sunday** and concludes on **Easter Sunday**. The week is filled with significant liturgical celebrations and rituals that highlight the core aspects of the Christian faith: Jesus' passion, death, and the hope of eternal life through his Resurrection. Here's a breakdown of the key days in Holy Week:

1. Palm Sunday, 13th April 2025

Significance: This day marks Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, where crowds laid palm branches in his path, praising him as the Messiah. The event is remembered as a joyful procession, but it foreshadows the coming passion and suffering.

Rituals: The Mass begins with the blessing of palm branches, and the faithful often participate in a procession. The Passion of Christ is read during the Mass, which helps prepare the faithful for the sorrowful events of the week.

2. Holy Monday, Holy Tuesday, and Holy Wednesday

Significance: These are days of reflection on the events leading up to the Last Supper, Jesus' betrayal by Judas, and the conspiracy to arrest him. While these days don't have specific liturgical events as prominent as Palm Sunday or Good Friday, they set the tone for the final days of Jesus' life.

Rituals: Catholic traditions may involve special prayers, reflections, or extra devotions in preparation for the Sacred Triduum (the three holiest days of the year).

3. Holy Thursday (Maundy Thursday) 17th April 2025

Significance: Holy Thursday commemorates the **Last Supper** of Jesus with his disciples, where he instituted the Eucharist (Holy Communion) and washed the feet of his disciples, teaching them humility and service. It also marks the beginning of the **Paschal Triduum** (the three days leading to Easter).

Rituals: The Mass of the Lord's Supper is celebrated in the evening. During this Mass, the priest washes the feet of parishioners, symbolising Jesus' act of humility. The Eucharist is especially highlighted, as Catholics believe that Jesus gave his disciples the gift of his body and blood in the form of bread and wine.

4. Good Friday, 18th April 2025

Significance: This is the day that Catholics solemnly remember the Passion and Crucifixion of Jesus. It's a day of mourning and reflection on Jesus' suffering and death for the salvation of humanity.

Rituals: There is no Mass on Good Friday, but a special liturgy includes the reading of the Passion narrative, veneration of the Cross (where people kneel or bow before a cross in reverence), and the distribution of Communion (host consecrated on Holy Thursday). The faithful may also participate in the **Stations of the Cross**, which help mediate on the journey of Jesus' suffering.

5. Holy Saturday, 19th April 2025

Significance: This is a day of waiting and mourning, as Jesus is in the tomb. It is a quiet day of reflection on the depth of his sacrifice and the silence before the resurrection.

Rituals: The most important event of Holy Saturday is the **Easter Vigil**, which takes place after sundown. The vigil begins with the lighting of the Paschal Candle, symbolising the Light of Christ. This Mass includes readings from the Old and New Testaments, the baptism of new converts, and the celebration of the first Mass of Easter.

6. Easter Sunday, 20th April 2025

Significance: Easter is the celebration of the **resurrection of Jesus** from the dead, the most important feast in the Christian liturgical year. It signifies victory over sin and death, and the promise of eternal life for all who believe in Christ.

Rituals: The Easter Sunday Mass is a joyful celebration with readings from the Resurrection narrative, hymns of praise, and the Eucharist. Catholics celebrate the Resurrection with great joy and hope, knowing that through Jesus' Resurrection, death has been conquered.

The Spiritual Focus of Holy Week

Throughout Holy Week, Catholics are invited to enter more deeply into the suffering and victory of Jesus Christ. It's a time for prayer, penance, reflection, and acts of charity. The events of the week are meant to prepare the faithful for a profound encounter with the Risen Christ, which is the heart of the Christian faith.

The Catholic Church also encourages devotions such as **Stations of the Cross**, **Confession** and reflection on the **Sacred Triduum** (the three holiest days), which are central to deepening one's faith during this season. The culmination of Holy Week in the Resurrection gives Catholics hope and strengthens their relationship with Christ, who conquered death for the sake of humanity.

Good Friday Oil for Healing, Protection and Deliverance **– A Remedy from Father Michel Rodrigue of Canada**

This is a remedy from Father Michel Rodrigue in Canada for healing, protection and deliverance:

To use the oil for Healing, Protection, and Deliverance, make the Sign of the Cross on the forehead of a sick person or sprinkle on food or ingest it.

When all is complete, please say a Rosary, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, or prayers of thanksgiving to the Blessed Mother.

Items needed:

- * Blessed icon, image or statue of Mary, the Mother of God
- * Extra-virgin olive oil (Blessed by a priest if possible–optional)
- * Glass or stainless-steel containers to hold the olive oil (flame from wick may melt plastic)
- * Pure cotton wick or pure cotton material rolled into a wick (see length requirement below)
- * Small metal lid with a small hole in the middle to thread the cotton wick through
- * Matches or lighter (place by the bowl with olive oil prior to 3am)
- * Syringe to move oil from large container to smaller containers (optional)
- * Paper/pen to keep track of the number of prayers
- * Labels marked “Good Friday Oil” to place on finished jars



Advance Preparations MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO 3AM GOOD FRIDAY MORNING

All preparation must be done in front of a blessed icon, image or statue of Mary, the Mother of God.

Use glass or stainless-steel containers that can hold heated extra-virgin olive oil — from one source, do not mix different oils in the same container.

Soak the cotton wick or the cotton cloth (rolled into a wick) in the oil.

Put a nail-sized hole in a small metal lid (eg: lid of a jam jar). Thread the wick/cotton cloth through the hole in the lid and tie a knot on the end. Drop the lid into the oil container and it will fall to the bottom. The wick will float to the top. The wick **MUST BE** long enough to burn the whole time it takes to pray the prayers below (about an hour or so).

When finished you may want to use a syringe to transfer the oil into smaller containers (I bought 4oz Mason jars). Label the bottles.

Specific Prayers to be Prayed

After lighting the candle at 3am, begin praying these prayers:

- * Pray the **Apostles' Creed** x 33 times in honour of Jesus' 33 years on earth.
- * Pray **Hail Holy Queen** x 7 times in honour of Mary's 7 Sorrows. OR you can pray the **Salve Regina** x 7 times in Latin.

This recipe was given by Our Lady for healing, protection and deliverance during her apparition at the Holy Mountain of San Lorenzo, Puerto Rico, from 1899 to 1910. This same recipe was given by St Joseph to St Andre Bessette of Canada (1845-1937).

Sol shares a dream she had on the Feast of Divine Mercy 2019



She explains how someone was raised from the dead through prayer, and how she was taken by angels to the Throne of Judgment; and how this was averted because she made sacramental confession.

'In the early hours of the morning, just around 3am, I had a dream that I was in this place with thousands of people, from all different races and backgrounds. We were all waiting for something...

I thought to myself, with this many people there's no chance that I will be called straight away. So, I decided to walk around because I was curious about what other people were doing. Everyone was doing the things they loved doing, like being with family, eating food they love to eat, just being around their favourite cars, houses, yachts, etc, all the things they valued the most. Everything was so clear, like telescopic, because even in the far distance, I could see people very clearly. Then I entered into a room and there were people there, and my eyes went to someone who was lying in a bed, as if he were dead. So, I said: "What's a dead person doing in here?" Suddenly, the man in the bed woke up and asked, **"Who's been praying for me? It's because of their prayers that I'm alive again!"**

After hearing that, I was in shock, and in an instant, like in a blink of an eye, I was taken to the Throne of Judgment by an angel, who started whispering into my right ear about my past sins...

All of a sudden, I was covering my face with my hands, crying and pleading hard to God, telling Him,

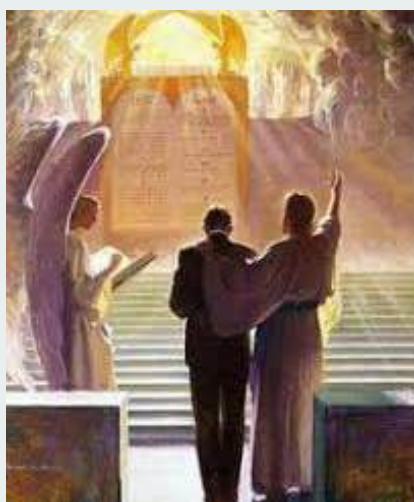
"Lord Jesus, I thought that You said, that if I go to confession and confess all my sins, You will forgive me and wipe out all my sins and You won't remember them any more."

Then I heard another whisper in my right ear telling me that He was just testing me, because he couldn't really see any more sins.

When I opened my eyes, I saw myself in a place with not much light, and in the distance, I could see a staircase going up and there was a bright light coming out of it. The angel pointed to the stairs and said: "I would have taken you up there to be judged!" I looked around and I saw many kinds of jewels on the floor - gold, diamonds, many different kinds of precious stones, and I asked the angel, "Why are these gems just on the floor? I wouldn't have been able to afford such things."

The angel replied: "Those are just rubbish! People value them the most, when they are just rubbish!"

Then I woke up! Terrified, shocked, like, frozen ... It was Divine Mercy Sunday morning. And I was still in shock for a few days after that!



Before having this dream, I was sceptical about always going to confession, when you can just confess your sins any time - just you and God. I hadn't really understood the value of Divine Mercy. Clearly, God was showing me the value of true confession and Divine Mercy, with the priest's absolution.

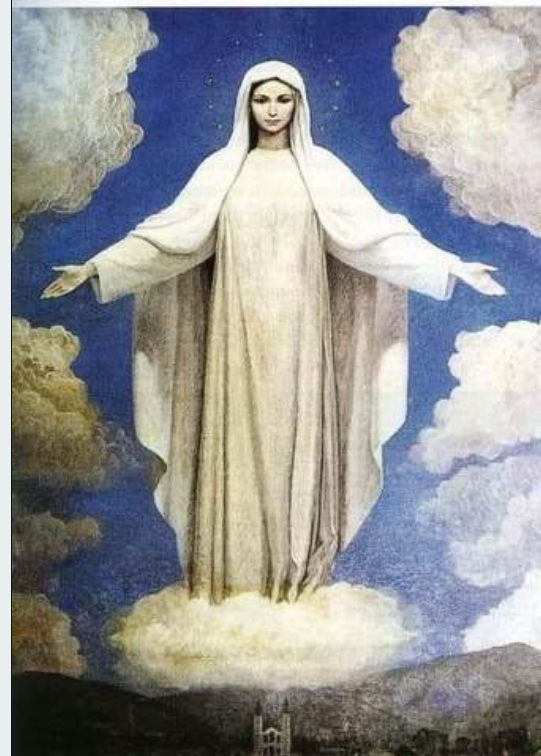

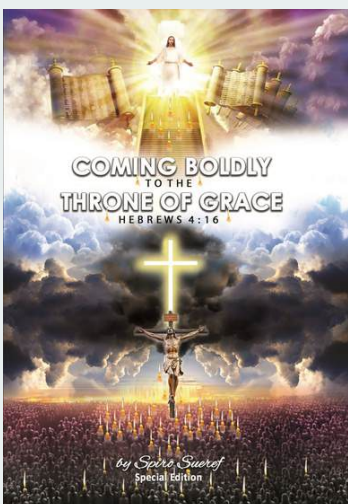

PREPARING FOR DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY 'LOW SUNDAY', 27TH APRIL 2025

Prepare Yourself Properly

Going to confession is not the only way we should prepare ourselves for Divine Mercy Sunday. As Cardinal Francis Macharski, Archbishop of Krakow, explains in a 1985 pastoral letter, we are not simply called to ask for God's mercy with trust. **We are also called to be merciful:**

"Our own merciful attitude is likewise a preparation. **Without deeds of mercy our devotion would not be real.** For Christ does not only reveal the mercy of God, but at the same time He places before people the demand that they conduct themselves in life with love and mercy.

St Pope John Paul II states that this requirement constitutes the very heart of the Gospel ethos (in his second encyclical, *Rich in Mercy*, 3)

- it is the commandment of love and the promise:

"Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy." (Matthew 5:7).

"Let it be a mercy that is forgiving and true, and universal, with good words, deeds, and prayer for others!"

Our Lord's words to St Faustina about this requirement to be merciful are very strong and leave no room for misinterpretation:

"Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy ... I demand from you deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbours always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse or absolve yourself from it." (742)

To fittingly observe the Feast of Mercy, we should:

1. **Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter**
2. **Sincerely repent of all our sins**
3. **Place our complete trust in Jesus**
4. **Go to Confession, preferably before that Sunday**
5. **Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast**
6. **Venerate* the Image of The Divine Mercy**
7. **Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers, on their behalf.**

*To venerate a sacred image or statue simply means to perform some act or make some gesture of deep religious respect toward it because of the person whom it represents - in this case, our Most Merciful Saviour.

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THE POWER OF THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET - Cathy shares her daughter's miraculous healing



From the age of 12 until the age of 38, my daughter has suffered with mental health issues, including anxiety and depression. In January 2024, she had a severe breakdown which culminated in a full-blown episode of psychosis. She was admitted to hospital for observation and treatment. I felt completely helpless and frightened. Having attended Spiro's prayer group since September 2023, I decided to ask him for spiritual guidance. **He suggested that I say the Chaplet of Divine Mercy 7 times daily for 7 days inserting my daughter's name into the Chaplet as it was being prayed.**

On completion, there was a marked change in her behaviour. The final date of my Chaplets fell on the 26th March.

From that day forward, she became kind, empathetic and attentive. No more delusions! Soon after, she was discharged from hospital! Thank you Lord Jesus for facilitating my meeting with Spiro and Nick. All praise be to Our Lord! I rarely used to see my daughter and she spent most days in bed. Now I see her most days! All glory to God Almighty! I continue to pray for her health and conversion. May God bless Spiro and Nick.

JESUS' 14 PROMISES OF PRAYING THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

Our Lord made 14 promises to those who pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet:

(1) "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image [of Divine Mercy] will not perish. I also promise victory over one's enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory." (Diary of St Faustina, 48)

(2) "The two rays denote Blood and Water... These two rays issued from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonised Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father..."

I desire that the first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy... whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment. Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy." (Diary of St Faustina, 299-300)

(3) "I desire that the Feast of Mercy... be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter... **The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion [in a state of grace on this day] shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.**" (Diary of St Faustina, 699)

(4) "Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death." (Diary of St Faustina, 687)

(5) "Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy... I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy." (Diary of St Faustina, 687)

(6) "The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death." (Diary of St Faustina, 754)

(7) "Souls who spread the honour of My mercy... at the hour of death I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Saviour." (Diary of St Faustina, 1075)

(8) "The prayer most pleasing to Me is prayer for the conversion for sinners. Know, my daughter, that this prayer is always heard and answered." (Diary of St Faustina, 1397)

(9) "My mercy is greater than your sins and those of the entire world." (Diary of St Faustina, 1485)

(10) "To priests who proclaim and extol My mercy, I will give wondrous power; I will anoint their words and touch the hearts of those to whom they will speak." (Diary of St Faustina, 1521)

(11) "Through this chaplet, you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will." (Diary of St Faustina, 1731)

(12) "When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one." (Diary of St Faustina, 1541)

(13) **"When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as a just Judge but as a merciful Saviour."** (Diary of St Faustina, 1541)

(14) "At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony... **I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion.**" (Diary of St Faustina, 1320)

My Divine Saviour, Jesus Christ, here I am prostrate before your image. Through your Passion and death, do not refuse me, but have mercy on me. Holy Spirit, dispenser of all graces, touch my heart with a ray of your light, with the warmth of your love and with a holy sorrow, that I may know well the sins which I have committed against you, and have true repentance and confess them properly in order to obtain your forgiveness. Holy Mary, refuge of sinners who wish to be converted, assist me. Holy Guardian Angel, help me; Saints and Saints of heaven, pray for me, that I may reap the regenerating fruits of penance. Amen.

In The Confessional with Padre Pio

CONFESSION CAN BE AS POWERFUL AS AN EXORCISM

In Revelation 12, we hear how the devil is The Accuser of the Brethren. He stands before God accusing us of our sins. Thankfully, in the same chapter, we are told that they (the Accused) overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb and their testimonies. Without the Blood of the Lamb, there is no remission of sin. This is why Jesus established the New and Eternal Covenant for the forgiveness of sin, as well for the reconciliation of man to God. The devil hates a good confession because the blood of the Lamb washes away the sin. This is how he loses authority over the sinner.

There's a powerful true story about an exorcist gathering his team of religious as well as lay people to begin a solemn exorcism of the church for a possessed person. When the preparations had been completed, they entered into the room to begin the exorcism, led by the chief priest. As he began to pray, the devil spoke through the possessed person in a mocking voice, and directing his conversation to those there, he began to reveal their sins, and this was very embarrassing for them. The exorcist suspended the session and ordered everyone out. He then ordered everyone to go for a thorough confession before going back in. When they went back in, and he began praying again, he was surprised that the devil was silent, so he questioned him, why was he not mentioning anyone's sins? And the devil replied because nobody had any! This is the power of confession. Wonderful!

How to make a Good Confession

Five Steps For a Good Confession

1. Examine your conscience.
2. Be sincerely sorry for your sins.
3. Confess your sins to a priest.
4. Resolve to amend your life.
5. After your confession, do the penance the priest assigns.

Procedure in the Confessional

You say:
"Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been - (state the length of time) - since my last confession. These are my sins."

Then tell your mortal sins and the number of times committed. If you have no mortal sin to confess, then confess the venial sins you have committed since your last confession. When you have finished telling your sins, you should say:
"For these and all the sins of my past, I am truly sorry."

The priest now gives the necessary advice, assigns your penance and asks you to say the Act of Contrition (in some form). Then wait and listen as the priest gives the absolution

Then say **"Thank you, Father"**, then leave the confessional and then perform the penance assigned by the priest.

The Differences in sins

There are two kinds of actual sin, **mortal** and **venial**.

Mortal sin is a horrible offense against God, so horrible that it destroys the life of grace in the soul. Three simultaneous conditions must be fulfilled for a mortal sin: (1) the act must be something very serious; (2) the person must have sufficient understanding of what is being done; (3) the person must have sufficient freedom of the will. So I cannot commit a mortal sin if the matter is not serious (e.g., if I stole a small amount of money from my employer), or if I did not know what I was doing (e.g., if I were to hurt someone accidentally or unthinkingly), or if I did not act with full freedom (e.g., I was under physical or emotional pressure).

A Catholic should know well the difference between mortal and venial sins. Deliberately missing Sunday Mass without sufficient cause is to be considered a very serious mortal sin.

Examination of Conscience

- 3. Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.**
Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation?
Have I not kept Sunday as a family day and a day of rest?
Do I do needless work on Sunday?
Do I make others work on Sunday?
- 4. Honor your father and your mother.**
Do I honor and obey my parents?
Have I neglected my duties to my spouse and children?
Have I given my family good religious example?
Do I try to bring peace into my home life?
Do I care for my aged and infirm relatives?
Do I respect my elders?
Do I respect my pastor, bishop, and the Pope?
- 5. You shall not kill.**
Have I had an abortion or encouraged anyone to have an abortion?
Have I physically harmed anyone?
Have I abused alcohol or drugs?
Did I give scandal to anyone, thereby leading them into sin?
Have I been angry or resentful?
Have I harbored hatred in my heart?
Have I been sterilized for reasons of birth control?
Have I encouraged or condoned sterilization?
- 6. You shall not commit adultery.**
Have I been faithful to my marriage vows in thought and action?
Have I engaged in any sexual activity before marriage or outside of marriage?
Have I used any method of contraception or artificial birth control?
Has each sexual act in my marriage been open to the transmission of new life?
Have I respected all members of the opposite sex, or have I thought of other people as objects?
Have I been guilty of any homosexual activity?
Do I seek to be pure in my thoughts, words and actions?
Am I careful to dress modestly, so as not to tempt others?
Have I been guilty of masturbation with myself.
- 7. You shall not steal.**
Have I stolen what is not mine?
Have I returned or made restitution for what I have stolen?
Do I waste time at work, school or at home?
Do I gamble excessively, thereby denying my family of their needs?
Do I pay my debts promptly?
Do I seek to share what I have with the poor?
- 8. You shall not bear false witness.**
Have I lied?
Have I gossiped?
Have I harmed someone's reputation?
Have I spoken behind someone else's back?
Am I critical, negative, or uncharitable in my thoughts of others?
Do I keep secret what should be kept confidential?
- 9. You shall not desire your neighbor's wife.**
Have I consented to impure thoughts? Have I caused them by impure television, movies, books, magazines or internet?
Do I pray at once to banish impure thoughts and temptations?
Do I listen to, or engage in, impure conversations or jokes?
- 10. You shall not desire your neighbor's goods.**
Am I jealous of what other people have?
Do I envy other people's families or possessions?
Am I greedy or selfish?
Are material possessions the purpose of my life?
Do I trust that God will care for all of my material and spiritual needs?

An Act of Contrition

"O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of heaven, and the pains of hell, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who art all good and deserving of all My love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen."

TRUST IN MY MERCY



Jesus says to St Faustina:

"Daughter, when you approach holy confession, this source of My mercy, My blood and the water that came from My heart always flow upon your soul and ennoble your soul. Every time you approach holy confession, immerse yourself completely in My mercy with great trust, so that I may pour upon your soul the bounty of My grace. When you approach confession, know that I myself am waiting for you in the confessional, I only hide behind the priest, but I myself act in the soul. Here the misery of the soul meets the God of mercy. Tell souls that from this source of mercy souls draw graces only through the vessel of trust. If their trust is great, My generosity has no limits. Streams of grace flood humble souls. The proud are always in poverty and misery, because My grace turns away from them to humble souls." (Diary 1602)

A SPECIAL PROMISE OF MERCY

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the Diary of St Faustina, each time in a slightly different way:

"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy" (1109).

"Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (300).

"The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (699).

EXTRAORDINARY GRACES

Our Lord is emphasising, through this promise, the infinite value of Confession and Communion as miracles of mercy. **He wants us to realise that since the Eucharist is His own Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, it is the "Fountain of Life" (300). The Eucharist is Jesus, Himself, the Living God, longing to pour Himself as Mercy into our hearts.**

Why would Our Lord feel the need to emphasise this? Because so many people do not really understand it. They either see no need to receive Holy Communion, or they receive it simply out of habit. **As St Paul explains in his letter to the Corinthians, they eat the bread or drink the cup of the Lord unworthily, "without recognising the body of the Lord" (1 Cor 11:27-29).**

In His revelations to St Faustina, Our Lord makes it very clear what He is offering us in Holy Communion and how much it hurts Him when we treat His presence with indifference:

- **"My great delight is to unite Myself with souls ... When I come to a human heart in Holy Communion, My hands are full of all kinds of graces which I want to give to the soul. But souls do not even pay any attention to Me; they leave Me to Myself and busy themselves with other things. Oh, how sad I am that souls do not recognise Love! They treat Me as a dead object" (1385)**
- **"It pains Me very much when religious souls receive the Sacrament of Love merely out of habit, as if they did not distinguish this food. I find neither faith, nor love, in their hearts. I go to such souls with great reluctance. It would be better if they did not receive Me." (1288)**
- **"How painful it is to Me that souls so seldom unite themselves to Me in Holy Communion. I wait for souls, and they are indifferent toward Me. I want to lavish My graces on them, and they do not want to accept them. They treat me as a dead object, whereas My Heart is full of love and mercy. In order that you may know at least some of My pain, imagine the most tender of mothers who has great love for her children, while those children spurn her love. Consider her pain. No one is in a position to console her. This is but a feeble image and likeness of My love." (1447)**

So, Our Lord's promise of complete forgiveness is both a reminder and a call. **It is a reminder that Jesus is truly present and truly alive in the Eucharist, filled with love for us and waiting for us to turn to Him with trust. And it is a call for us all to be washed clean in His Love through Confession and Holy Communion - no matter how terrible our sins - and begin our lives again. He is offering us a new start.**

A Nine-Day Novena:

Good Friday – Divine Mercy Sunday.

INTRODUCTION:

In *Divine Mercy in My Soul: Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*, Jesus revealed to Saint Faustina a nine-day novena that He desired be prayed in preparation for Divine Mercy Sunday. The novena was to begin on Good Friday and be prayed each day of the Triduum and of Easter Week in preparation for the glorious Feast of Mercy which was to take place on the Eighth Day of Easter (The Sunday after Easter Day) (See Diary #1209-1230).

During this novena that Jesus Himself revealed to Saint Faustina, He asks that each day be dedicated to prayers for a different group of people. The novena comes from these private revelations of Saint Faustina as recorded in her Diary of Divine Mercy.

"I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fount of My mercy, that they may draw there from strength and refreshment and whatever graces they need in the hardships of life and, especially, at the hour of death. On each day you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls, and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy, and I will bring all these souls into the house of My Father. You will do this in this life and in the next.

I will deny nothing to any soul whom you will bring to the fount of My mercy. On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My bitter Passion, for graces for these souls."

After the **prayer and meditation each day, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and the Litany of Divine Mercy should be prayed.** (These prayers are at the end of this feature)



The Divine Mercy Novena

DAY 1 (Good Friday)

Today bring to Me **ALL MANKIND, ESPECIALLY ALL SINNERS**, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. In this way you will console Me in the bitter grief into which the loss of souls plunges Me. Most Merciful Jesus, whose very nature it is to have compassion on us and to forgive us, do not look upon our sins but upon our trust which we place in Your infinite goodness. Receive us all into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart, and never let us escape from It. We beg this of You by Your love which unites You to the Father and the Holy Spirit. Oh omnipotence of Divine Mercy, Salvation of sinful people, You are a sea of mercy and compassion; You aid those who treat You with humility.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon all mankind and especially upon poor sinners, all enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion show us Your mercy, that we may praise the omnipotence of Your mercy for ever and ever. Amen.

Now pray the **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** and the **Litany of Divine Mercy**. (See the end of this feature)

DAY 2 (Holy Saturday)

Today bring to Me **THE SOULS OF PRIESTS AND RELIGIOUS**, and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy. It was they who gave Me strength to endure My bitter Passion. Through them as through channels My mercy flows out upon mankind. Most Merciful Jesus, from whom comes all that is good, increase Your grace in men and women consecrated to Your service, that they may perform worthy works of mercy; and that all who see them may glorify the Father of Mercy who is in Heaven. The fountain of God's love Dwells in pure hearts, Bathed in the Sea of Mercy Radiant as stars, bright as the dawn.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the company of chosen ones in Your vineyard—upon the souls of priests and religious; and endow them with the strength of Your blessing. For the love of the Heart of Your Son in which they are enfolded, impart to them Your power and light, that they may be able to guide others in the way of salvation and with one voice sing praise to Your boundless mercy for ages without end. Amen.

Now pray the **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** and the **Litany of Divine Mercy**. (See the end of this feature)

DAY 3 (Easter Sunday)

Today bring to Me **ALL DEVOUT AND FAITHFUL SOULS**, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. The souls brought Me consolation on the Way of the Cross. They were that drop of consolation in the midst of an ocean of bitterness. Most Merciful Jesus, from the treasury of Your mercy, You impart Your graces in great abundance to each and all. Receive us into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart and never let us escape from It. We beg this grace of You by that most wondrous love for the heavenly



Father with which Your Heart burns so fiercely. The miracles of mercy are impenetrable. Neither the sinner nor just one will fathom them. When You cast upon us an eye of pity, You draw us all closer to Your love.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon faithful souls, as upon the inheritance of Your Son. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, grant them Your blessing and surround them with Your constant protection. Thus may they never fail in love or lose the treasure of the holy faith, but rather, with all the hosts of Angels and Saints, may they glorify Your boundless mercy for endless ages. Amen.

Now pray the **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** and the **Litany of Divine Mercy**. (See the end of this feature)

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DAY 4 (Easter Monday)

Today bring to Me **THOSE WHO DO NOT BELIEVE IN GOD AND THOSE WHO DO NOT YET KNOW ME**. I was thinking also of them during My bitter Passion, and their future zeal comforted My Heart. Immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. Most compassionate Jesus, You are the Light of the whole world. Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who do not believe in God and of those who as yet do not know You. Let the rays of Your grace enlighten them that they, too, together with us, may extol Your wonderful mercy; and do not let them escape from the abode which is Your Most Compassionate Heart. May the light of Your love Enlighten the souls in darkness; Grant that these souls will know You And, together with us, praise Your mercy.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls of those who do not believe in You, and of those who as yet do not know You, but who are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Draw them to the light of the Gospel. These souls do not know what great happiness it is to love You. Grant that they, too, may extol the generosity of Your mercy for endless ages. Amen.

Now pray the **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** and the **Litany of Divine Mercy**. (See the end of this feature)



DAY 5 (Easter Tuesday)

Today bring to Me **THE SOULS OF THOSE WHO HAVE SEPARATED THEMSELVES FROM MY CHURCH**, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. During My bitter Passion they tore at My Body and Heart, that is, My Church. As they return to unity with the Church, My wounds heal and in this way they alleviate My Passion. Most Merciful Jesus, Goodness Itself, You do not refuse light to those who seek it of You. Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who have separated themselves from Your Church. Draw them by Your light into the unity of the Church, and do not let them escape from the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart; but bring it about that they, too, come to glorify the generosity of Your mercy. Even for those who have torn the garment of your unity, A fount of mercy flows from Your Heart. The omnipotence of Your mercy, Oh God. Can lead these souls also out of error.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls of those who have separated themselves from Your Son's Church, who have squandered Your blessings and misused Your graces by obstinately persisting in their errors. Do not look upon their errors, but upon the love of Your own Son and upon His bitter Passion, which He underwent for their sake, since they, too, are enclosed in His Most Compassionate Heart. Bring it about that they also may glorify Your great mercy for endless ages. Amen.

Now pray the **Chaplet of Divine Mercy** and the **Litany of Divine Mercy**. (See the end of this feature)

DAY 6 (Easter Wednesday)

Today bring to Me **THE MEEK AND HUMBLE SOULS AND THE SOULS OF LITTLE CHILDREN**, and immerse them in My mercy. These souls most closely resemble My Heart. They strengthened Me during My bitter agony. I saw them as earthly Angels,

who will keep vigil at My altars. I pour out upon them whole torrents of grace. Only the humble soul is capable of receiving My grace. I favour humble souls with My confidence. Most Merciful Jesus, You yourself have said, "Learn from Me for I am meek and humble of heart." Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart all meek and humble souls and the souls of little children. These souls send all Heaven into ecstasy and they are the Heavenly Father's favourites. They are a sweet-smelling bouquet before the throne of God; God Himself takes delight in their fragrance. These souls have a permanent abode in Your Most Compassionate Heart, O Jesus, and they unceasingly sing out a hymn of love and mercy. "A truly gentle and humble soul, Already here on earth the air of paradise breathes, And in the fragrance of her humble heart, The Creator Himself delights."



Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon meek souls, upon humble souls, and upon little children who are enfolded in the abode which is the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. These souls bear the closest resemblance to Your Son. Their fragrance rises from the earth and reaches Your very throne. Father of mercy and of all goodness, I beg You by the love You bear these souls and by the delight You take in them: Bless the whole world, that all souls together may sing out the praises of Your mercy for endless ages. Amen.

DAY 7 (Easter Thursday)

Today bring to Me **THE SOULS WHO ESPECIALLY VENERATE AND GLORIFY MY MERCY**, and immerse them in My mercy. These souls sorrowed most over my Passion and entered most deeply into My spirit. They are living images of My Compassionate Heart. These souls will shine with a special brightness in the next life. Not one of them will go into the fire of hell. I shall particularly defend each one of them at the hour of death. Most Merciful Jesus, whose Heart is Love Itself, receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who particularly extol and venerate the greatness of Your mercy. These souls are mighty with the very power of God Himself. In the midst of all afflictions and adversities they go forward, confident of Your mercy; and united to You, O Jesus, they carry all mankind on their shoulders. These souls will not be judged severely, but Your mercy will embrace them as they depart from this life. A soul who praises the goodness of her Lord is especially loved by Him. She is always close to the living fountain And draws graces from Mercy Divine.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls who glorify and venerate Your greatest attribute, that of Your fathomless mercy, and who are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. These souls are a living Gospel; their hands are full of deeds of mercy, and their hearts, overflowing with joy, sing a canticle of mercy to You, O Most High! I beg You O God: Show them Your mercy according to the hope and trust they have placed in You. Let there be accomplished in them the promise of Jesus, who said to them, I Myself will defend as My own glory, during their lifetime, and especially at the hour of their death, those souls who will venerate My fathomless mercy. Amen.

DAY 8 (Easter Friday)

Today bring to Me **THE SOULS WHO ARE DETAINED IN PURGATORY**, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy. Let the torrents of My Blood cool down their scorching flames. All these souls are greatly loved by Me. They are making retribution to My justice. It is in your power to bring them relief. Draw all the indulgences from the treasury of My Church and offer them on their behalf. Oh, if you only knew the torments they suffer, you would continually offer for them the alms of the spirit and pay off their debt to My justice. Most Merciful Jesus, You Yourself have said that You desire mercy; so I bring into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls in Purgatory, souls who are very dear to You, and yet, who must make retribution to Your justice. May the streams of Blood and

Water which gushed forth from Your Heart put out the flames of Purgatory, that there, too, the power of Your mercy may be celebrated. From that terrible heat of the cleansing fire Rises a plaint to Your mercy, And they receive comfort, refreshment, relief In the stream of mingled Blood and Water.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls suffering in Purgatory, who are enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. I beg You, by the sorrowful Passion of Jesus Your Son, and by all the bitterness with which His most sacred Soul was flooded: Manifest Your mercy to the souls who are under Your just scrutiny. Look upon them in no other way but only through the Wounds of Jesus, Your dearly beloved Son; for we firmly believe that there is no limit to Your goodness and compassion. Amen.

DAY 9 (Easter Saturday)

Today bring to Me **SOULS WHO HAVE BECOME LUKEWARM**, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy. These souls wound My Heart most painfully. My soul suffered the most dreadful loathing in the Garden of Olives because of lukewarm souls. They were the reason I cried out: 'Father, take this cup away from Me, if it be Your will.' For them, the last hope of salvation is to run to My mercy. Most compassionate Jesus, You are Compassion Itself. I bring lukewarm souls into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart. In this fire of Your pure love, let these tepid souls, who, like corpses, filled You with such deep loathing, be once again set aflame. O Most Compassionate Jesus, exercise the omnipotence of Your mercy and draw them into the very ardor of Your love, and bestow upon them the gift of holy love, for nothing is beyond Your power. Fire and ice cannot be joined, Either the fire dies, or the ice melts. But by Your mercy, O God, You can make up for all that is lacking.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon lukewarm souls who are nonetheless enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Father of Mercy, I beg You by the bitter Passion of Your Son and by His three-hour agony on the Cross: Let them, too, glorify the abyss of Your mercy. Amen.

1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and 1 Apostles' Creed.

Then on the 'Our Father' Beads say the following:

Leader: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ,

Others: ***in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.***

On the 10 'Hail Mary' Beads say the following:

Leader: **For the sake of His sorrowful Passion,**

Others: ***have mercy on us and on the whole world.***

Repeat for all five decades.

Conclude with (three times):

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

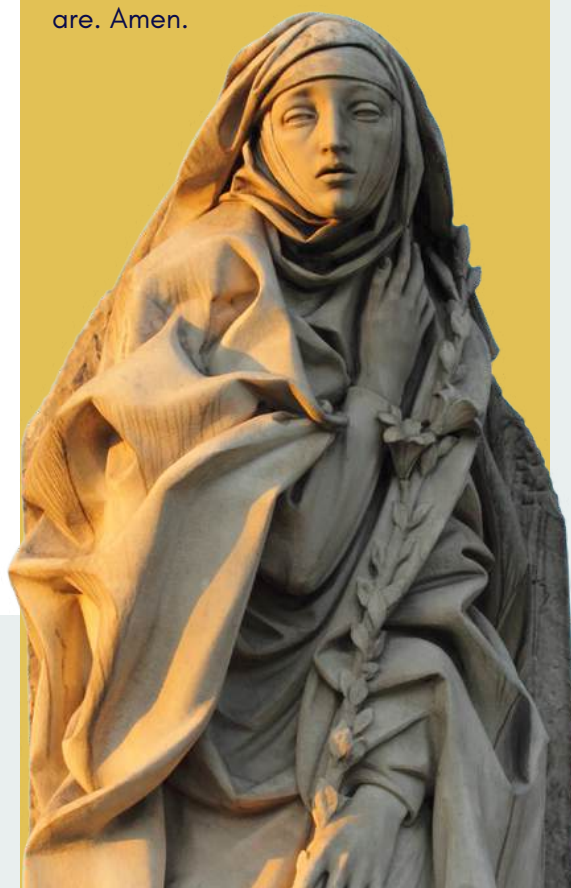

MAY - THE MONTH OF MARY

Act of Consecration by Pope Pius XII

Most Holy Virgin Mary, tender Mother of men, to fulfil the desires of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the request of the Vicar of Your Son on earth, we consecrate ourselves and our families to your Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart, O Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, and we recommend to You, all the people of our country and all the world. Please accept our consecration, dearest Mother, and use us as You wish to accomplish Your designs in the world. O Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, and Queen of the World, rule over us, together with the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ, Our King. Save us from the spreading flood of modern paganism; kindle in our hearts and homes the love of purity, the practice of a virtuous life, an ardent zeal for souls, and a desire to pray the Rosary more faithfully. We come with confidence to You, O Throne of Grace and Mother of Fair Love. Inflame us with the same Divine Fire which has inflamed Your own Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart. Make our hearts and homes Your shrine, and through us, make the Heart of Jesus, together with your heart, rule and triumph in every home. Amen.

Remembering Our Lady of Fatima Apparition on 13 May 1917

First, the Angel of Portugal appears to the Children of Fatima

Sister Lucia, the last living seer of Fatima who died in 2005, recorded in her memoirs several visions of angels prior to the appearances of the Blessed Virgin in 1917. On each of these occasions, an angel "appeared in the form of a young man, transparent and much brighter than crystal pierced by the rays of the sun." During the first visitation in spring 1916, the angel told the children:



"Fear not. I am the Angel of Peace. Pray with me." Kneeling and then bowing his head to the ground, the angel taught the children a prayer: **"My God, I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love Thee. I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust and do not love Thee."**

During the second visit, the angel again directed the children to adore God and to love their neighbour: "Pray a great deal. The Hearts of Jesus and Mary have designs of mercy on you. Offer up prayers and sacrifices to the Most High."

Lucia asked: "How are we to make sacrifices?"

The angel answered:

"Make everything you do a sacrifice and offer it as an act of reparation for the sins by which God is offended, and in supplication for the conversion of sinners. Bring peace to your country in this way. Above all, accept and bear with submission the sufferings sent you by Our Lord."

In the last apparition of the angel, some six months before the Blessed Virgin appeared to the children, **the Angel of Peace taught the children to offer themselves with Jesus to the Father in the Holy Eucharist.** He also taught them to adore Jesus' Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament. The angel, bearing the Holy Eucharist, adored Christ with the children and gave them Holy Communion. The Angel taught them another prayer that they made their own:

"Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference by which He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His most Sacred Heart, and of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg the conversion of poor sinners."

Then the angel gave the Host to Lucia, and the contents of the chalice to Jacinta and Francisco. For Jacinta and Francisco, seven and nine years old, this was their first Holy Communion. As he gave them the Eucharist, he said:

"Take and drink the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, horribly outraged by ungrateful men. Repair their crimes and console your God."

Francisco was not aware that he had received Holy Communion from the hands of the angel. However, by the work of the Holy Spirit, he recognised and adored the Real Presence of Christ in his body and soul. A few days after the event he asked Lucia: "The angel gave you Holy Communion, but what was it he gave Jacinta and me?"

She replied, "It was Holy Communion too. Didn't you see that it was the blood that fell from the Host?"

Francisco answered: "I felt that God was within me, but I did not know how."

Lucia wrote of the impact the apparitions of the angel had had on her and her younger cousins: "The angel's words made a deep impression on our minds, like a light making us understand who God is, how He loves us and desires to be loved, as well as the value of sacrifice; how pleasing it is to Him and how, on account of it, He grants the grace of conversion to sinners."

The Blessed Virgin Mary Appears to the Children of Fatima for the first time

On 13 May, 1917, the children saw the Mother of God for the first time. Lucia's first impressions are noteworthy:

"We beheld a lady all dressed in white. She was more brilliant than the sun, and radiated a light more clear and intense than a crystal glass filled with sparkling water when the rays of the burning sun shine through it."

The vision of the Blessed Mother was the first and, in a sense, the most important of Heaven's lessons to the young children who spoke frequently of Mary's beauty, her kindness, and especially of the wonderful light that shone all about her. They knew that she was from heaven. They perceived that the light she radiated was the effulgence of God Himself. They knew, without being able to articulate it, that Mary existed in a glorified body, sharing physically in her Son's triumph over sin and death. The children were not "annihilated" by her presence as they had been by the presence of the angel, but rather felt the joy and security of a mother's love. In her presence, they sensed the presence and love of God.

The first thing Mary did for the children was to steal their natural fear of death from them. They discovered that life exists beyond the confines of this world, beyond the barrier of the grave.



Mary told them: **"I am from Heaven."**

Lucia, speaking for the three, said: **"Will I go to heaven too? And Jacinta and Francisco?"**

Mary told them that they would. From that moment, the children no longer feared death and, in fact, began to long to be with God and Mary in Heaven. In the apparitions, the children experienced the presence of the Holy Trinity. Referring to the May apparition, Lucia said:

"Our Lady opened her hands for the first time, communicating to us a light so intense that, as it streamed from her hands, its rays penetrated our hearts and the innermost depths of our souls, making us see ourselves in God, who is that light, more clearly than we see ourselves in the best of mirrors."

Then, moved by an interior impulse that was also communicated to us, we fell to our knees repeating in our hearts:

"O most Blessed Trinity, I adore you. My God, my God, I love you in the Most Blessed Sacrament."

The phenomenon of experiencing God in the presence of Mary was repeated more strongly in the June apparition. Lucia observed:

"As Our Lady spoke the words, 'I will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God,' she opened her hands and for the second time she communicated to us the rays of that same intense light. We saw ourselves in this light, as it were, immersed in God. In the front of the palm of Our Lady's right hand was a heart encircled by thorns that pierced it. We understood that this was the Immaculate Heart of Mary, outraged by the sins of humanity, and seeking reparation."

Francisco recognised and sought to explain the phenomenon of God manifested through Mary's Heart:

"These people are so happy just because you [Lucia] told them that Our Lady wants the Rosary said, and that you are to learn to read. How would they feel if they only knew what she showed us in God, in her Immaculate Heart, in that great light?"

On another occasion, Francisco said to Lucia:

"I loved seeing the angel, but I loved still more seeing Our Lady. What I loved most of all was to see Our Lord in that light from Our Lady which penetrated our hearts."

In permitting the children to experience the mysteries of Mary's Immaculate Conception, her Spiritual Motherhood, and her Assumption into Heaven, God gave them a deep and penetrating knowledge of themselves. **They described the "light" as piercing their hearts, causing them to know themselves in God. From this knowledge, they acquired a great hatred for sin as well as a desire to live only for God.** God also communicated to the children a deep knowledge of Himself and a yearning for eternal life. **Mary led them not only to know about God, but to know him truly in a deeply interior, personal way. This knowledge gave birth to a love that weaned them instantaneously from fear of suffering and death.**

The 5 Fatima Prayers

Fatima Prayer

O My Jesus, forgive us our sins,
save us from the fires of hell,
lead all souls to Heaven,
especially those in most need of

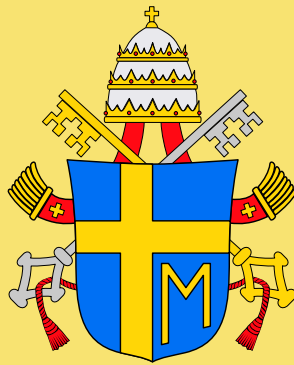

Connection with Pope John Paul II and his being shot on 13 May 1981 on the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima



Throughout the course of his pontificate, His Holiness Pope John Paul II frequently invited the members of the Church to contemplate the significance of Mary's apparitions at Fatima. John Paul first journeyed to Fatima, Portugal in May of 1982, to thank the Blessed Virgin for what he believes to be her direct intervention in the brutal attempt on his life that took place in Saint Peter's Square on 13 May, 1981.

1981: Thousands see the Pope shot in Rome on 13th May

The Pope was shot four times as he blessed the crowds in St Peter's Square in Rome. Surgeons performed a five-hour operation and said they hoped he would make a full recovery. At about 17:15 local time, as he was being driven in his Popemobile through a crowd of about 20,000 worshippers, he was hit by four bullets fired from a 9mm pistol some 15 feet away. Two struck him in the stomach, one in his right arm and the fourth hit his little finger. Police arrested a 23-year-old man who said he was a Turkish citizen and gave his name as Mehmet Ali Agca. He kept repeating: "I couldn't care less about life."

The Turkish press reported Agca was jailed for the killing of Turkish newspaper editor Abdi Ipekci in February 1979. But he escaped from prison and left behind a letter vowing to kill the pontiff just before the Pope visited Turkey in 1979.

Horrificed witnesses

Many of those who witnessed the shooting in the crowded square burst into tears, or screamed and fell to their knees in disbelief. The Pope collapsed and was driven at speed into the Vatican complex and from there by ambulance to hospital. Vatican Radio has appealed to the world to pray for his survival.

The Queen and the Archbishop of Canterbury expressed their shock and deep sympathy for the Pope and his followers. Pope John Paul II, formerly Cardinal Karol Wojtyla of Poland, became Pope in 1978. He was the first non-Italian pope in 455 years.

Pope John Paul II believed the Blessed Virgin Mary saved his life

In gratitude for saving his life, the Pope gave Our Lady of Fatima the gift of one of the bullets from the shooting, by having it placed inside the crown of the Statue of Our Lady of Fatima in Fatima itself.
