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Whether through prayer, healing ministry, teaching, evangelisation, Marian devotion, community support or spiritual formation, our hope has always been to help people encounter the love, healing, mercy and presence of God in a deeper and more personal way.

And as the world grows increasingly noisy and distracted, I believe the Lord is calling many people back to the simplicity and beauty of prayer once again.

One of the greatest signs of encouragement for us over recent months has been the continued growth of the **54-Day Rosary Novena mission**. What began as a simple initiative of prayer has gradually grown into an international Rosary movement, bringing together individuals, families, prayer groups and communities from different parts of the world, united through prayer and devotion to Our Blessed Mother. As I share this we can reveal that **we now have over 400 members in our public WhatsApp group and around 60 Leaders helping to manage and run the live rosaries**. In these times, I truly believe the Rosary is becoming more important than ever. Our Heavenly Mother told us that the devotion to her and the Rosary will protect us from the **Great Deception** that is coming to the world. Through the Rosary we meditate upon the life of Jesus Christ with Mary. We place ourselves under her maternal protection and allow Our Lord to bring peace, healing, conversion and grace into our lives, our families and the world around us.

As we look ahead prayerfully toward the future of this mission, one of the great hopes we carry in our hearts is to help inspire the offering of:

One Million Rosaries to Heaven by the end of 2027.

This is not simply a number or a campaign goal. Rather, it is a spiritual offering of love, intercession and prayer that we hope may rise to Heaven from countless hearts, as beautifully scented bouquets, throughout the world during these important times, rising up to our heavenly Mother's hands to be presented to our God on our behalf and with our intentions.

We warmly invite everyone — individuals, families, prayer groups, parishes and communities — to help us achieve this vision together.

Every Rosary matters.

Every prayer counts.

Every soul is precious.

Every intention is heard.

Everything done in faith and with love will prevail.

And we believe that prayer, in the name of Jesus, truly has the power to bring healing, protection, conversion and spiritual renewal to countless lives. As the 54-Day Rosary Novena continues to grow, we are also prayerfully exploring ways of helping parishes and communities participate more fully in this growing international prayer movement.

Our Lady prepared us for the 45th anniversary of her Medjugorje apparitions, 25th June 2026, with a novena, appearing 9 consecutive nights at Apparition Hill from the 16th June. Each night Mary had a theme or request:

16th June: Spend day in prayer

17th June: Pray for the unborn

18th June: Pray for souls in purgatory, to heal the family tree

19th June: Prepare for eternal life,

leave behind a good spiritual legacy

20th June: Love God and glorify God with your whole heart

21st June: Spend three days prayer and abstinence

22nd June: Pray for peace

23rd June: joyful presence

24th June: Mother Mary thanks us for every offered sacrifice, penance and every prayer during the novena:

"Neither you, nor your children, nor your children's children will regret it."
Pray for family past, present & future.

helping parish priests, bishops, prayer groups and parishioners better understand the Novena and more easily join the live Rosary gatherings. Our hope is that this outreach may eventually include:

- **introductory cover letters for parish priests and bishops**
- **a new annual 54-Day Rosary Novena magazine**
- **testimonies and reflections from participants**
- **simple "how to join" guides**
- **parish notice board posters**
- **leaflets and promotional literature**
- **practical support materials to help parishes share the Novena**

We pray that through these efforts many more people may discover the beauty and spiritual power of the Rosary and become part of a wider global family united in prayer. **We are also delighted to welcome Karolina and Sonia as our new Mission to Parish Liaison Coordinators**, helping support this growing outreach to parishes and dioceses. Working together with the wider mission team, they will be helping prayerfully develop parish support resources and assist in making the mission more visible and accessible to parish communities who may wish to participate in the Rosary Novena and wider Jesus4usall.com outreach. I am sure that this will open up more opportunities to provide many Parish Resources for the Development and Evangelisation of Parishes and the wider community. Please keep them in your prayers as they begin this important area of service for the mission.

At the same time, we continue exploring ways of better harmonising our various prayer platforms and outreach channels, including WhatsApp groups, Zoom gatherings, YouTube broadcasts and Facebook Live streams. Our hope is to help create a more connected and accessible international prayer community, enabling people from many nations and backgrounds to participate together more easily in prayer, fellowship and evangelisation. Technology, when used wisely and prayerfully, can become a powerful instrument for spreading the Gospel and bringing people together in faith and prayer across great distances.

One of the most encouraging aspects of this mission over recent years has been seeing how so many volunteers continue stepping forward to offer their gifts, talents and time in service to God and His people. **We are therefore also delighted to welcome Rahela as our new video editor**, helping support the development of a new series of short explainer videos designed to assist members in navigating the Jesus4usall.com website and online community. In her preliminary checks of our website she found that we were in want of some of the basic legal requirements regarding cookie preferences, privacy policy and the legal framework of who we are and what we do. To add to this, we have taken a further step into introducing a comprehensive legal document which covers many aspects of our website and online website community, including our terms and conditions and our donation policy, among other things. Thanks to Rahela for being proactive in

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this matter, it's because of this that we are producing a comprehensive range of governance documents, and also include our existing documentation, such as our Members & Volunteers Handbook; our 54-Day Rosary Novena Guidance etc. These will all be available from the website.

As the mission continues to grow, we increasingly recognise that many people today are searching not only for prayer, but also for spiritual formation, healing, encouragement and discipleship where there is a sense of belonging to a movement that is making a difference to people's lives. For this reason, **another exciting area we are now prayerfully developing through the Jesus4usall.com Academy is the packaging and expansion of many of the live Zoom Events and Seminars we have been running over the past several years.** Our hope is to make these programmes available not only online, but also as practical formation resources that can be used within parishes, prayer groups, ministries and organisations for their own spiritual development, outreach and evangelisation.

Initially, we hope to focus on areas such as our monthly:

- Penitential Healing Service (1st Friday Devotion to the Sacred Heart)
- Empowerment Service (Renewal & Empowerment)
- Healing Service (Inner healing, healing and deliverance)

Then to introduce our annual seasonal seminars:

- Advent Seminars (7 weeks)
- Lent Seminars (7 weeks)
- Easter to Pentecost Seminars (7 weeks)

As these resources gradually develop, our prayer is that they may help equip and encourage others to confidently lead prayer gatherings, renewal programmes and evangelisation initiatives within their own churches, ministries, groups and organisations.

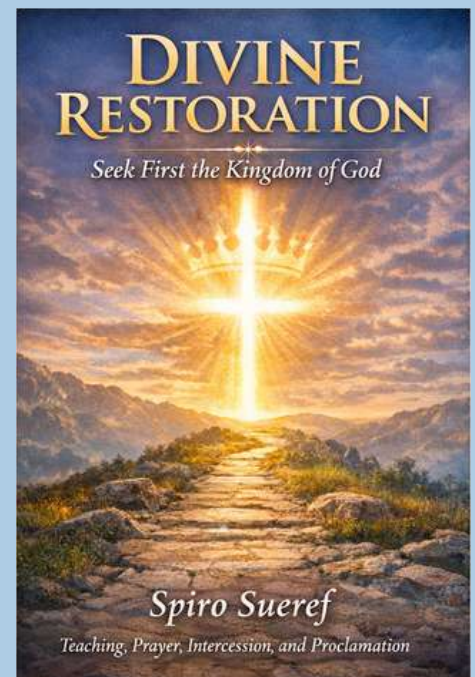
The vision is not simply to host online meetings, but to help raise up disciples, prayer leaders and evangelisers who can themselves become instruments of encouragement, healing and renewal for others within their own Parishes and their wider communities.

For this reason, we are also prayerfully exploring the development of:

- **Leaders' manuals**
- PowerPoint and video presentation packages
- **Certification for those completing the various programmes**

As part of this wider vision for community and formation, we are also prayerfully exploring the possibility of future regional gatherings and renewal events, including potential meetings in London and North Wales, around the UK, and later on, mainland Europe. 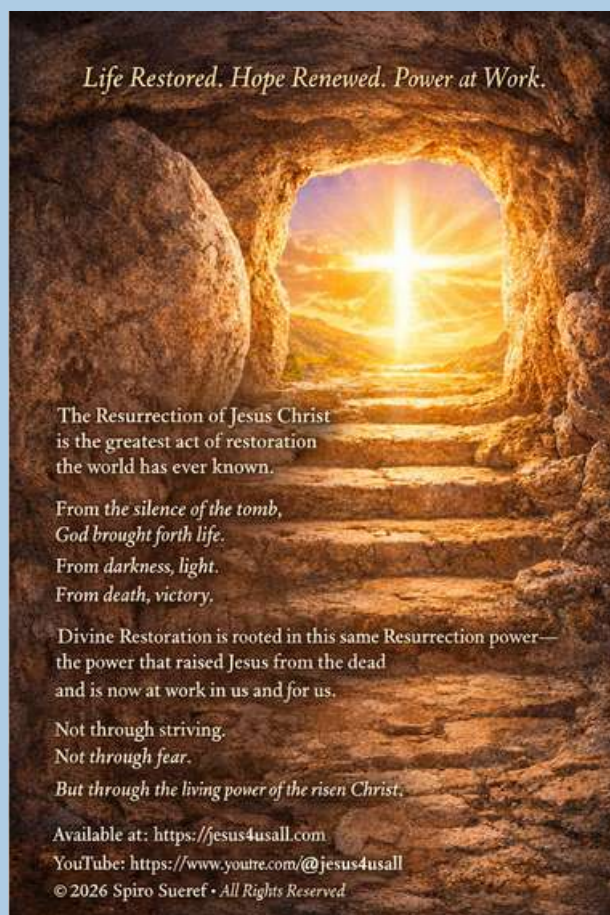
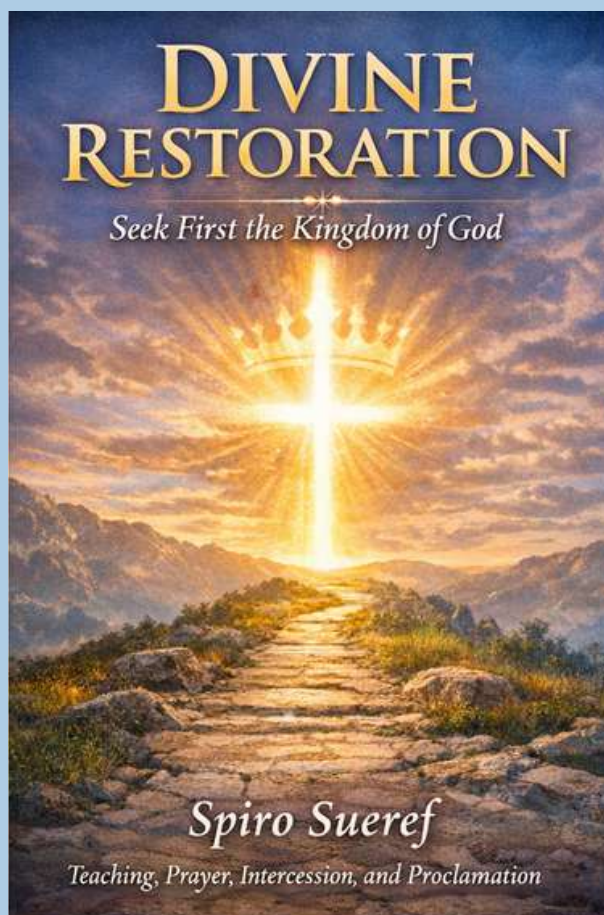

God's Timing

Just as Spiro completed drafting out this new eBook, he received a message from someone whose testimony was in Spiro's first book, **"Coming Boldly to the Throne of Grace"**. She is a lady, a single mother, from Lesotho, South Africa. Her message was to ask Spiro for prayer because she was going through some challenging times. Her testimony in the first book was now nearly six years ago, when her little baby boy was only five months old. He was miraculously healed, as the testimony in the book explains. **This lady's name is Puseletso**, and when Spiro heard from her, being happy to hear from her, Spiro was wondering if she could let us know how she had been since the miracle. During their conversation, Spiro became curious about the pronunciation of her name "Puseletso" and what her name meant. When **Puseletso explained that her name meant "restoration"**, it was obvious to both of them when Spiro explained the title of his new eBook that this chance encounter was providential and that God was doing something new.

In the following pages, you will read Puseletso's original testimony from nearly six years ago, November 2020, as well as her experiences as Spiro prayed for her when she reached out for prayer earlier this year, 2026. It's an incredible story, and **what's more incredible, is our wonderful God, who is eager to restore us**. This is what the eBook is about... Divine Restoration in all our lives.

Puseletso's lifeless baby boy miraculously healed in November 2020. Now the Lord is doing a new work!

My name is Puseletso Patana and I am from Lesotho, South Africa. I first met brother Spiro through his Facebook Prayer Group, managed by [Jesus4UsAll.com](https://www.jesus4usall.com), which is part of brother Spiro's International Mission. When I met him, it was under his Facebook name, "Jesus Emanuel", so that's how I knew him back then.

Around 2nd November 2020, my little five-month-old baby was taken into hospital and into the ICU [Intensive Care Unit] because he was seriously sick. My baby developed a fever around that time and then I took him to the local hospital in my district.

'My baby is almost lifeless in ICU'

There, they assessed my baby and requested to take him as an emergency to the larger regional hospital in the area. They took him with the ambulance. Once there, they carried out some tests and then moved him immediately to the ICU as a serious case. My baby was tired and off-colour, almost lifeless.

When the doctors told me they needed to take him to the ICU, I lost hope and I almost gave up on him being able to recover from the way he was; I could see there was something very seriously wrong with him. It was a terrible and very distressing time for me.

'In my distress I turned to God'

I remember November 2020, when this happened, I was very distressed, especially, as a single mother. I didn't know where or who to turn to except to God, to ask for my baby's healing. I went to Facebook and began looking for someone who could pray for my baby. That's how I came to know the [Jesus4UsAll.com](https://www.jesus4usall.com) prayer group, '[Prayer Request to Jesus](https://www.jesus4usall.com)' and I posted my urgent Request there around the beginning of November. I did get a lot of people responding to me, saying that they were praying for me and my baby. I even got the owner, the administrator of the group, "Jesus Emanuel" [Spiro], replying, saying he was praying for a

miraculous healing for my baby boy. I didn't know Jesus Emanuel at the time, nor that he was in fact Spiro, but he reached out to me and asked if I would like him to pray for my baby.

'Even allowing a phone call in ICU was a miracle to me'

Although the ICU would not allow phones, on this occasion, it was a miracle to me that they allowed brother Spiro [Jesus Emanuel] to call me. Just to give you the scene in the ICU so you understand the environment we were in; doctors were monitoring everything about the baby. Knowing my baby's condition and the distress I was in, they allowed me to continue with brother Spiro. I could tell by their faces that they were curious as to what would happen.

I was so distressed that Spiro asked me to calm down and then he waited. That's how distressed I was. I couldn't stop crying, and so brother Spiro calmed me down and said he wanted to pray for me first, before praying for the baby. As he prayed for me, guiding me through forgiveness and the cancellation of judgements, I felt the power of God coming upon me like never before. This was a new experience for me.

I began shaking under the power of God and I began to speak out in the gift of the Holy Spirit called "tongues". I began to feel heat and I was trembling and then I felt a hand on my right shoulder. I felt someone standing behind me and that's when I began speaking in tongues. All the fear, anxiety and distress left me and I had

joy and peace flowing out of my heart and whilst my emotions were mixed, my hope came back.

'My son's colour started returning'

Then brother Spiro asked me if the baby had been baptised. He had not been, so brother suggested we do an emergency baptism. I got a glass of water and baptised my baby under the guidance of brother Spiro. Then I was asked to allow for my hands to be commissioned for the service of God. I agreed. And my hands were commissioned for God. Then I was asked to place my hands on my baby. At once, my boy began shaking. As we were on a voice call and brother Spiro could not see my baby, he would periodically ask me for feedback, and so I explained what was happening while Spiro guided me in prayer. As soon as I put my hands on my baby under the anointing, **his normal colour began to come back**; he was purple, but now his healthy colour returned immediately. His shaking turned to normal movements as if he was waking up, and then he slept in his normal way. I just knew that he was sleeping normally and that he would wake up totally well. After brother Spiro prayed for my baby, the doctors were amazed and named him

Puseletso's life since the miracle

This miracle with my baby being restored back to health all happened over five years ago. So after my baby was miraculously healed, we went home from hospital and "Blessing" was a healthy baby boy.

As he was growing up, following some medical interventions in his childhood, he developed autism. At around one-year-old, my baby started to show signs that he was not responding to my voice. This troubled me and it was a hard and sad time since before the interventions he would hear and respond to me fine. He also became hyperactive.

This was the situation when I made contact again with brother Spiro. Brother Spiro did not know about any of these things that had happened to my baby son.

I remember the day when brother Spiro called me on WhatsApp and we began talking about my situation and the difficulties I was having with my son's condition.

Brother Spiro explained that since my testimony of healing was featured in his book "Coming Boldly to the Throne of Grace", it would be nice if I could join a live Zoom meeting to share what happened five years ago in the miracle healing of my baby in the hospital ICU.

What does "Puseletso" mean?

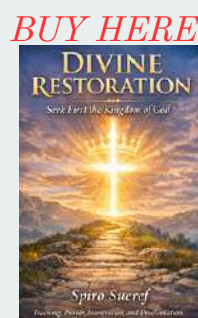

I am happy to know brother Spiro because every time we pray, I find myself in another dimension, in the spirit, as if in heavenly realms. One time he prayed over me I could smell perfume, a heavenly aroma. I feel weak under the power of God, His love and His presence. I feel cared for; I feel heat, joy, I feel I am a winner, a conqueror; it's amazing; I wish you all could feel this. To God, we give thanks, and to Jesus, be all the glory, now and forever. Amen.

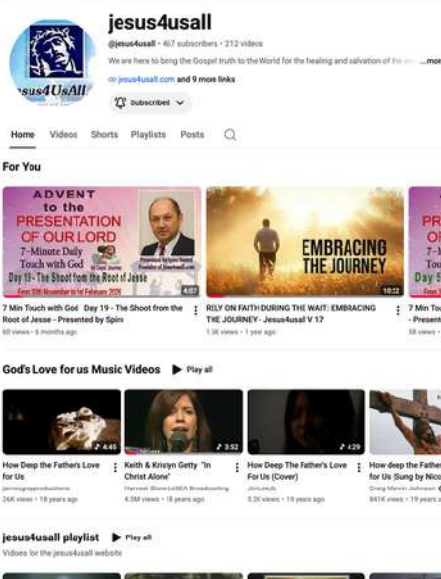

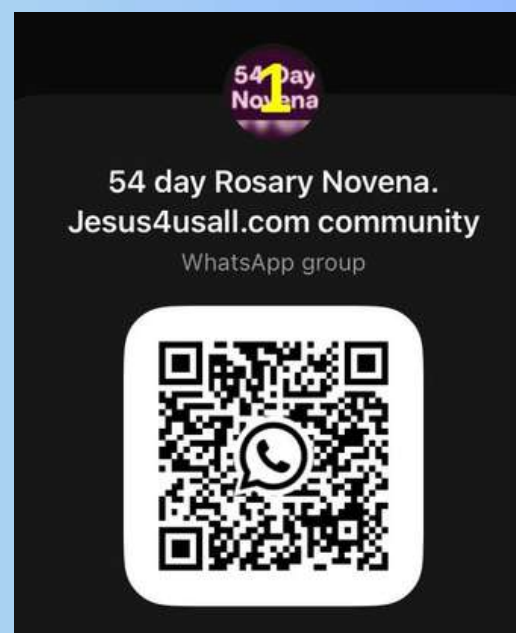

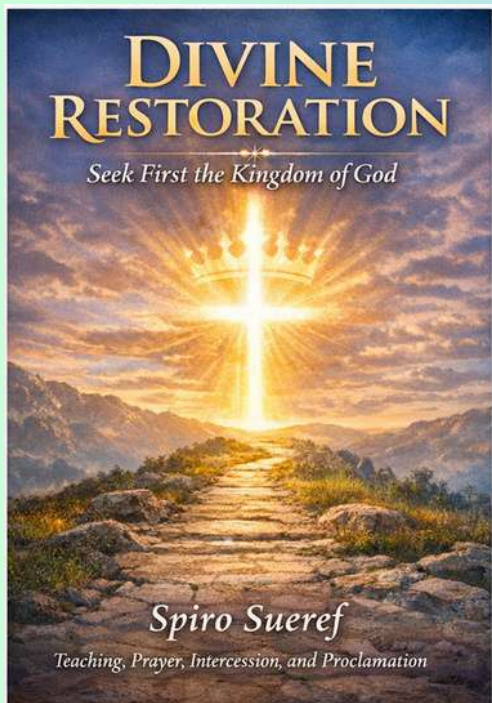

The foundation of Christian generosity begins with God Himself.

Long before the early Church supported missionaries and cared for the poor, Scripture revealed God as the great giver and provider.

Moses reminded Israel:

“Remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth.” — Deuteronomy 8:18

Everything ultimately belongs to God:

My name is Sylvia, and I am from France. In November 2021, I went to Lourdes with my parish. My name is Tracey. I met up with my dear friend Charlotte one day for a swim. She was picking up quite a lot from me: themes of **unforgiveness, resentment and anger**. We left the swimming pool earlier than planned and went to pray in her car. **She took out Spiro's book, "Coming Boldly to the Throne of Grace". She was drawn to a certain page in the book which was about the father wound.** I found it very moving and also totally relevant to what I was feeling at the time. I began to question my yearning for spiritual guidance. It has set me on a path to explore this further. I then had a one-to-one prayer ministry session with Spiro. I am not baptised, but he explained to me about my path to the Catholic faith. **Spiro led me in prayer and all my resentment and anger was lifted from me and I was able to forgive myself and others.** All throughout that day things were happening that couldn't be explained. My son had sent a prayer to me in the morning and I had felt the Lord's presence with me all day. **I feel lighter and unburdened knowing that God has a plan for me.**



SPIRO'S BOOK BRINGS HEALING TO TRACEY

Charlotte's testimony: 'I had a nudge to give Tracey my friend Spiro's book. Two days later I saw her transformed, full of life and joy'

My name is Charlotte from the UK and I've been a volunteer at Jesus4UsAll.

com for seven months. I was received into the Catholic Church on Easter Saturday, after being saved from living and working in the new age world for 30 years. My close friend Tracey has experienced challenging and sometimes debilitating mental health, including anxiety and depression, which has caused her to self-medicate with alcohol. She also has a very challenging relationship with her mother.

We were having our weekly swim, when I experienced a sudden pressing and stabbing sensation in my ribs, restricting my breathing. I felt a rising sense of overwhelming panic. I swam to the side of the pool, sat in the shallow part and started praying, asking God what was happening. I was repeatedly shown the word unforgiveness, also resentment and anger. We both got in the steam room where my mind was taken over by a hurricane of confusion and my breathing got worse. Curiously, when Tracey left the steam room the symptoms lessened. I was shown by the Holy Spirit that I needed to pray for Tracey today, with an urgent message that Jesus loves her.

I left the steam room to go back to the pool when Tracey swam up to me and asked if I was okay, I said I couldn't breathe and needed to get out soon. I told her everything is going to be okay but that I needed to pray for her today if she accepted. She said yes, although she looked petrified! I told her I had a message for her and she said she wanted to receive it. I said: **"Jesus loves you and everything is going to be okay."** She went to float on her back and absorb this message, whilst I went back into the steam room. I was immediately shown the red emergency button on the wall. I was shown that her drinking had come to a head and

that this was now an emergency. Then I was shown the blue ceiling light and a vision of this cooling light flooding down over Tracey (similar to the Divine Mercy image), cooling down the agitation. I thanked Jesus for these gifts and covered myself in his blood. I prayed hard for the words for this prayer that Tracey needed to receive and confided that I had been scared by the sudden symptoms and gave this fear to God. I heard the Holy Spirit tell me that I would be given the exact words and instructions. After a while in prayer, I heard the words, **"You are mine, you are covered, you are safe now"**. We got out, showered and dressed and went outside to the gardens where it began to rain very heavily. I grabbed Tracey's hand and said get in my car, where we took shelter. I said we can pray here, whilst still having no clue what was needed for this prayer. We chatted, I listened, and then I asked Tracey whom she needed to forgive. She said herself, her mum, her dad and broke down at the word "dad". **I had a nudge to pick up Spiro's book "Coming Boldly to the Throne of Grace" and was told page 47.** I opened it up on p47 and it said 'Essential Foundation'.

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I then knew that this wound was from childhood and related to her dad. I heard the Holy Spirit say, "Turn the page..." and this happened three times, ending up on page 52, which was **'The Father's Love Letter' (overleaf)**. I was told to pass her the book to read it out aloud. I passed her the book and **she began to read the 3-page prayer**; her voice was quiet and shaky to begin with, then started to become bolder. I could see and feel each word was touching her deeply; she told me afterwards how it was as though each word had been

was as though each word had been written especially for her. She read out the words:

"You were not a mistake, for all your days are written in my book."
Psalms 139: 15-16

These words really hit home for Tracey as she had been reminded by her mum that she was not planned and even taken through alternative scenarios of her not being born.

Her homework was to read the Father's Love Letter prayer every day out loud for seven days and also to read and meditate on **John 10:10**

"The thief comes only to kill and steal and destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."

The very next day a conversation came up between Tracey and her mum about her not being planned, where her mum was reminiscing and reflecting. Tracey called me the day after this and she was full of life, joy, lightness and hope. **All the negativity, heaviness and worry had lifted! Praise God!**

I am so proud of my incredible friend, who has since experienced God clearly move in her life. She has had a prayer ministry session with Spiro for unforgiveness; and **she has made the life-changing decision to become baptised into the Catholic Church.** She has also committed to giving up drinking by entering into a rehabilitation programme. We recently prayed for her difficult relationship with her mum and a few days later **her mum called her and said she was ready to have family counselling,** which had previously been shut down for many years.

All glory to our wonderful Lord for his mighty ways and works. Thank you for using Spiro's book, and for using me to glorify Your Kingdom. What an honour and a privilege. I see Tracey as being a charismatic evangelist and amazing mentor!

A Cry from Heaven: Neglecting Eucharistic Jesus

Before leaving this world, Jesus promised that He would never abandon us, that He would be with us until the end of time. As a great gift to us, Jesus gave himself in the Eucharist, where He is truly present all the time. But have we neglected spending time with Him? O Lord forgive us, let us come back to You with all our hearts

Approved private revelations in the Catholic tradition frequently highlight a profound sadness from Heaven regarding the neglect of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and the lack of adoration before the tabernacle. These messages, initiated by Our Lady and Jesus himself, delivered through mystics or saints, emphasise that Jesus is truly present, **alive**, and frequently alone in tabernacles worldwide.

The "Neglect" of Adoration

The "Burning Thirst" for Adoration

In many Church-approved messages, Our Lord Jesus expresses a "burning thirst" to be honoured in the Blessed Sacrament: "I so ardently thirst to be loved by men in the Most Blessed Sacrament that this thirst devours Me..." (St Margaret-Mary Alacoque to whom He revealed His Sacred Heart).

Jesus Left Alone

Jesus has revealed that many believers neglect to visit Him in the Eucharist; that He is left alone, treated with coldness and ingratitude. This causes immense sorrow to the Heart of Jesus. "I remain unknown. I am left alone. Even those who claim to profess the mystery of my Real Presence in the Sacrament of the Altar forsake Me. I am treated with a terrible indifference, with coldness, and with a lack of respect that causes the angels to weep because they cannot offer Me reparation for the coldness and indifference of human hearts." - (*The Soul of the Apostolate* - Jean-Baptiste Chautard, OCSO)

A Lack of Reparation

Heavenly revelations often state that, despite the great need, there are few souls who make reparation for the indifference of others. The lack of adoration is described as a source of deep pain. "Only men can make reparation for men. What is lacking is the loving response of a human heart

to My Eucharistic Heart, pierced, alive and beating in the Sacrament of the Altar. **Only a human heart can make reparation for a human heart.** For this reason, the angels are sorrowful." - (Jean-Baptiste Chautard, OCSO)

Urgent Call of Our Lady

At Fatima (1917) and Akita (1973), the Blessed Virgin Mother requested that the faithful offer prayers and sacrifices for sinners, explicitly encouraging Eucharistic adoration as a means of offering reparation for the insults and blasphemies made against God, as a way of consoling Jesus.

Personal Presence

Even when the Blessed Sacrament is not exposed, the lit candle near the tabernacle indicates that Jesus is present. Truly Present. Truly alive. He waits for the faithful to "speak to Him, heart to heart" ("*cor ad cor loquitur*"). Let's say Yes to His invitation to meet Him, Our Lord Redeemer... Regularly, reverently, with our whole heart!



Importance of the Eucharist

Catechism 1324-1327

The Eucharist is **"the source and summit of the Christian life."** The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch. The Eucharist is the efficacious sign and sublime cause of that communion in the divine life and that unity of the People of God by which the Church is kept in being. It is the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship men offer to Christ and through him to the Father in the Holy Spirit. Finally, by the Eucharistic celebration we already unite ourselves with the heavenly liturgy and anticipate eternal life, when God will be all in all. In brief, the Eucharist is **the sum and summary of our faith**: "Our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking." **A "Foretaste of Heaven"**

Eucharistic adoration is a "foretaste of heaven on earth"; an encounter with the Lord. In heaven, we will spend eternity in the beatific vision, gazing upon the Lord in all His glory, praising Him endlessly. Here on earth, we are given glimpses of that joy, particularly in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, as we are drawn beyond the temporal and into the eternal. Pope Benedict XV declared that the devotion to the Holy Eucharist is **"the queen of all devotions."**

Holy Hour according to the saints

A Holy Hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament is worth more than "a thousand years of human glory". (**St Padre Pio**) "A Holy Hour before the Most Blessed Sacrament so pleases the Heart of Jesus, that every man, woman and child on earth receives a new effect of God's graces." (**St Faustina**)

St Clare & the Miraculous Power of the Eucharist by Fr S Haynes

Feast day of St Clare of Assisi: 11 August

Introduction: A City in Peril

In the year 1240 AD, Europe: excommunicated emperor Frederick II hired Saracen mercenaries, fierce Muslim warriors from Sicily, to ravage the Papal States. The city of Assisi, jewel of Umbria, home to the Franciscan movement, was a target. Behind its stone walls, panic brewed. The men prepared weapons; the friars prayed. And, just beyond the city's gates, at San Damiano, another community watched and waited, not with swords, but with psalms. Where Abbess Clare of Assisi, once a noble daughter, now the "little plant" of Francis, and her cloister of women vowed to absolute poverty, lived in silence and prayer. When word came that Saracen troops were advancing, fear rippled through the cloister. The sisters had no walls of iron, no soldiers, no escape route.

Invasion of San Damiano

According to historical accounts the mercenaries stormed Assisi's outskirts, plundering, burning, and slaughtering. Soon they reached San Damiano. The soldiers intended not only to loot, but to desecrate. Clare, 46, though weakened by years of illness and fasting, rose from her bed with a strength not her own. Her face shone with a calm fire. She did not summon armed guards. She turned instead to the Lord of Hosts.

Weapon of Heaven

Scripture must have burned in Clare's heart:

"Thou art my protection and my refuge: my God, in Him will I trust." (Psalm 90:2)

Supported by her sisters, Clare walked to the little oratory. There, in a small silver pyx, was the Blessed Sacrament. She placed the pyx in a small monstrance (ciborium), veiled it in linen, and clutched it to her breast. Then, gathering her daughters, she went to an open window overlooking the advancing horde.

Clare lifted high the Body of Christ.

"Behold, my Lord, is it possible that You would deliver into the hands of beasts Your defenceless servants, whom I have nourished with Your love?" Then she heard an interior voice: **"I will always protect you."**

Recalling Isaiah 41:10: "Fear not, for I am with thee: turn not aside, for I am thy God: I have strengthened thee, and have helped thee, and the right hand of my just one hath upheld thee." Strengthened, Clare pressed on: **"Guard, O Lord, these Your handmaids, for I cannot guard them,"** making the sign of the Cross with the Host over the marauders.

The Miracle Unfolds

As though struck by an unseen force, the soldiers retreated in confusion and fear. The chronicles testify that the enemy scattered "as if driven by a mighty wind." No blood was shed. No sister harmed. The cloister remained inviolate by the protective hand of Christ. The words of the Psalmist became flesh (Psalm 67:2): **"Let God arise, and let His enemies be scattered: let them that hate Him flee from before His face."**

A Second Trial, A Second Triumph

A year later, the Saracens returned with greater fury. Once more, they reached the walls of San Damiano. Once more, Clare raised the Blessed Sacrament on high. Once more, the enemy fled without striking a blow.

The Church has long cherished this event as a Eucharistic miracle, a sign that the Real Presence of Christ is not passive but active, a fortress stronger than stone, a sword sharper than steel.

Franciscan and Papal Voices

St Clare's biographers saw in this miracle the essence of her vocation: to fight not with arms but with adoration.

Pope John Paul II describes it like this: "Her whole life was a Eucharist because from her cloister she raised up a continual 'thanksgiving' to God - in prayer, praise, supplication, intercession, weeping, offering and sacrifice."

Pope Benedict XVI, in 2010, said:

"In the simplicity and humility of her life, St Clare was a courageous woman who knew how to live and defend her faith."

The Eucharist as Shield

Why did Christ intervene through the Eucharist? The Blessed Sacrament is Christ Himself — Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Clare understood what St Thomas Aquinas would later write:

"O sacrum convivium, in quo Christus sumitur." (O sacred banquet! In which Christ is received)

For Clare, the Host was not a symbol but a Person, the Bridegroom of her soul. In her moment of peril, she clung to Him with nuptial boldness, echoing the words of the Song of Songs: **"I found Him whom my soul loveth: I held Him: and I will not let Him go." (Canticle of Canticles 3:4)**

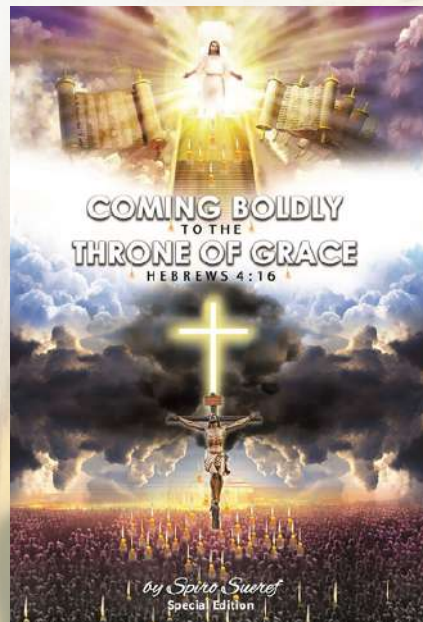
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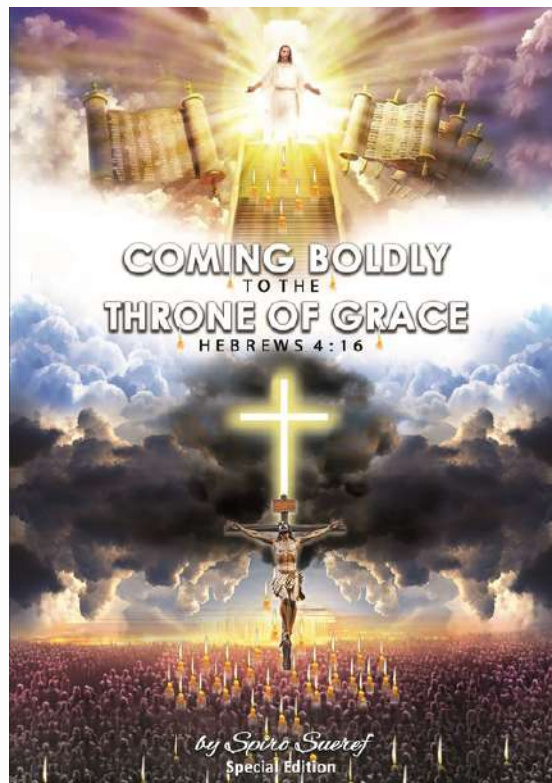


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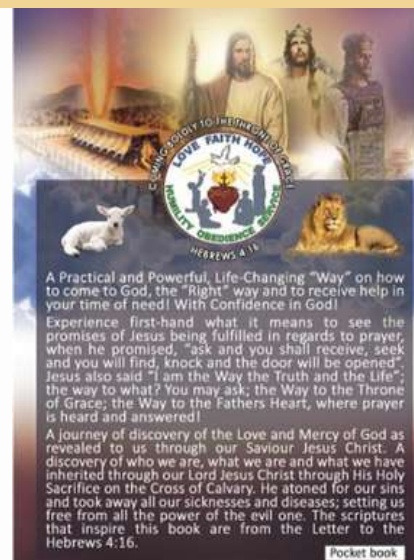

ST BENEDICT OF NURSIA, ITALY

born 2 March 480
died 21 March 547
Feast day:
11 July



Patron saint of: Europe; and of exorcists, against temptations, witchcraft, various diseases, poisoning, all evil, and death; as well as students and school children.
He had a twin sister: St Scholastica.
Benedictine values: Humility and Obedience, Prayer and Work, Community and Stability, Balance and Moderation, Silence (solitude) and Listening, Hospitality and Stewardship, Conversion of Manners

St Benedict is known for his ability to drive out evil spirits, and for his Benedictine cross/medal, which can be used as a protection against evil. He was born in Norcia (Nursia in Latin), Perugia, central Italy, into a noble family and went to study in Rome. Disgusted by the corruption in Roman society during this turbulent period of history, he left his studies to seek a holy life, living as a hermit in a cave in Subiaco, 40km from Rome. He was renowned for his ascetic lifestyle, teaching and holiness. He later became the "Father of Western Monasticism" and of the Benedictine Order at Monte Cassino around 529AD. He established "The Rule of St Benedict", a practical guide for communal monastic life, prescribing a life of prayer, study, and manual labour ("ora et labora"), which became the foundation of Christian monasticism across Europe. St Benedict is known for numerous miracles, including surviving poisoning twice and finding water in a time of famine. He also raised at least two people from the dead. Most of what we know about him was written by Pope St Gregory the Great in his *Dialogues* books.

ST BENEDICT'S JUBILEE MEDAL - HISTORY AND MEANING

The St Benedict medal in current use today is the **Jubilee medal**, designed by the monk Desiderius Lenz, of the Beuron Art School. He designed it in 1880 for the 1,400th anniversary of the birth of St Benedict under the supervision of the prior of Monte Cassino, the Very Rev Boniface Krug (1838-1909). Monte Cassino was given the exclusive right to strike this medal, with which special Jubilee indulgences were attached.

MEDAL FRONT:

St. Benedict holding a cross in one hand and the book of the Rule in the other.

EIUS IN OBITU NRO PRA SENTIA MUNIAMUR:

Latin for: "May his presence protect us in the Hour of death."

CRUX SANCTI PATRIS BENEDICTI:

Latin for: "The Cross of the Holy Father Benedict."

CHALICE WITH SERPENT:

This image represents the event when a group of monks plotted to murder St. Benedict. They offered him poisoned wine, but when St. Benedict made the sign of the cross over the chalice it shattered.

RAVEN WITH BREAD IN BEAK:

This image represents a second attempt to murder St. Benedict by poisoning his bread. St Benedict commanded the raven to carry it away.

EX S M CASINO

MDCCCLXXX:

Latin for: "From the Holy Mount of Cassino, 1880" – Jubilee Medal

MEDAL BACK:

In the centre of the back of the medal, there is the cross of St. Benedict which he used to drive away demons.

On the vertical beam are the following letters: C.S.S.M.L. (Crux Sacra Sit Mihi Lux), which is Latin for: "May the Holy Cross be for me a light." On the horizontal beam are the letters: N.D.S.M.D (Non Draco Sit Mihi Dux), which is Latin for: "Let not the dragon be my guide."

PAX: Latin for: "Peace."

RIGHT SIDE OF MEDAL:

Encircling the right side of the back of the medal are the letters:

V.R.S.N.S.M.V. (Vade Retro Satana; Numquam Suade Mihi Vana), which is Latin for: "Be gone, Satan! Suggest not to me thy vain things."

LEFT SIDE OF MEDAL:

Encircling the left side of the back of the medal are the letters:

S.M.Q.L.I.V.B. (Sunt Mala Quae Libas; Ipse Venena Bibas), which is Latin for:

The drink you offer is evil; drink that poison yourself."

FOUR LARGE LETTERS AROUND

CROSS:

C.P.S.B. (Crux Sancti Patris Benedicti), which is Latin for: "The Cross of the Holy Father Benedict."

Originally, this sacramental was in the form of a cross. Tradition teaches that Bruno of Egisheim-Dagsburg, the future Pope Leo IX, when he was a young Benedictine monk, nearly died of a snake bite. He attributed his recovery to the Benedictine cross. He was emaciated, had lost the ability to speak, and most people had given up on him. It was then when Bruno received a vision of a luminous ladder that reached to Heaven. **On the ladder, he saw St Benedict holding a radiant cross with which he touched Bruno instantly curing him.** Then the apparition disappeared. When Bruno became Pope Leo IX in 1049AD, he redesigned the Benedictine cross as a medal to which he attributed blessings and indulgences. St Vincent de Paul had a strong devotion to this sacramental and asked his Sisters of Charity to attach the medal to their rosaries, which remains a common custom today. Pope Benedict XIV solemnly approved the use of the medal to the faithful in 1742.

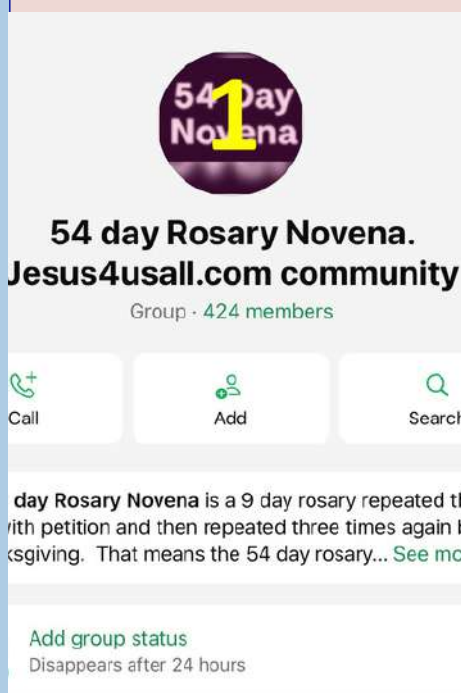

Introduction to this issue’s theme – The Dedication & Our Lady of Mount Carmel

Since the 4 February 2001, when I had a profound mystical experience that changed my life, the Lord has, from time to time, spoken to me in an audible, and, I suppose, an inner-locution, way. His word begins in my heart, and then rises up like a banner into my conscious mind; usually, they are simple words or sentences, but they can be more. The Lord established a pattern to give me special words at the end of the year in order to prepare me for the year to come. When in 2001, I asked the Lord when should I get married, seeking a date, he led me to the scripture 2 Chronicles 7, and that, as you will see, is the story of King Solomon dedicating his temple to God. Since I was asking for a date for my wedding, I was amazed to find that the place that I had cut open the bible, was not only about the Dedication, but it also gave me the date of the 16th of the seventh month. Without knowing it then, I came to know that this date was in fact the

Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel: 16 July.

Seven years later, I met the woman who would become my wife for the first time. On the feast of the Holy Family, we were engaged, and on the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel we were married, having completed **a 54-day rosary novena** leading up to the wedding day, which included the enrolment, and consecration of our marriage to Our Lady of Mount Carmel during the ceremony.

So we are not new to this devotion, and we have seen many miracles through our devotion to our Heavenly Mother and Our Lord, and through what we now call our ‘perpetual 54-day rosary novena’. And we hope to continue to dedicate ourselves and our family to Our Lady of Mount Carmel every year as we move forward into our God-given future.

This is why I am reaching out to you all, to encourage you to dedicate yourselves and your families to God through the Mother of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Each year, the people of God celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles — *Sukkot* (usually celebrated immediately after Yom Kippur, around September/October) — a holy remembrance that God Himself chooses to dwell with His people. It is a feast when Jews live in temporary booths to recall how the Lord led the Israelites through the wilderness, and made His holy presence felt amid a wandering nation. “You shall live in booths for seven days... that your generations may know that I made the people of Israel live in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt” (Leviticus 23:42-43). More than a ritual remembrance, this feast announces a profound truth — that God chooses to dwell with mankind. The wilderness, the tent, the Holy of Holies (the Temple of Moses) became a beacon of their belonging to God, a holy reminder that the Almighty chooses to make His home with His people.

King Solomon builds a Temple in Jerusalem and dedicates it to God. After the king prayed, fire came down from Heaven and the glory of the Lord filled the place, 2 Chronicles 7



God Dwells among His People, leading them out of Egypt and into the Promised Land, Exodus 25:8

2. Solomon's Temple: A Promise that Endures

Centuries later, when King Solomon dedicated the holy Temple in Jerusalem, the glory of the Lord descended upon it. The Scriptures recount this sacred scene: “When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the Lord filled the temple. And the priests could not enter the house of the Lord, because the glory of the Lord had filled the Lord's house. When all the people of Israel saw the fire come down and the glory of the Lord upon the temple, they bowed down with their faces to the ground on the pavement and worshiped, and gave thanks to the Lord, saying, ‘For he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever’” (2 Chronicles 7:1-3). Here we witness a moment where the glory of the Almighty so completely fills the holy space that even the priests cannot stand within it. It is a reminder of the pure and holy nature of spaces dedicated to God, and of the reverence required of those called to stand within them.

After this sacred scene, the Lord appeared to Solomon that night and promised: **“I have heard your prayer and have chosen this place for myself as a house of sacrifice... Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayer that is made in this place”** (2 Chronicles 7:12,15). This promise made by God applies to every holy space and every heart that chooses to be a living temple for the glory of God.

3. Elijah and Our Lady of Mount Carmel: The Holy Flame

On the heights of Mount Carmel (in northern Israel; its western slopes descend into the Mediterranean sea) the Prophet Elijah called down the holy flame upon an altar dedicated to the Lord. The flame consumed the sacrifice, exposed the idols of Baal, and called God's people back to obedience. **"Hear me, O Lord, that this people may know that you are the Lord God, and that you have turned their hearts back"** (1 Kings 18:37). Today, Our Lady of Mount Carmel reminds us of this holy heritage. The mountain becomes a symbol — a place where prayer meets obedience, where the holy flame burns away idolatry and makes space for the glory of the Almighty. Our Lady, the living Tabernacle of the New Covenant, reminds every believer that holy spaces must be set apart for God alone.

4. Pentecost: The Holy Spirit Fire Comes Down Upon the Apostles and Our Lady

The story finds its fulfillment at Pentecost. Here, the disciples, apostles, and Our Lady were gathered in prayer when flames descended from Heaven upon each head: "When the day of Pentecost came, they were all gathered together in one place. **Suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rushing of a wind, and tongues of fire appeared and rested upon each one of them.** All were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak as the Holy Spirit gave them utterance" (Acts 2:1-4). This moment confirms the reality of God's indwelling within humanity; within the human heart.

5. YOU Are a Living Temple of God

St Paul reminds the Church of a revolutionary truth: **"Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you?"** (1 Corinthians 6:19). In a world that treats the person as disposable and defiles holy places, this truth shines forth like a beacon of light. You are called to be holy. You are called to be a holy temple for the glory of God. The holy places of old — the tent, the temple, the altar upon the holy mountain — all point to this reality: **We are all called to bear the holy presence of God within us. This calling comes to all believers and we are all encouraged to experience our own personal pentecost.**

6. The Brown Scapular: A sign of Belonging to the Family of God and Dedication to the Lord

The heritage of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is one of closeness to God, rooted in the sacred tradition of the Prophet Elijah, lived by hermits seeking intimacy with the Divine, and made accessible to all through the gift of the Brown Scapular. The Scapular is more than a piece of brown cloth (based on the monastic garment worn by Carmelites) — **it is the grace to become a holy tabernacle of God**; a sign of obedience and dedication. To wear the Scapular is to say: "I am dedicated to my Lord Jesus Christ. I am wrapped in the mantle of His mother, Our Heavenly Mother. I am called to bear witness to Jesus Christ, to follow the commandments of God and to be a living temple, where the presence of Almighty God can be felt and heard through me." Those who are enrolled in the Brown Scapular are embraced by the heritage of the Carmelite Family. They become sons and daughters of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, called to live holy lives rooted in prayer and obedience.

A Brief History of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

The feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, celebrated on 16 July, was first instituted in the late 14th century in commemoration of the approval of the rule of the Carmelite Order a hundred years earlier. According to legend, a religious community was established even before the time of Christ on Mount Carmel. This is the mountain overlooking the Mediterranean Sea on which the prophet Elijah successfully challenged the priests of Baal and won the people over to the one true God. The feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel entered the calendar of the Universal Church in the early 18th century. Although there is no historical evidence of the pre-Christian Carmelite community, references in the 12th century record a community of monks living on the holy mountain. Despite continual difficulties, the community built a monastery and church dedicated to the Virgin Mary on Mount Carmel in 1263. Saint Louis, King Louis IX of France, had visited Mount Carmel in 1254, and brought back six French hermits for whom he built a convent near Paris. Mount Carmel was taken over by the Muslims in 1291, and the brothers were killed and the convent burned. The spread of the Carmelites in Europe is largely attributable to the work of the English priest St Simon Stock (1247-1265). The Carmelite Order was formally approved in 1274 at the Council of Lyon.

7. Novena and Feast Day: A Time for Renewal - Join us!

Each year, this historical devotion finds its pinnacle in the Novena to Our Lady of Mount Carmel – from 7 July to 16 July – a sacred time for renewal. These nine days invite every believer to deepen their understanding of what it means to belong to the people of God, aligning their heart with the heart of Our Lady. The Feast Day, 16 July, becomes the moment when countless faithful accept this call, making themselves holy temples for the glory of the Lord. The enrolment in the Brown Scapular is not a superficial ritual, but a sign of purpose in the family of God – the enrolment, the belonging and the purpose has the effect of fanning into flame the fire of God's love in the heart of a believer. **No matter who or where you are, you can join us in this initiative.**

8. A Holy Call for Our Times: To Find our Purpose and Mission in life

Today, when countless altars are being defiled or replaced by worldly things for unholy purposes, even to becoming desecrated by satanic powers, this call to be holy has never been more urgent. The Church needs to be a holy place. The faithful needs the Church. The Lord Himself seeks holy spaces with zeal – holy temples, where the heart is the Holy of Holies, and the Throne Room of God, where prayer does rise like incense before the Lord, and is heard and answered – and from where the light of Christ can illuminate the soul and shine out into the world. Through the heritage of Elijah and Solomon, through the example of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, through the sign of the Brown Scapular, we are called to stand upon the holy mountain, to bear witness to the holy altar to the holy Lamb of God, where His glory shines all around. **Join our global virtual community and find your place and purpose in reaching out to the world.**

9. Prayer of Holy Dedication - Accept this Call Today

Lord, let everyone who prays this prayer feel Your Divine presence shining down on them, like a pillar of cloud by day, and a pillar of fire by night. May their prayers rise up like incense before your altar. And may your glory shine all around them. Lord, hear and answer their prayers and send them your holy angels to assist them, to inspire them, to heal them, to deliver them, to preserve and protect them from all harm and danger. Lord, give them a faithful and faith-filled heart. Let them be a Holy Temple of praise and worship, with thanksgiving in their heart. Give them the gifts and the fruits of the Holy Spirit. Let them be fruitful vines, these children of Our Lady of Mount Carmel; heavenly Mother, intercede for those who say these prayers.

O Lord, make of me a temple for Your holy presence. Through Our Lady of Mount Carmel, clothe me in grace and humility. Let our hearts beat in unison. Let us be with one heart and one mind through the Holy Spirit. May everything I think, say and do bring You glory. Grant me the grace of Your Divine Will, and help me to delight in You always. Inspire me to bear witness to You and Your Saving Grace fearlessly, now and forever. Amen.

10. Q & A about the Brown Scapular

Q1: What is the Brown Scapular?

The Brown Scapular is a sign of belonging to Our Lady of Mount Carmel, belonging to God's family. It signifies dedication to God and obedience to Our Lady, reminding its wearer to live as a holy place, or tabernacle, for God.

Q2: Do I have to be a Carmelite to wear the Brown Scapular?

No. The Brown Scapular can be worn by any baptised Catholic who wishes to live a holy and dedicated life, following the example and spirituality of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Q3: What promises are associated with the Brown Scapular?

According to tradition, Our Lady promised that those who die wearing the scapular will not suffer the fires of hell. The scapular signifies the wearer's belonging and obedience to Heaven.

Q4: Do I have to pray certain prayers?

The Church encourages daily prayer, especially the Rosary, and regular reception of the holy Sacraments. To honour chastity. These practices deepen our relationship with God, deepen our faith and commitment. By simply wearing the Scapular, we are telling Mary every moment of the day that we venerate her, love her and trust in her protection.

Q5: What if I forget to wear the Scapular?

The scapular is an external sign, but the belonging it signifies rests within the heart. What truly matters is that the heart remains holy, pure in intention, open and dedicated to God.

Q6: Will Our Lady really protect those who wear the Scapular?

Our Lady promised intercession and protection for those wearing the Brown Scapular with devotion and obedience, leading them closer to her Son, Jesus Christ.

The Scapular Is a Silent Prayer

As Our Lord taught us to say the 'Our Father', Our Blessed Mother taught us the value of the scapular. When we use it as a prayer, Our Lady draws us to the Sacred Heart of Her Divine Son. It is good, therefore, to hold the scapular in the hand. A prayer offered while holding the Scapular is as perfect as a prayer can be. It is especially in time of temptation that we need the powerful intercession of God's Mother. The evil spirit is utterly powerless when the wearer of a scapular faces temptation, calling upon the Holy Virgin in this silent devotion. "If you had recommended yourself to me, you would not have run into such danger," was Our Lady's gentle reproach to Blessed Alan de la Roche, one of her devoted servants.

The scapular must be 100% wool without plastic casing and should not be pinned or affixed to clothing. It is worn over the head, under one's clothes, with one square of wool hanging on the chest and the other on the back. Pictures are not necessary.

According to tradition, on 16 July, 1251, in Aylesford, England, Our Lady appeared with a multitude of angels to Simon Stock, a Carmelite monk. She handed him a brown wool scapular, saying:

"This shall be a privilege for you and all Carmelites, that anyone dying in this habit shall not suffer eternal fire. Wear it devoutly and perseveringly... It is my garment. To be clothed in it means that you are continually thinking of me, and I, in turn, am always thinking of you and helping you to secure eternal life."

Over time, the Church extended this magnificent privilege **to all the laity** who are willing to be invested in the Brown Scapular of the Carmelite order and who perpetually wear it as well.

11. Enrolment in the Brown Scapular: What It Means and How to Live It

To be enrolled in the Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is to accept a sign and a calling. It means becoming a member of the holy Carmelite Family — a holy heritage of prayer, obedience, and belonging to the family of God.

What Holy Enrolment Means:

- You have been placed under the holy protection and maternal care of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.
- You have entered a spiritual bond with the holy Carmelite Order, sharing in its spiritual benefits and heritage.
- You have promised to live as a holy witness, making space for God within your heart and life.

The Rules and Spiritual Commitment:

1. Wear the holy Brown Scapular devoutly — as a sign of belonging and obedience.
2. Live a holy life of prayer — making space for holy moments of silence and reflection every day.
3. Embrace holy obedience and holy humility — following the example of Our Lady in accepting God's Divine Will.
4. Honour Our Lady — through practices such as praying the holy Rosary, Angelus, and attending holy Mass on feast days.
5. Remain faithful to the holy Sacraments — making regular confession and attending holy Mass to deepen your bonds and belonging.
6. Live in simplicity and purity — making your heart and life a holy space wherein God can dwell.

How to Fulfill the Enrolment:

- Begin and end each day with prayer of dedication.
- In moments of trial, call upon Our Lady for strength.
- Be faithful to your heritage by attending holy Mass on the **Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel (16 July)**.
- Pray the **Novena every year from 7-16 July**, deepening your belonging and commitment.
- Trust deeply in Our Lady's protection and intercession.

Through this sign of belonging, you accept the call to stand upon the holy mountain, bear witness upon the holy altar, and live as a holy space wherein the glory of God can dwell.

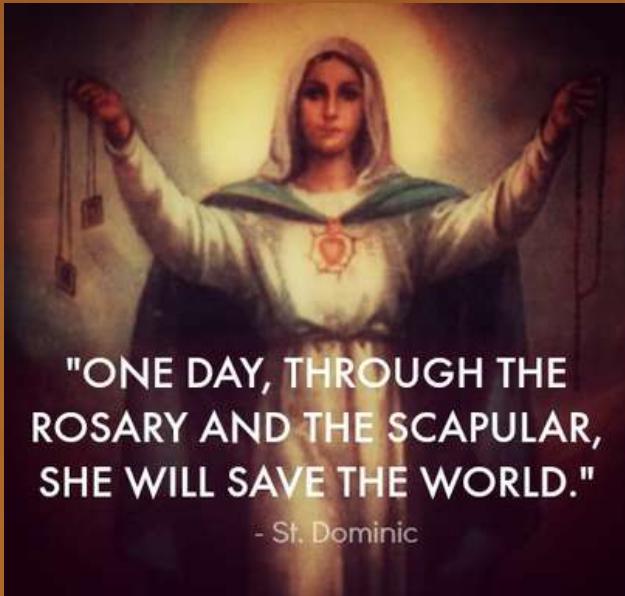

WHO ARE THE PASSIONISTS?



The Passionists, or **Congregation of the Passion of Jesus Christ**, are a religious order founded in Italy in 1720 by St Paul of the Cross. In addition to the traditional monastic vows of poverty, chastity and obedience, members take a special fourth vow to promote the remembrance of and devotion to Christ's Passion. They combine a deeply monastic, contemplative life of prayer with active pastoral and missionary work. Members wear a black habit featuring the Passionist sign (above): a heart, as a symbol of Love, surmounted by a white Cross, a reminder of the Suffering Love of Jesus on the Cross. The words read: **"Jesu Xpi Passio"**, which means **'The Passion of Jesus Christ'** in Hebrew, Greek, Latin. Beneath this, an image of the three nails used to fix Jesus to the Cross, a reminder of the Holy Wounds He bore for us. St Paul says the "Sign" was given to him in a vision of the BV Mary, dressed in black with a badge over her heart. He understood he was to found a Religious Family that would be clothed in the same manner and badge. That badge became the 'Sign' we know today.

SAINT PAUL OF THE CROSS

St Paul is the founder of the Passionists and was widely regarded as one of the most compelling and compassionate preachers of his time and one of the greatest spiritual directors of his era. He was the second of sixteen children, only six of whom survived infancy. In his early years he taught catechism in local churches.

After a powerful conversion aged 19, he famously taught that meditating on Jesus's suffering is the most effective path to finding hope, strength and union with God. Despite enduring nearly 50 years of spiritual darkness, he united his own sufferings with Christ's suffering. His legacy continues with his mystical writings and letters.

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SAINT VINCENT STRAMBI

Feast Day: 25th September

BORN: 1st January 1745

Pope Pius XII

St Vincent was known as "The Holy Passionist Preacher", highly sought after by the Pope for his charismatic and zealous preaching to Priests, Bishops and Cardinals in Rome. He had a troubled childhood, his three elder siblings all died in childhood. He excelled in athletics, becoming more devout in his adolescence.

He radically cut diocesan expenditure and redirected funds to charitable projects and the poor. He served as the Bishop of Macerata-Tolentino from 1801 until his resignation in 1823, where he became an adviser to Pope Leo XII. St Vincent offered his life to God so that sick Pope Leo XII may live. The Pope made a miraculous recovery with St Vincent suffering a stroke and being received by God.



SAINT GEMMA GALGANI

Often called the “Daughter of the Passion”, St Gemma was a humble mystic and stigmatist whose brief but radiant life burned with extraordinary love for Christ. She was orphaned young and plagued by many illnesses. She dedicated her entire life to quiet surrender and mystical visions. At just 21, she received the stigmata. Wounds appeared on her hands, feet and side every Thursday night causing excruciating pain, miraculously disappearing on Friday afternoons.

She experienced frequent ecstasies, visions of the Virgin Mary and intense suffering, as well as extraordinary graces; her frail health prevented her from fulfilling her dream of becoming a Passionist nun.



SAINT GABRIEL OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS

St Gabriel was an Italian Passionist seminarian and mystic, who was a very sociable young man. Born into a wealthy family, he loved reading novels, the theatre, dancing and the company of girls. He also had a fondness for clothes and dressed immaculately in the latest fashion. In contrast to this, he was known for his exemplary life of holiness, his serious devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and his deep identification with the sufferings of Mary and Jesus. His empathy was profound and he sought to console the Blessed Mother through his prayers and sacrifices. He is celebrated as the patron saint of students, seminarians and young people. He continues to inspire young people today to live a life of faith.

BLESSED DOMINIC BARBERI C.P.

Dominic was an Italian theologian and Passionist priest who was prominent in spreading Catholicism in England. Born into a poor family of farmers, his parents died in his early childhood and he was brought up by his uncle. With no regular education, he was taught to read by an elderly capuchin priest. He became involved with several Passionists living in exile near his town and used to serve daily Mass with them.

He established the first Passionist monastery in Staffordshire, England. Despite his thick Italian accent and anti-Catholic prejudice that was prevalent in the day, he drew massive crowds, sparking renewal including the first Corpus Christi procession in England and he was a strong influence in the conversion of St John Henry Newman.

HISTORY OF ST MARIA GORETTI

The third of seven children, St Maria Goretti, was born in the village of Corinaldo, near Ancona, north east Italy, in October 1890. Her mother had her consecrated to the BV Mary on the day of her baptism. Maria's parents laboured in poverty to support their children, but by 1896 their plot of land proved insufficient to feed them. Her father, Luigi, decided they would move to the plains of Rome, where it was said that fertile land could be rented at low cost. After only four years in Ferriere di Conca, near Nettuno, Luigi, exhausted by the heavy heat and hard labour, died.

Luigi had wanted Assunta to return to Corinaldo, but their rental contract obliged her to pay what they owed to their employer, so while Assunta worked in the fields, Maria, nine years old, took care of her four younger brothers and sisters. She was an angelic child whose piety was observed by all. Her fervour won her the grace to make her First Communion, as she begged to do, with the other children. When she asked permission, her mother told her she did not know how to read or write, nor did they have the means to buy the shoes, dress and veil she would need. Maria replied that in the town a lady who knew how to read would teach her, and on Sundays she could go to a priest who taught catechism to children; she was sure God would care for her needs. She was right; she passed the questioning session by the Archpriest of Nettuno with honours, and kind benefactors gave what she needed.

Living conditions for the family were difficult; they shared a kitchen with another family, the Serenellis. Whose mother had died in an asylum; their father was a drunk. The son, Alessandro, 19, began to pay Maria a lot of attention, and she, who wished to remain pure for Jesus, begged her mother never to leave her alone. But one summer day, while Maria watched over her baby sister and prepared the meal, Alessandro left the field where everyone was working and went to the house with evil intentions. No one heard Maria's cries for help; it was only an hour later that Alessandro's younger brother found her in a pool of blood on the floor. She had suffered 14 grievous wounds in the stomach, nine of which were profound. She told the priest who visited her in hospital that she forgave her assassin and wanted him to be with her in Paradise. She received the Last Sacraments in peace and joy, dying on 6 July, 1902.

Alessandro Serenelli was condemned to 30 years of prison (aged 19, he was too young for the death penalty). Gruff and impenitent, he was distrusted by the guards. But the bishop of the diocese, Mgr Blandini, wanted to save his soul, and visited him in prison. 'My son', he said, 'Your bishop wants to greet you and comfort you.' 'I didn't ask for your visit, and I don't need comfort or your sermons,' was the reply. But when the prelate told Alessandro how, during her last minutes, Maria had forgiven him and wished to have him near her in heaven, the nonchalant young man was overcome. 'That is not possible!' he exclaimed. Before the bishop left, Alessandro had fallen into his arms, weeping; and in the hours of solitude which followed, he began to pray.

Three years before the end of his term, Alessandro was freed for good behaviour, and in 1937, aged 55, he visited Maria's mother. When he fell on his knees, begging her pardon, she forgave him. They went to Communion in the village church at Christmas; there was no inhabitant who did not rejoice with joy in this new proof of the sanctity of Maria, to whom they attributed his wondrous conversion. Maria was beatified in April 1947, and canonised in June 1950, by Pope Pius XII.

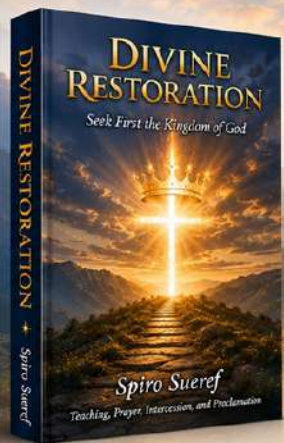

ON OUR WATCH, JUNE 2026

WATCHING THE HORIZON - THE BIRTH PANGS OF THE KINGDOM - PART 1

This is part of our mission at Jesus4UsAll.com to keep you informed.

As we continue from our previous *On Our Watch* articles, we cannot help but reflect upon just how rapidly events have accelerated before our eyes. What only a short time ago may have appeared distant or unlikely now seems to be converging at astonishing speed. Nations are trembling, wars and rumours of wars continue to intensify, economies remain unstable, and technological change is advancing at a pace never before witnessed in human history. At the same time, many people sense that the world has entered a new and uncertain chapter. Fear, confusion and instability seem to dominate many areas of society. Yet for Christians, these things should not surprise us.

Our Lord Jesus Christ Himself warned us long ago that the closing period of this age would be marked by upheaval, deception and distress among nations. In the Gospels of Matthew 24, Mark 13 and Luke 21, Jesus gave a prophetic outline of the conditions that would characterise the times leading toward His return.

Jesus said:

"You will hear of wars and rumours of wars... Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom... All these are but the beginning of the birth pangs." (Matthew 24:6-8)

It is important to notice that Jesus did not simply describe these events as signs of destruction, but as birth pains.

This is profoundly significant.

Birth pains are distressing and painful, yet the focus of childbirth is not ultimately the pain of delivery, but the joy of the birth that follows. In the same way, the shakings now increasing across the world are not merely signs of collapse – they are signs that creation itself is groaning in expectation of the coming Kingdom of God.

St Paul writes:

"The whole creation has been groaning in labour pains until now." (Romans 8:22)

The true focus of the Watchman must therefore never become fear or obsession with catastrophe. Our focus must remain firmly fixed upon Jesus Christ and His glorious return. The signs themselves are not the destination – they are indicators pointing toward the coming reign of Christ and the establishment of the Kingdom of God within human hearts.

Throughout our previous Watchman reflections, we have considered many developments unfolding around us:

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- the erosion of Christian values
- increasing moral confusion
- global instability and uncertainty
- the rise of technological control systems
- artificial intelligence (AI) and digital dependence
- economic shakings
- increasing centralisation of power
- tensions in the Middle East
- the Abrahamic Peace initiatives
- discussions surrounding the rebuilding of the Third Temple
- and the growing spiritual battle between truth and deception.

We have also reflected upon Marian warnings associated with Fatima, Akita and La Salette, all of which repeatedly call humanity back to repentance, prayer and conversion before greater chastisements unfold. As we now look upon the current world scene, it is difficult not to recognise how rapidly these conditions continue to intensify. The Middle East once again stands at the centre of global concern. Tensions involving Israel, Iran and surrounding nations continue to grow, carrying with them the frightening possibility of wider regional conflict and even global escalation. At the same time, discussions surrounding peace agreements, regional normalisation and the future of Jerusalem continue to unfold in ways many Christians find prophetically significant.

Yet Jesus warned us:
"See that you are not alarmed."
(Matthew 24:6)

For Christians, these developments should not lead us into panic or despair, but rather into deeper prayer, discernment and trust in God.

(Part 1) **The Great Falling Away**

One of the clearest warnings given in Scripture concerning the last days is

not only the shaking of nations, but the great spiritual falling away that would take place within humanity itself.

St Paul warns:

"Let no one deceive you in any way; for that day will not come unless the rebellion comes first and the lawless one is revealed..."

(2 Thessalonians 2:3)

This "rebellion," often translated as the "Great Apostasy" or "Falling Away", refers to a widespread turning away from God, truth and righteousness. In many ways, we can already see signs of this unfolding throughout the world today.

Christian values that once shaped nations and societies are increasingly rejected or ridiculed. Truth itself has become relative, morality is redefined according to human desire, and many now live as though God no longer exists.

Jesus Himself asked:

"And yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"
(Luke 18:8)

The Catholic Church also speaks clearly about this final spiritual trial. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) teaches:

"Before Christ's Second Coming the Church must pass through a final trial that will shake the faith of many believers." (CCC 675)

The Catechism warns of a growing religious deception that offers humanity apparent solutions apart from God, ultimately culminating in what it calls:

"The supreme religious deception... that of the Antichrist." (CCC 675)

And further:

"The Antichrist's deception already begins to take shape in the world..." (CCC 676)

These warnings feel increasingly relevant within a world moving rapidly toward secular globalism, technological dependence, moral

relativism and systems that increasingly attempt to redefine truth, identity and even human nature itself apart from God.

At the same time, Scripture reminds us that the spirit of antichrist is not merely a future reality, but is already active wherever Christ is rejected and deception replaces truth.

St John writes:

"As you have heard that Antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come..." (1 John 2:18)

For this reason, Christians must remain spiritually awake and discerning. The greatest danger in the Last Days may not simply be persecution from outside the Church, but deception from within the spirit of the world itself – a gradual drifting away from truth, holiness and obedience to God. Yet even here believers must not lose hope. God always preserves a faithful remnant. Throughout history, whenever darkness increased, God also raised up saints, prayer movements and faithful believers to keep the light of truth burning.

(Part 2)

The Rise of the Digital World

Another major transformation unfolding rapidly before our eyes is the accelerating movement toward an increasingly digital and centralised world system. Across many nations we are witnessing growing discussion surrounding:



- **digital identification systems**
- **biometric technologies**
- **digital passports**
- **central bank digital currencies**
- **artificial intelligence governance**
- **and increasing integration between technology, finance and personal identity.**

Whilst many of these developments are often presented in terms of convenience, efficiency or security, they also carry profound implications for freedom, privacy and human autonomy.

For the first time in history, technological systems now exist that could potentially monitor, regulate or restrict commerce, communication and movement on a global scale.

Students of biblical prophecy cannot help but notice parallels with the warnings found in the **Book of Revelation** concerning systems of economic control associated with the final period of this age:

“No one can buy or sell who does not have the mark...”

(Revelation 13:17)

Whilst Christians should avoid sensationalism or rash conclusions, we should nevertheless remain spiritually awake and discerning regarding the direction in which the world appears to be moving.

In recent years there has also been increasing public discussion surrounding unidentified aerial phenomena, government disclosures and growing speculation concerning extraterrestrial intelligence. What was once largely confined to fringe discussion has now entered mainstream media and public conversation.

Scripture warns repeatedly that the last days will be marked not only by political upheaval, but also by deception, false signs and spiritual confusion.

Jesus warned:

“False messiahs and false prophets will appear and produce great signs and omens, to lead astray, if possible, even the elect.

(Matthew 24:24)

The Christian understanding of reality already recognises the existence of spiritual beings, both holy and fallen. For this reason believers must remain spiritually grounded, prayerful and discerning, testing all things through Scripture, the teaching of the Church and the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

At the same time, Christians should avoid becoming consumed by fear or obsession with every new development. The purpose of prophecy is not to create panic, but to awaken hearts and call people back to God before it is too late.

(Part 3)

Keeping Our Lamps Burning

In times such as these, one of the greatest dangers facing Christians is not only deception in the world, but

found themselves unprepared when the moment finally arrived. The oil in the lamp represents the interior spiritual life — prayer, faith, holiness, perseverance and life in the Holy Spirit. It is not enough merely to recognise signs in the world around us. The deeper question is whether our own hearts are truly prepared for the coming of Christ.)

For this reason, now more than ever, Christians must:

- **remain close to the sacraments, especially Confession and the Holy Eucharist.**
- **We must return to daily prayer, Scripture reading, fasting and repentance.**
- **We must seek refuge in the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the**

spiritual tiredness within the Church itself. Many people today feel overwhelmed by the rapid pace of events, distracted by the noise of daily life, or weighed down by fear and uncertainty about the future.

Yet Jesus repeatedly calls His people to remain spiritually awake:

“Keep awake therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour.”

(Matthew 25:13)

(The parable of the wise and foolish virgins has perhaps never felt more relevant than it does today. The wise virgins kept oil in their lamps and remained ready for the coming of the Bridegroom. The foolish virgins allowed their lamps to go out and

- **Immaculate Heart of Mary, remaining under the grace and protection that God continually offers His people.**

The world may increasingly move toward confusion and darkness, but believers are called to become lights shining within it.

Jesus said:

“You are the light of the world.”

(Matthew 5:14)

This is not a time for despair, but for spiritual strengthening. God is preparing a faithful remnant who will continue to stand firm, proclaim the truth, pray with faith and help guide others toward Christ during difficult times.

(Part 4)

Refuge in the Midst of the Storm

Throughout Scripture, whenever God's people passed through times of upheaval or great trial, the Lord always provided refuge, guidance and protection for those who remained faithful to Him.

- When the flood came upon the earth, Noah entered the ark.
- When the plagues struck Egypt, God protected His people in Goshen.

Likewise today, God is not leaving His people abandoned or defenceless. The Lord continues to call us into spiritual refuge through prayer, repentance, the sacraments, Scripture and life in the Holy Spirit.

Psalm 91 has become especially meaningful for many believers in these times:

"He who dwells in the shelter (the secret place) of the Most High, abides in the shadow of the Almighty, will say to the Lord, 'My refuge and my fortress; my God, in whom I trust.'" (Psalm 91:1-2)

This does not mean Christians will avoid every hardship or difficulty. Even the saints passed through trials and persecutions. Yet God promises His grace, strength and presence to those who trust in Him.

For this reason, spiritual preparation is becoming increasingly important. Christians should not only prepare practically where appropriate, but above all spiritually. The greatest refuge is not a place, but a state of grace and union with God.

As the world grows darker and more uncertain, Christians are called to become people of peace, faith and discernment. We must avoid both extremes: neither ignoring the signs of the times, nor becoming consumed by fear and anxiety.

Jesus warned us beforehand precisely so that we would not lose heart when these things begin to unfold.

In Luke's Gospel, after describing turmoil among nations, Jesus gives one of the most hopeful instructions in all of Scripture:

"Now when these things begin to take place, stand up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." (Luke 21:28)

Whilst the world trembles in fear, Christ tells His people to lift up their heads in hope. Why? Because beyond the labour pains lies the birth of the

Kingdom of God, the triumph of Christ, and the fulfilment of His promises.

Marie-Julie Jahenny (1850–1941)

Known as the “Breton mystic,” Jahenny received regular Marian apparitions (beginning 22 February 1873) and bore stigmata throughout her life.

Her prophecies briefly include:

- Civil war in France and destruction of Paris.
- Global plagues, catastrophic storms, earthquakes.
- The “Blood Rain” lasting 7 weeks.
- Two or Three Days of total darkness, just before the end.

She promoted the Purple Scapular: as a protective sacramental during the coming chastisements.



St Padre Pio (1887–1968)

Mystical experiences included stigmata (first appearing in August 1918), bilocation, healing, spiritual encounters and battles with demons.

Apparitions and combats:

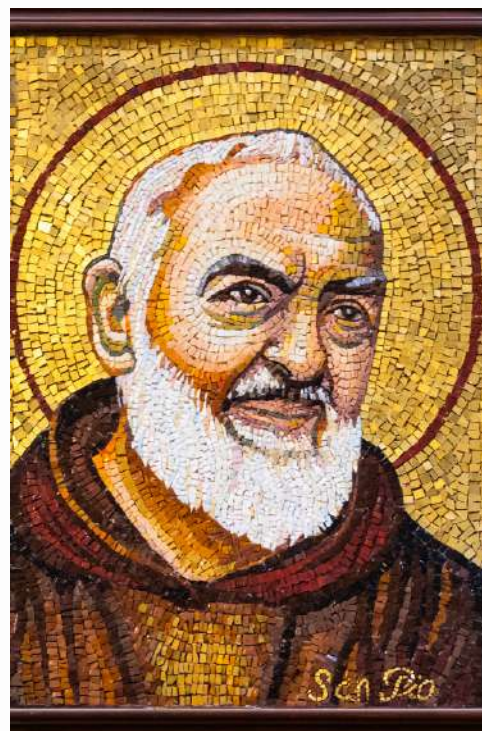
He saw angels, saints, Christ, Mary, and fought a black-robed devil who told him his identity — a soul in purgatory.

Prophetic Revelations:

In 1913 he saw Jesus lamenting corrupt clergy, calling them “butchers”.

In 1949–1950, he received a series of End-Times warnings:

- Catastrophes beyond prior suffering; wars leading to global chastisement.
- “Three days of total darkness”— no food or drink — with only a blessed candle, covered windows, perpetual prayer.
- Earthquakes, storms, poisonous rains, meteorite strikes, mass death — but survivors would find renewal, light, and divine peace.
- He warned of satan being within the Church, predicting that “a false Church” would rise, signalling the End-Times.

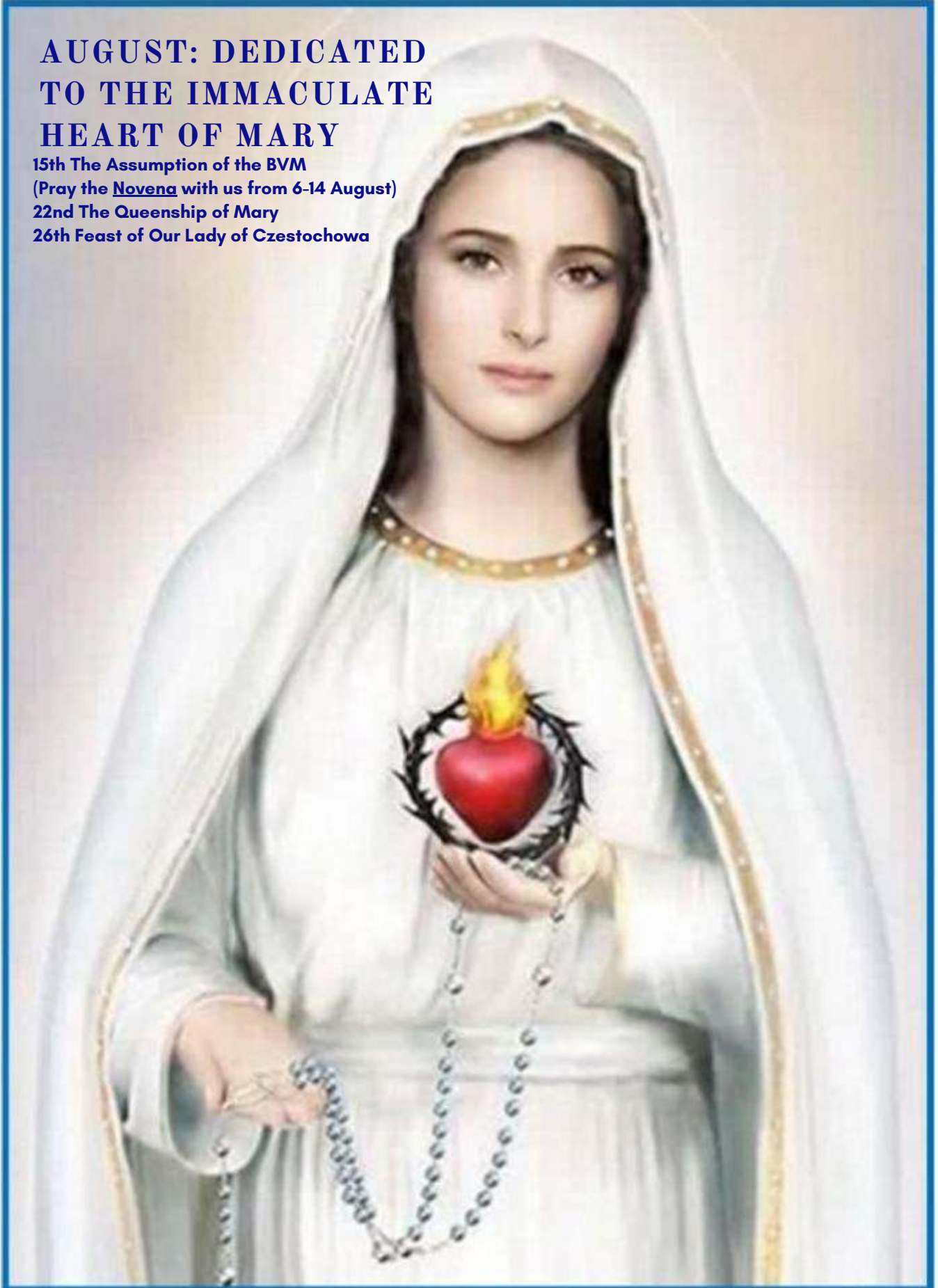

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SAINT OF THE MONTH: ST JOHN VIANNEY, CURE D'ARS

Dates: 8 May, 1786 - 4 August, 1859 **Feast day:** 4 August

Patron saint of: parish priests and clergy worldwide

St John Baptiste Marie Vianney was a priest who Pope Pius X proposed as a model of parochial clergy for his extraordinary devotion and life which he committed to the church ministry. In time for his feast day, which we celebrate on 4 August, let's revisit his inspiring and thought-provoking story.

The Early Life and Education of St John Vianney, Curé d'Ars

St John Vianney was born on 8 May, 1786, in the French town of Dardilly, near Lyons, France. He was the fourth child in a humble family of six children born to Matthieu Vianney and his wife, Marie. The Vianneys were peasant farmers and devout followers of the Catholic Faith who helped the needy. Marie was responsible for leading John into the religious life.

The turbulence of the French Revolution marked St Vianney's childhood. The anticlerical zeitgeist of the times made it a dangerous time for religious people and many priests were forced into hiding. They conducted their ministry in secret, risking their lives in the process. The family journeyed to distant farms to attend Mass facilitated by these priests. These extraordinary circumstances and the priests' courage deeply touched the young Vianney who began to look up to the priests as heroes.

St Vianney received his first communion when he was 13 years old in a private home conducted by two nuns whose communities had been dissolved during the Revolution.

In 1802, Napoleon Bonaparte reestablished the Catholic Church in France and, at this time, Vianney wanted to pursue a religious education. His father allowed him to leave the family farm in order to study at a school for ecclesiastical students that the curé of Ecully, M. Balley, had opened.

Because the French Revolution had interrupted his early education, St Vianney struggled in his studies especially with his Latin. But his deep

determination to become a priest let him prevail over his difficulties.

His education was once again interrupted in 1809 when he was drafted into Napoleon's army. Two days after Vianney was expected to report at Lyons, he fell ill and required medical care. He was left behind by his draft as a result of his hospitalisation.

Life in the Mountains

After he was released from the hospital, St Vianney was sent to Roanne for another draft but got left behind again when he stopped by a church to pray. At this point, he met a kind young man who offered to help guide him back to his group.



This meeting marked the beginning of a significant event in St Vianney's life when the young man led him to a group of deserters who had gathered in the village of Les Noes deep in the mountains of Le Forez. The harsh winters isolated Les Noes and this protected the deserters from surveying gendarmes.

St Vianney lived in Les Noes for 14 months and assumed the name Jerome Vincent. As Jerome Vincent, he opened a school for the village children. On March 1810, he was able to return to Ecully and resume his ecclesiastical studies when an imperial decree granted amnesty to all deserters.

His Exemplary Priesthood

St Vianney attended a minor seminary at Verrieres-en-Forez and was later sent to the major seminary at Lyons in 1813. He still struggled with his schooling, but Abbé Balley persuaded the Vicar general that St Vianney's extraordinary piety made up for his limitations.

St Vianney was finally ordained a priest on 12 August, 1815, in the Couvent des Minimes de Grenoble and celebrated his first Holy Mass the very next day. He was also appointed Abbé Balley's assistant.

When Abbé Balley passed away three years later, St Vianney was appointed parish priest of the town of Ars. This opened his eyes to the sordid state of the community of 230 people. The spirit of the Revolution had made many people ignorant or indifferent toward religion and caused them to behave in debauched ways. People used God's name in vain, danced and drank in taverns and worked in their fields during Sundays.

During the course of his assignment in Ars, St Vianney strived to transform his town spiritually. He prayed for many hours in front of the Blessed Sacrament. He believed that time spent before the Eucharist was the key to unlocking the graces necessary to convert hearts. He vehemently preached against blasphemy and pagan dancing and refused to give absolution to parishioners who did not obey.

It took St Vianney 10 years to bring spiritual renewal to the town of Ars, but his perseverance resulted in greater attendance in his church and the people turning away from their vices. The town taverns started closing down and domestic quarrels became less.

St Vianney found joy in teaching the children their catechism and taught people love for the rosary. Together with Catherine Lassagne and Benedicte Lardet, he also founded La Providence, a home for girls.

ST JOHN VIANNEY... continued

Sainthood

St Vianney started drawing pilgrims who sought his advice. By 1855, about 20,000 people would visit him, seeking his counsel. In the last 10 years of his life, he would spend 16 to 18 hours per day in the confessional.

On 4 August, 1859, St Vianney died at aged 73. More than 6,000 people and 300 priests attended the funeral, presided by the bishop. He was proclaimed "venerable" by Pope Pius IX in October, 1874; declared Blessed in January 1905 by Pope Pius X.

St Vianney was canonised in 1925 by Pope Pius XI and made the patron saint of parish priests. His feast day is celebrated on 4 August, the day of his death. The life and vocation of St Vianney shows us the importance of our role in the spiritual transformation of our communities. He was able to transcend his limitations and humble beginnings to become an exemplary priest who changed his town and even the world.

Vianney's devotion to St Philomena

Vianney credited St Philomena with countless miracles, famously stating, "St Philomena is the most beautiful of all the saints that I know". He routinely sent sinners and the sick to her altar to seek her intercession and composed the Miraculous Litany of St Philomena in her honour (**see next page**).

St Vianney commissioned a portrait of St Philomena which he housed in her chapel in Ars. He said that the image was based on his visions of her, claiming that the painting was an exact likeness of how she appeared to him.

ST PHILOMENA

Feast day: 11 August

St Philomena is one of the most beloved virgin martyrs of the Catholic Church, although many details of her life are known through tradition rather than documents. Her devotion spread throughout the world during the 19th century, and she became known as the “Wonder-Worker” because of the extraordinary miracles attributed to her intercession.

Discovery of St Philomena

In May 1802, archaeologists exploring the Catacombs of Priscilla discovered a sealed tomb bearing three terracotta tiles. The inscription, when correctly arranged, read: ‘PAX TECUM FILUMENA’ (“Peace be with you, Philomena”)

Within the tomb they found:

- The remains of a girl estimated 13-15 years old; A vial containing dried blood, regarded by the early Church as a sign of martyrdom.
- Symbols including: an anchor, arrows, a palm branch, a lily, and a scourge, pointing to a young virgin martyr who had suffered for Christ.



Life of St Philomena, according to tradition

According to the traditional account, preserved through the revelations received by Sister Maria Luisa di Gesù in the 19th century, Philomena (10 Jan 291 – 10 August 304) was: the daughter of a Greek king, born after her previously childless parents prayed for a child, baptised and raised as a Christian. When she was around 13 years old, her parents travelled to Rome during the persecution of Christians. The Roman Emperor is identified as Diocletian. He became captivated by Philomena’s beauty and proposed marriage. Philomena replied that she had already consecrated herself to Christ and had vowed perpetual virginity. Her refusal enraged the emperor.

St Philomena’s Martyrdom

Tradition dates her martyrdom to 10 August, around AD 304. Philomena endured several forms of torture:

- 1. Scourging** She was beaten severely with whips. Many expected her to die. Instead, she was miraculously healed during the night by angels.
- 2. Anchor** An anchor was tied around her neck. She was thrown into the River Tiber. As she fell into the water: angels cut the rope, she floated safely, she emerged unharmed. Many witnesses reportedly converted after witnessing the miracle.
- 3. Arrows** Archers were ordered to shoot her. The arrows refused to strike her. Some turned back upon the soldiers. The emperor then ordered the arrows to be heated. This time the arrows struck her.
- 4. Beheading** Finally she was beheaded.

Why is St Philomena called the ‘Wonder-Worker’?

Soon after her relics were translated to Sanctuary of St Philomena in 1805, numerous miraculous healings were reported. Thousands claimed cures from:

- blindness, paralysis, incurable illness, infertility, spiritual oppression, conversion of sinners.

Her shrine rapidly became one of Europe’s most visited pilgrimage destinations.

Her feast is traditionally celebrated on 11 August. Pilgrims continue to seek her intercession at her shrine (Santuario di Santa Filomena) in Mugnano del Cardinale, about 40km from Naples, where many testimonies of answered prayers and healings have been recorded.

St Philomena is often invoked for:

children; young people; purity; impossible causes; impossible pregnancies; infertile couples; healing; students; protection of life; perseverance in faith

Spiritual Lessons

St Philomena teaches us: to remain faithful to Christ whatever the cost; that purity is a treasure worth defending; that courage comes through God's grace rather than human strength; that God often glorifies His saints through humble and hidden lives; that suffering united to Christ bears eternal fruit.

Prayer to St Philomena

O glorious St Philomena, faithful virgin and courageous martyr of Jesus Christ, I come before you with confidence, trusting in your powerful intercession before the throne of God. You remained steadfast in your love for Christ despite persecution, suffering and death. Obtain for me the grace to remain faithful to Jesus in every trial and never to be separated from Him by sin or fear. Beloved St Philomena, Wonder-Worker, you have brought comfort to countless souls and have obtained miraculous favours for those who have called upon your name with faith. I humbly ask you to intercede for me, especially for this intention: (**Mention your intention here.**) If it is according to God's holy will, obtain for me the grace I seek. Help me to trust completely in the providence of our Heavenly Father and to accept His will with peace and confidence. Pray for the healing of the sick, the conversion of sinners, the strengthening of families, the protection of children, the purity of young people, and perseverance for all who strive to follow Christ faithfully. Teach me to love Jesus with an undivided heart and to honour His Blessed Mother with filial devotion. May your example inspire me to live courageously, speak truthfully, love generously and persevere faithfully until the end of my earthly pilgrimage. St Philomena, powerful advocate before God, pray for me, protect me, and obtain for me the grace to grow daily in faith, hope and charity, so that one day I may rejoice with you forever in the presence of the Most Holy Trinity. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

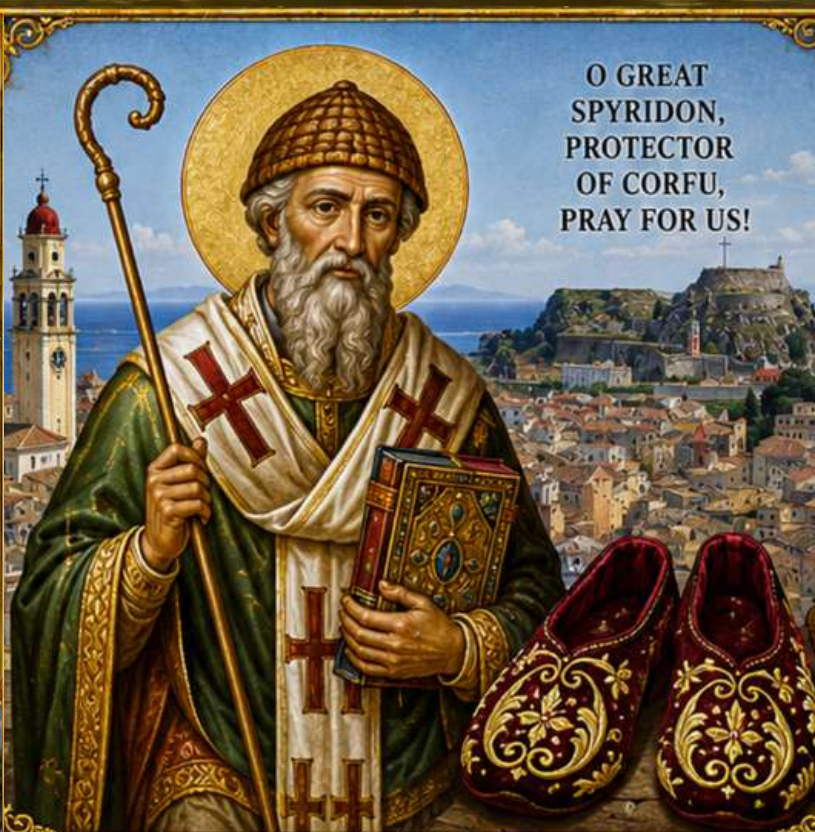

Our founder Spiro is named after St Spyridon (Spiridon), the Patron Saint of Corfu, a third century bishop from Cyprus. The island celebrates the **miracle of 11 August, 1716**, annually, remembering how 'the Wonder Worker Saint' saved the island and the people of Corfu from a massive Ottoman Turkish siege.

St Spyridon occupies a unique place in Christian history. Unlike many saints who are remembered for one or two extraordinary events, St Spyridon has been associated with a continuous tradition of miracles spanning more than 1,600 years.

His life demonstrates the biblical principle that “God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise” (1 Corinthians 1:27). Though a simple shepherd with little formal education, he became one of the Church’s most revered bishops and wonderworkers.

Miracles During His Lifetime

1. Healing the Sick St Spyridon was renowned for healing many who came to him suffering from illness.

Accounts describe him praying over those afflicted with: paralysis, blindness, severe fevers, and various incurable diseases. **Unlike physicians of his time, he charged nothing** and always pointed people to Christ as the true healer. **His ministry echoes the words of Jesus: “Heal the sick... Freely you have received; freely give.” (Matthew 10:8)**

2. Raising the Dead One of the most striking traditions concerns the resurrection of a dead child. According to early accounts, a grieving mother brought her deceased child to St Spyridon. Moved with compassion, he knelt in prayer and asked Christ to restore the child’s life. The child revived, and the astonished mother, overwhelmed with emotion, herself collapsed and died. St Spyridon then prayed again, and she too was restored to life. This represented God’s power over death due to the prayers of the Saint.

3. Miracle of the Snake Turned into Gold This is one of the best-known stories from his life. A poor farmer needed money to survive a difficult season and sought help from St Spyridon. **The Saint had no wealth** to give him. He picked up a snake from the ground and, through prayer, it was transformed into a bar of gold. The farmer used the gold as security for a loan, saved his farm, and later returned to repay the loan. St Spyridon then took the gold back into his hands, prayed, and it returned to being a living snake, which slithered away.

4. Bringing Rain During a Drought During a severe drought that threatened famine, St Spyridon prayed earnestly for rain. Soon afterward, heavy rain fell upon the land, saving the crops and preventing widespread hunger. Later, when excessive rainfall threatened destruction, he prayed again, and the rain ceased. This recalls the ministry of the prophet Elijah (1 Kings 17-18), showing that a prayer of a righteous man works powerfully before God, Who remains sovereign over creation.

5. Ending Famine During another famine, a wealthy grain merchant refused to sell food except at inflated prices. St Spyridon rebuked his greed and warned that trust should be placed in God rather than wealth. According to tradition, the merchant’s grain stores were opened by a violent storm, allowing grain to spill into the streets. The poor gathered what they needed, while the merchant learned humility through the experience. The account echoes biblical warnings against exploiting the poor (Amos 8:4-7).

6. The Miracle of St Spyridon and His Daughter Irene

St Spyridon had one daughter named Irene, who was known for her holiness and purity of life. A wealthy woman entrusted Irene with a valuable piece of jewellery (usually described as a gold ornament or valuable jewel) for safekeeping. Before Irene could return it, she died.

Some time later, the owner returned asking for her precious jewel. St Spyridon had no idea where his daughter had hidden it. Filled with compassion for the distressed woman, he went to Irene’s tomb and prayed. According to tradition, he called to his daughter: “My daughter Irene, where have you placed the jewel entrusted to you?”

Irene answered him from the grave, telling him exactly where the jewel had been hidden. St Spyridon went to the place she had described, recovered the jewel, and returned it to its rightful owner. Having completed this act of justice, Irene rested once again in peace.



7. Delivering the Innocent from Execution A friend of St Spyridon had been falsely accused of a crime and sentenced to death. The Saint hurried to intervene but encountered a river swollen by floodwaters. Unable to cross safely, he prayed and commanded the waters in the name of Christ. The river is said to have parted or subsided sufficiently for him to cross. He reached the court in time, exposed the false accusation, and secured the innocent man's release. This miracle resembles biblical accounts such as the crossing of the Jordan (Josh 3).

8. The Emperor's Healing Constantius II suffered from a serious illness after no physician could help him. He dreamed that only St Spyridon could heal him. The Saint travelled to the imperial court, prayed over the emperor, and he recovered. The emperor rewarded him generously, but St Spyridon distributed much of the wealth among the poor. This illustrates his lifelong detachment from riches.

9. The Lamp That Burned Without Oil Tradition records that while serving the Divine Liturgy, the church's lamp ran out of oil. St Spyridon prayed, and the lamp continued burning. Such accounts emphasise God's providence and recall biblical miracles such as the widow's oil (2 Kings 4).

10. The Council of Nicaea and the Brick At the First Council of Nicaea, St Spyridon defended the Church's faith in the Trinity. Holding a brick, he declared: 'In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.' According to tradition: fire rose upward, water flowed downward, clay remained in his hand. This dramatic sign became one of the best-known symbols associated with St Spyridon. It is understood as a traditional illustration of the Trinity rather than a doctrinal proof.

Miracles After His Death

St Spyridon's reputation as a wonderworker grew even more after his death.

The Protection of Corfu

His relics were transferred to Corfu during the fifteenth century. The people of Corfu credit his intercession with delivering the island on several occasions. Traditionally, these include: protection during Ottoman sieges, deliverance from outbreaks of plague, preservation during periods of famine, and aid during other crises. These events are commemorated by annual processions through the streets of Corfu.

The Plague Miracle (1629 and 1673)

One of the most famous traditions recounts that during devastating outbreaks of plague, many witnesses reported seeing Saint Spyridon walking through the city carrying a cross or torch. Soon afterward, the epidemic subsided. Out of gratitude, the people established annual commemorative processions that continue today.

The Ottoman Siege of August 1716

Perhaps the most celebrated miracle occurred during the Ottoman siege of Corfu in 1716. According to tradition, defenders and even some attackers reported seeing a venerable bishop clothed in brilliant vestments walking upon the city walls while a violent storm struck the invading fleet. The Ottoman forces unexpectedly abandoned the siege. The people attributed their deliverance to St Spyridon's intercession and have celebrated this event ever since.

The "Walking Saint"

Perhaps the most unusual tradition concerns his incorrupt relics. His body is preserved in Corfu and clothed in embroidered vestments and slippers. Caretakers have long reported that: his slippers become worn, they periodically need replacing, and the old slippers are distributed to pilgrims as devotional relics.

Tradition holds that St Spyridon continues to "walk" throughout the world, helping those who seek his prayers. While this belief forms part of Orthodox devotional tradition, the worn slippers themselves are not presented as proof of miraculous journeys but as a cherished sign of the Saint's ongoing spiritual care.

The Spiritual Pattern of His Miracles

When all of St Spyridon's miracles are considered together, a consistent pattern emerges. His miracles were never performed to draw attention to himself. They reflected the compassionate ministry of Christ by bringing healing to the sick, provision to the poor, justice to the innocent, protection to communities, and encouragement to those whose faith was being tested. In many ways, his life illustrates Jesus' promise: "Whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father." (John 14:12)

For this reason, both Eastern Orthodox and many Eastern Catholic Christians continue to invoke St Spyridon as a powerful intercessor, especially in matters of healing, financial hardship, family needs, travel, and protection. His enduring witness reminds believers that holiness is found not in worldly learning or status but in humble faith, obedience to God, and love for one's neighbour.

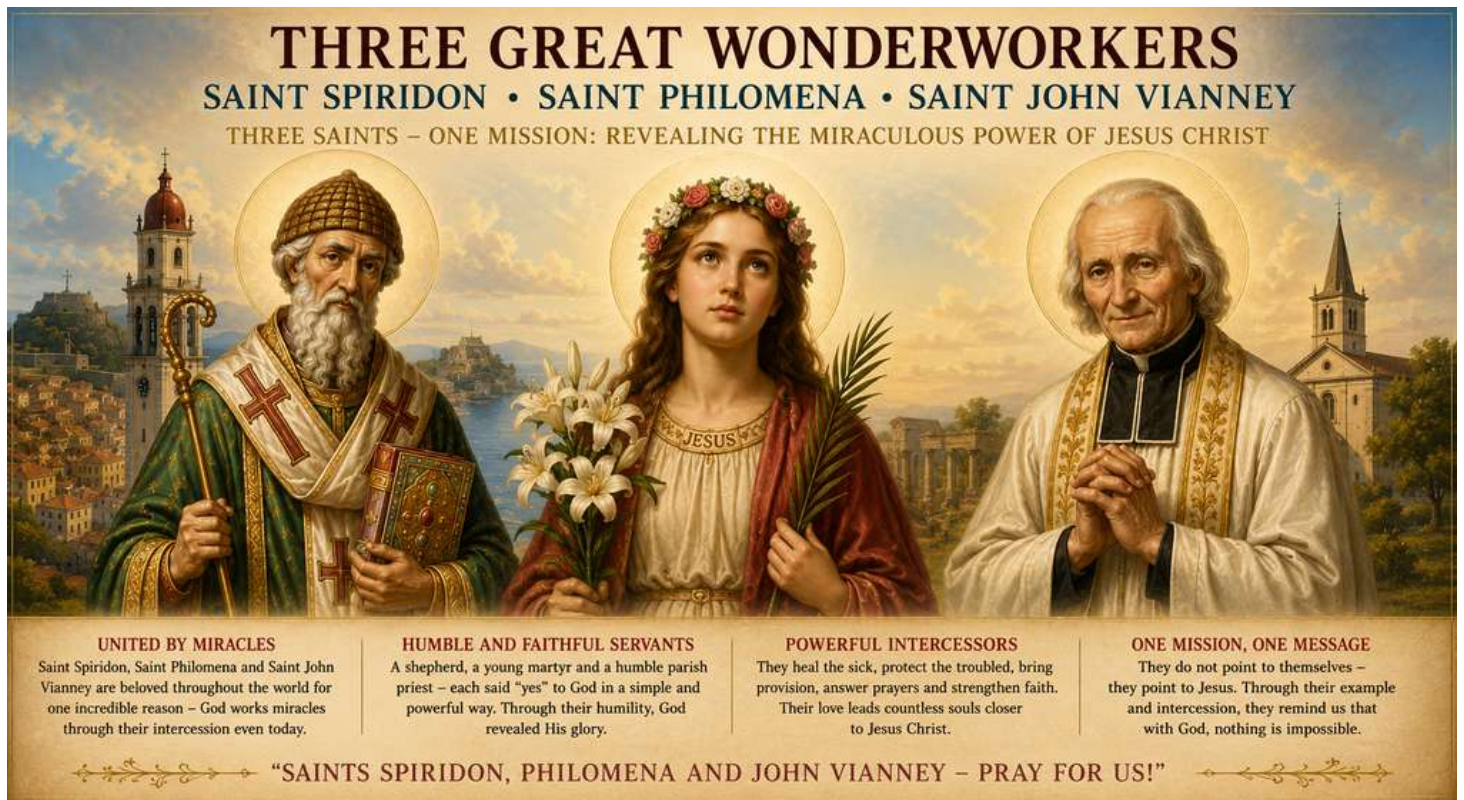
Prayer to St Spiridon the Wonderworker for Difficult and Impossible Cases

Pray that every obstacle standing in the way of God's will may be removed, that every door which God desires to open may be opened, and every door that would lead me away from His holy will may remain closed. Through your powerful intercession, may the Lord grant healing where there is sickness, peace where there is anxiety, reconciliation where there is division, provision where there is need, and hope where there is despair. Above all, obtain for me the grace never to lose confidence in the mercy of Jesus Christ, who alone is our Saviour and Redeemer. May my life always give glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever. St Spiridon the Wonderworker, pray for us. Amen.



Three Great Wonderworkers: United by the Miraculous Power of Jesus Christ

At first glance, St Spiridon, St Philomena, and St John Vianney appear to have little in common.

St Spiridon was a humble shepherd who became Bishop of Trimythous in the fourth century and is honoured as the patron and protector of Corfu. St Philomena was a young virgin martyr whose courageous witness to Christ inspired generations of believers. St John Vianney, the humble Curé of Ars, was a nineteenth-century parish priest renowned for his holiness and tireless ministry in the confessional. Yet these three saints are united by a remarkable thread that runs through Christian history – the extraordinary power of God working through humble and faithful lives.

The strongest historical connection is between St Philomena and St John Vianney. The Curé of Ars had an unwavering devotion to St Philomena and often attributed the many miracles witnessed in his parish to her powerful intercession, saying, “It is St Philomena who obtains everything for me.” Through his love for this young martyr, devotion to St Philomena spread throughout the Catholic world.

St Spiridon shares with them the title of Wonderworker. For over sixteen centuries, countless healings, conversions, acts of protection and extraordinary favours have been attributed to his prayers. His incorrupt relics remain in Corfu, where the faithful lovingly speak of him as “the Walking Saint”, believing he continues to help those who call upon him with faith.

What unites these three Saints above all is not simply their miracles, but their humility, holiness, and complete trust in Jesus Christ. None sought honour or recognition; each lived only to glorify God. Their lives remind us that miracles are never ends in themselves—they are signs that lead us to Christ, strengthen our faith, and encourage us to persevere in prayer.

Together, these three great saints proclaim one timeless message: with God, nothing is impossible. Through their powerful intercession, may we grow in faith, hope and love, always giving glory to Jesus Christ, from whom every grace and every miracle flows.

THE 14 HOLY HELPERS

The 14 Holy Helpers are a group of saints venerated together because of their powerful intercession during times of physical illness, spiritual warfare, and personal adversity. Traditional prayers consist of a preparatory invocation, a litany detailing their specific patronages, and concluding prayers for healing and liberation. This group of *Nothelfer* ("helpers in time of need") originated in the 14th century, in the Rhineland, part of 'The German Empire', largely as a result of the bubonic plague. Whilst a few of these saints are still highly regarded in Continental Europe (eg, St George), interest in them as a group was reignited in 2019-20, when people started to invoke them during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The 14 Holy Helpers are, as above:

St Christopher; St Denis; **St Catherine of Alexandria;** St Blaise; **St Vitus;** St George; **St Erasmus;** St Margaret of Antioch; **St Barbara;** St Eustace; **St Acacius;** St Cyriacus; **St Pantaleon;** St Giles.

ST MAXIMILIAN KOLBE, PRIEST & MARTYR

Feast day: 14 August



St Maximilian Kolbe, a Polish Conventual Franciscan friar, was born on 8 January, 1894. He was very active in promoting the Immaculate Virgin Mary (particularly Our Lady of Lourdes; Lourdes water healed his thumb when he was a young friar) and he is **known as the Apostle of Consecration to Mary**. His life was influenced by a vision he had of the Virgin Mary when he was 12. Kolbe says: "That night I asked the Mother of God what was to become of me. She came holding two crowns, one white, the other red. She asked if I was willing to accept either of these crowns. The white one meant that I should persevere in purity, and the red that I should become a martyr. I said that I would accept them both." One year later, Kolbe and his elder brother, Francis, joined the Conventual Franciscans. **In 1911, he professed his first vows.** At 21, Kolbe earned a doctorate in philosophy from the Pontifical Gregorian University; by 28, a doctorate in theology. Kolbe **created the Militia Immaculata (Army of the Immaculate One) after witnessing demonstrations against Pope Pius X and Benedict XV.** His goal was to work for the conversion of sinners and enemies of the Church, specifically, the Freemasons, through the intercession of Mary. **In 1918, he was ordained a priest.** He founded a monthly magazine, "**Rycerz Niepokalanej**" (**Knight of the Immaculate**); operated a publishing press and founded a new Conventual Franciscan monastery at Niepokalanow (about 42km west of Warsaw); as well as monasteries in Japan and India. In 1936, Kolbe's poor health forced him to return to Poland, and once the WWII invasion by Germany began, he became one of the only brothers to remain in the monastery. He opened a hospital to aid those in need. When his town was captured, he was sent to prison but released three months later. He refused to sign a document that would recognise him as a German citizen with his German ancestry, and continued to work, providing shelter for refugees - including 2,000 Jews. Kolbe's publishing house issued many anti-Nazi publications. On 17 February, 1941, the monastery was shut down; Kolbe was arrested by the Gestapo and taken to Pawiak prison. Three months later, he transferred to Auschwitz. Never abandoning his priesthood, Kolbe was subjected to severe violence and harassment. In the second month in Auschwitz, men were chosen to face death by starvation to deter thoughts of escaping. Kolbe volunteered to take the place of a chosen (family) man. During his last days Kolbe made his cell into a chapel and led prisoners in prayer to Our Lady. He was the last of the group to stay alive, after two weeks of dehydration and starvation. The guards gave him a lethal injection of carbolic acid. He raised his left arm and calmly awaited death. St Maximilian Kolbe **died as a Martyr of Charity on 14 August 1941; his remains were cremated on 15 August, the feast of the Assumption.**

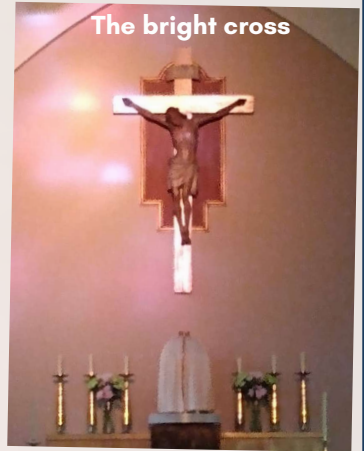
VOLUNTEER TESTIMONY: JANKA WAS HEALED MIRACULOUSLY FROM LONG COVID. FOUR YEARS ON, HER SPIRITUAL JOURNEY SINCE THEN

Our administrator, beloved sister Janka, shares her testimony and journey with Jesus4UsAll.com



Janka

Sister Janka, *left*, had suffered for exactly 13 months, with many ailments, including extreme fatigue, chest pains, brain fog, disorientation, headache, breathlessness, sleepiness, heaviness, nerve pain, and back pain. She was spending most of the time in bed; she had stopped working, stopped her normal daily activities and had become dependent on her husband as her primary carer, who would do everything for her. She was two weeks' away from losing her job. Here we find out how the miraculous power of God restored her back to full health and a full and vibrant life.



Hi, my name is Janka, I am from Slovakia but now living in the UK. I was suffering for many months with Long COVID, and I was getting desperate to get healed and restore my life back to normality. Here are some notes from my diary, showing how the Lord set before me a clear direction as to where I would find my healing:

In November 2021, I heard about Spiro from my friend Walter whom I met in the Prince of Peace community. Walter told me about his experience of healing with Spiro's brother Nicholas, and he added that both Spiro and Nicholas have a healing ministry. I was intrigued and said I would like to meet Spiro one day. And so it happened that that very night Spiro had a live Zoom Healing Service and because of my Long COVID, I thought I'd give it a try. Walter shared the healing service link with me and I joined that night. I thought it was good, but it was so long that I couldn't stay until the end. For 6 months, I tried each month, again and again, to join, but the timing just wasn't for me; I usually fell asleep by the time Spiro prayed with people.

On the 12th May 2022, Spiro changed the time and decided to do two days' ministry instead of one, it said 3 hours both days! I thought, hmmm, that sounds better, maybe finally I could join for the whole session, though we usually have our prayer group meeting in church on Thursday at that time. **I had suffered with Long COVID for 13 months by then and I could never plan anything because my energy would just falter at any point, and all I could do was sleep.** I did plan to go to the prayer group in the church that day but about an hour before, I realised I couldn't go, I was exhausted. I decided to run myself a bath and I listened to Spiro's healing service. For the first hour, it was the same as before and sister Lea from Lebanon was giving a testimony about her healing. I had already heard it before, so was thinking that when I get out of bath I would just go to sleep. However, something drew me to listen until the end, and two ladies got healed (one had a bad reaction to the COVID vaccine) and Spiro said that he would continue with the healing the next day. I thought I would give it a go.

The next day, the 13th May, I joined again, I was second to get into the meeting. One lady, who had gotten healed the night before, was giving her testimony to Spiro. When she finished, Spiro said: "Now it's Janka's turn!" I switched my mobile's camera and microphone on. I wasn't sure if it wasn't Jesus' wish that I was ill, because I offered everything to Him. When I mentioned this to Spiro later on another call, he clarified the point that it was not God's will. Spiro asked me to tell him what was wrong and to name my symptoms. As soon as I started naming the symptoms, the Wi-Fi signal showed me that Spiro's connection was red, meaning it kept stopping, however, Spiro said that it was my connection and not his. He asked the other lady who was there to confirm it and she said that indeed it was my connection and not Spiro's. **Someone didn't want Spiro to hear my symptoms!!!** Then, after a while, Spiro could hear me as I named all the symptoms I was experiencing - chest pain, extreme tiredness, brain fog, sleepiness, breathlessness, disorientation, weakness etc.

Spiro began to pray for me as follows, saying: "Let's start with the sign of the cross. In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

"Almighty God, Heavenly Father, I thank You for Janka, for bringing her to us, Almighty God, You knew she would be here tonight. Lord, we ask You to open a window to heaven above her right now and let Your glorious and merciful light shine down on her from Your Throne of Grace in heaven.

"Lord, let it shine on her so brightly that it consumes and dissolves all the powers of darkness within her, let it consume and dissolve all the roots, the chains and the anchors of the evil one operating in her heart, mind, body, soul and spirit. Almighty God, let the divine light of Your presence shine on her so intensely, that no evil spirit of infirmity, sickness or disease will remain in her and let the fire of Your Holy Spirit come to consume it all, leaving her perfectly healthy, healed and made whole in heart, mind, body, soul and spirit.

"And we come against the spirit of sickness, the spirit of COVID or Long COVID, the spirit of disability. Out now, in Jesus' Name! Out now, in Jesus' Name!

Every sickness and disease of heart, mind, body, soul and spirit operating in Janka, your time is up in the Name of Jesus! You will come out and you will depart quietly, peacefully, without harm to her or anyone else and you will go to the foot of the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. And we forbid you to ever try coming back. O, blood of Jesus, come on Janka, let the blood of Jesus defend her and set her free. Almighty God, Heavenly Father, as we give words of command in the Name and for the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ, send your holy angels to enforce the Word to bring healing, let your

holy Seraphims from before Your throne in heaven leave given the instructions to go down to her now to minister healing and deliverance. Let the fire of the Holy Spirit bring that purification of body, soul, heart, mind in her, let her feel the presence of Our Lord, the peace of His grace, power of His healing, the light of His life operating in her mind, heart, body, soul and spirit. Lord, in Your Mercy. Hear our prayer."



Spiro then asked me if I felt anything as he prayed for me and I said: "No." Twice he asked me and twice I said: "No."

Spiro then began to ask me questions to find out where there might be obstacles to my healing, he first asked me if I had forgiven everyone, to which I answered: "Yes." Then he asked me if I ever practised Yoga or any other new age or occult practice. I said that I used to do Yoga but I renounced it the night before.

Spiro then guided me through a prayer of renunciation and that was followed by a prayer to invite Jesus to sit on the throne of my heart. At the precise point of asking Jesus to come and sit on the throne of my heart and to be my only Lord, God and Saviour, giving Him permission to remove every idol from me, I felt like I was lifted up to heaven, and I suddenly had a life changing encounter with Jesus, suddenly I felt such amazing and

powerful LOVE and PEACE, that my heart was on fire for Jesus' love. All I could say was constantly repeat the name of Jesus, I felt His presence and although I was there, I wasn't there, **I was with Jesus on the mountain of Transfiguration. Only me and Jesus and nothing and no one else, I wished I could stay there forever, it was unbelievable and yet so real and completely unforgettable.** It only lasted a few seconds, I think, but I will never forget it. **I became a new person, I will never be the same again.** I will do anything for Jesus. I will not doubt Him ever and never deny Him ever again! I was completely sure in my spirit that I was healed there and then. I just have to believe it!

Here is the prayer that Spiro led me in that brought about my deliverance:

"I renounce the spirit of kundalini in the mighty Name of Jesus. I renounce every spirit of Yoga in the Name of Jesus. I command you all to leave me now in the mighty Name of Jesus. I don't want you any more. I want to have nothing to do with you and I want you to have nothing more to do with me. I bind you up together in the Name of Jesus. I command you, all of you, to leave me now in the Name of Jesus. Go quietly, peacefully, without harm to me or anyone else and go to the foot of the cross of my Lord Jesus Christ for Him to deal with you. I forbid you to ever try coming back. Dear Jesus, release a fresh anointing on me now, let that anointing of Yours dissolve me from the yoke of slavery to sin and satan and the yoke of slavery to all sickness and disease in the Name of Jesus. Let that yoke on me from the enemy dissolve now. I command the heavy burden that satan has placed on my heart to be

lifted from me now. No more tightness in my chest, no more interference with my respiratory system, Lord, come into my heart, take up Your rightful place there on the throne of my heart. I give you permission to remove every form of idolatry there now, any idol I have there, take them out. **Be the only One, be my Lord, my God and my Saviour [this is when I had the encounter with Jesus!] now and forever. Jesus, be the Lord of my heart."**

I heard Spiro's voice calling me back. I really didn't want to come back.... Then Spiro asked me to walk up and down the stairs. As I did this, there were times where I felt better and times when I felt the symptoms coming back. This was all new to me. I didn't really understand all of this. I had already said all the prayers the night before with everyone and tried claiming healing for myself with all the prayers as Spiro taught us how to speak to our mountains from Mark 11. I couldn't understand why when I said it nothing happened, but now being guided by Spiro, I could feel healing, light, peace and love flowing in me in a powerful way. As I was repeating Spiro's prayers, suddenly I felt like my body was fighting with all the COVID symptoms again (fatigue, chest pains, high temperature, dizziness, brain fog, headache...). When I felt heaven open, in the spirit I knew I was healed and now began the war of faith, to believe in God and to claim the healing according to Jesus' promise from Mark 11. To birth it from the spirit to the flesh. I completely surrendered everything to Jesus. It was obvious that there was a battle going on. But what Spiro spoke and prayed continued to manifest in me, it was slow, but surely working.

Spiro guided me into naming all the symptoms I felt and to speak to them as they were my mountains and I sent them to the foot of the cross of Our Lord Jesus Christ. I felt them leave one by one. Then Spiro told me to walk around, and up and down the stairs. At times I started to feel better, then feel the symptoms coming back again. Spiro prayed with me again, we said a prayer to detach myself from my husband's unbelief. Then I walked around the room. I felt renewed, refreshed and then my daughter came into the room and I felt the symptoms coming back again, and another lady on the Zoom call said that my face had changed completely.

Spiro prayed with me again and told me to keep applying Mark 11 (speaking to the mountains and what we have prayed for, we believe we have received). I felt really calm again but I was thinking about my daughter and wanted to go to her. Spiro said he will have a one-to-one call with me some other time because there were other people waiting to be healed in the meeting. I thanked him.

In the following days, I saw significant improvements in my health and strength, and I was beginning to do things I hadn't done for a long time. I completed more tasks than I could remember doing before and I was not affected. And every time any symptom tried to come back I

immediately sent it to the foot of the cross of Jesus, applying (speaking out in faith) Mark 11 and praying the rosary and the symptoms left immediately.

Because I was off from work for a whole year by now, I was given a choice to either mutually agree to resign, or leave it another month and it would be decided for me what happens with my employment. Everybody said I should just leave, but I chose to stay. I trusted Jesus.

I was in contact with Spiro and texted him on the 18th (5 days after my healing) because I finally found the strength to tell my husband what had happened. Who told me not to say anything about it to my doctor and employer etc because they would think I was crazy. So I texted Spiro while his car was in the garage being repaired, we spoke and we prayed that God's will would prevail regarding my health and work and the decision of my employer as well as occupational health. To be honest, I was completely prepared to tell everyone that Jesus healed me, I didn't care if people thought I was crazy. Spiro assured me that the time to give witness to the healing would come, but that for now we would have to exercise wisdom in order for me to obey my husband and by refraining from telling everyone the whole truth as it was. Spiro advised me to present my case through the occupational health expert.

I also told Spiro that the symptoms kept trying to return at times. Spiro advised to apply Mark 11 in conjunction with James 4:7 - submitting to God and resisting the devil. I kept applying this until the symptoms left. Sometimes I had to ask my friend to read Mark 11 for me

as I was unable to read due to brain fog and I felt my heart on fire every time she read it to me. Then the symptoms began to diminish as I took authority over them.

My last big attack was when I went to Pantasaph on Saturday 28th May. I went there with my friends and it was the first time I went somewhere for a whole day without anyone from the family. After the rosary, praise and worship and Holy Mass, I wanted to climb up the Calvary Hill to complete the stations of the cross. At the second station, suddenly all symptoms came on me and something was telling me to stop and go back and sit down, that I couldn't do it. I nearly gave in, but I said, "NO, I WILL DO IT!"

I gave my friend my phone to read Mark 11, because the brain fog was so bad that I couldn't read any more, my heart went on fire half way through her reading it and at the end of it I felt the Holy Spirit coming down on me and all the symptoms vanished. I completed the stations of the cross without any problems. **This was a miracle.**

Shortly after this, I had my occupational health appointment call and I explained how I was feeling my old healthy self. She was pleased and wrote a report, and sent it to my employer. I asked her if she came across anyone who has recovered suddenly and she said she hadn't personally but because it's a new illness, it affects everyone differently. And that is what I said at my final meeting, they kept asking me how it was possible that just three weeks ago I didn't have the strength to hold my head up during the Zoom meeting and I was so tired I could hardly keep my eyes open and I couldn't concentrate because of the brain fog, I told them that this was a new illness and no one knows. Though one of

them asked me personally why I thought it happened so suddenly, I was tempted to disobey my husband and nearly told the whole truth, I asked Jesus for the wisdom of what to say and I simply said: "because of my prayers". I trusted Jesus completely, no matter what happened. That morning after my prayers I opened the bible on: **"Prudence will watch over you; and understanding will guard you." (Proverbs 2:11)** and I knew Jesus was with me, in me and by my side. After the meeting with my employers I waited for an hour and the outcome was that I could start work again in two weeks time! Praise be to God! Thank you Jesus!

Another miracle.

All I know and can say is that I am healed by Jesus with Spiro's help and I am so thankful for that and this is the Truth. And I will share my testimony with others so that I will praise, glorify and thank Jesus forever. Amen



What happened since then

I have just celebrated 4 years anniversary of my healing on the 13th May 2026, I celebrate it as my birthday, it is such a special day. Jesus has truly become the only Lord of my heart now.

I give thanks and praise to Jesus every day, since the day He healed me, I know he gave me another chance, new life and I never want to hurt Him again. I needed inner healing after receiving my bodily healing and in Jesus' timing it happened, it wasn't easy but we all

have to carry our own crosses, and we need to go through the narrow path which leads to salvation, the only way to get to it, is to focus completely on Jesus. Only Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life. As the Scripture says in 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 – My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness... For when I am weak, then I am strong.

Since my healing, Mark 11 is my daily prayer, I have come under an attack of COVID at least 3 times since my healing and all symptoms were starting to manifest upon me but as soon as **I prayed and applied Mark 11, including James 4:7 and John 10:10**, they left all at once. I haven't been off sick from work.

I started having symptoms of other illnesses from time to time but with prayer they mostly went away, though sometimes I have found myself reaching out to Spiro, who is a brother and mentor in Christ, to pray for me as he always asked me to do. This always does the job. Glory to God and praise be to Jesus.

I am a new person now, compared to 4 years ago. After my healing, I was drawn to become a volunteer for Jesus4UsAll.com and attended almost all services that Spiro presents in his mission, such as Penitential healing services, Healing services, Empowerment services, as well as a whole range of seminars. I have been exposed and participated in over 150+ services with Spiro which has significantly contributed to who I am today, so much so, that I am now experiencing the kind of miracles I only witnessed before in other peoples lives, the Lord is now performing them through me because of this mission ordained by God and His calling on my life to be part of it.

I know that it is only grace and I am not worthy to receive such grace and a new chance in life, I definitely don't deserve it. Jesus died for all of us and He loves us equally, the main point here is that He came to save the sinners and the bigger the sin He forgives, the bigger the love He receives back. It is really true. **I love Jesus with my whole heart.** Before I felt unworthy because of the sinful life I led before, but since I felt the love of Jesus and His mercy flooded my soul, I have been overwhelmed by a sense of loving Jesus even more like those who loved more because they were forgiven for much more, my love is growing more and more every second, I never realised what love really meant, it is not comparable with the love that the world brings.

Truly, I am experiencing miracles in my job and I can now clearly see that this job was from the Lord. Thank You Jesus.

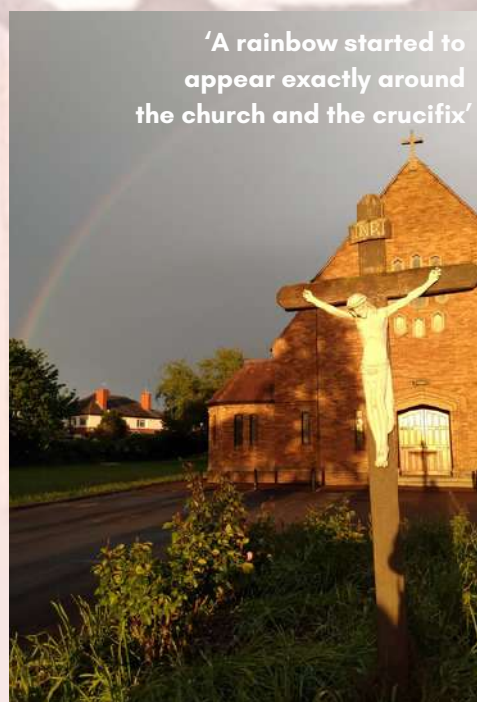

On the feast of the Ascension of the Lord on 14th May 2026 I went to Holy Mass. Our final hymn was "Abba Father, send Your Spirit" and after we finished singing it, I felt power coming to my hands, I stayed in the choir upstairs. Everyone left and I remained there in the presence of God, receiving graces

Then I sang "*Adoro te devote*" from my heart and I was filled with so much peace and love.

I went downstairs and **when I looked at the crucifix above the altar, it was illuminated and gold**, I prostrated myself before it and prayed. I fell down on my knees onto the grass and I knelt and bowed down on the grass, it was wet but I didn't care that my skirt was wet, I was crying, it is only grace, I don't deserve this...

I was praising Jesus and glorifying Him. I took photos of the rainbow straight after I kissed His feet. And again a few more photos after I got up from the wet grass. When I got to the car which was parked a few feet away, I noticed that my skirt was completely dry.

Only the next morning I realised that the first photo of the emerging rainbow I took was 8:32pm then I fell to the ground and the photo I took after was 8:34pm, which means the time I was completely in awe on my knees was 8:33pm. **The number 33 is special to me.**

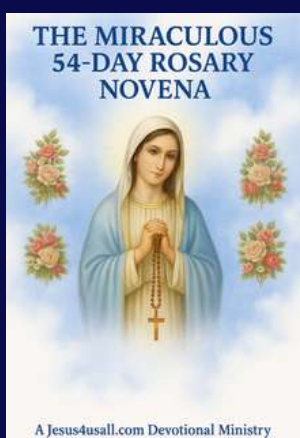

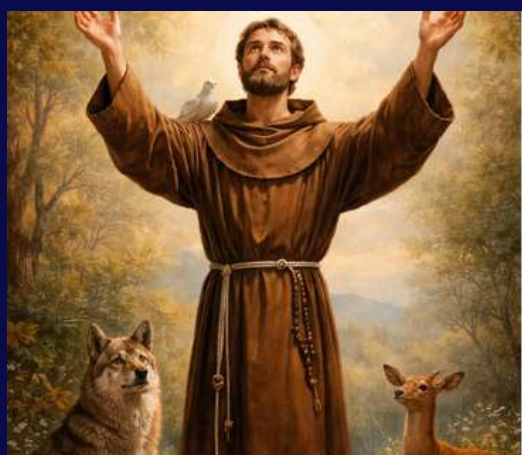
